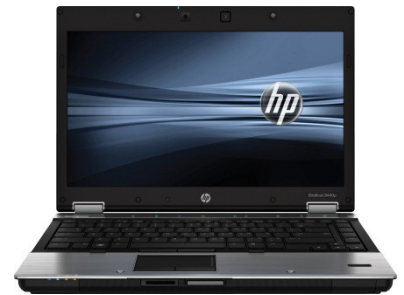

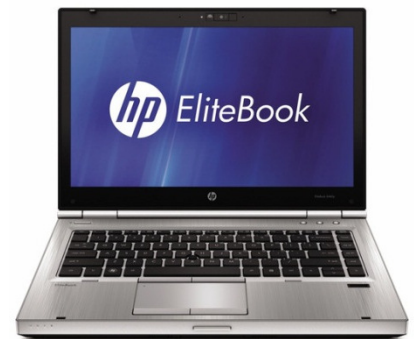

Contractor Provided Equipment. Equipment shall meet all standards established by specification or incorporated by reference and shall be maintained in good repair by the Contractor. The Contractor shall provide equipment including software, software installed, hardware, and consumables as stated. No substitutions are permitted. The contractor shall provide computers with current Microsoft Windows 7 & Microsoft Office Security Patches at the time of shipping. There shall be no additional charges for the patches. Contractor will provide a 24 hour/7 day support phone number on the device should technical assistance be required. Contractor will provide a list of all equipment available for order with make and model #. Contractor will create a restore point in Windows 7 after the image is built for rapid recovery should the need arise. Contractor will provide a spare computer when 5 or more are ordered. Computers with technical issues will be replaced via FedEx.

Government Provided Services, Licensing, and Software: The Government GIS software installs will be coordinated through the USFS Region 5 Fire & Aviation Management GIS Lab. (*See attached). Licenses will be provided under existing USFS Enterprise Licensing Agreements. GIS software shall be fully functional upon arrival in the field. When returned to the vendor from field use, GIS computers shall be wiped, reimaged/reinstalled, licenses reset and shall be ready for the next order. (*ESRI approved process under the ELA with the Forest Service).

Ordering quantities (minimum): The Government anticipates the minimum initial order of (5) units, with a total number per incident generally will not to exceed 40 units.

Dispatching/Ordering of Equipment: All awarded BPA contractors will be placed on a dispatch priority list by Geographic Area (ONCC / OSCC). Priority is given to price offered. This BPA does not preclude the Government from using any Agency or Agency Cooperator owned resources before mobilizing a resource order for this BPA.

Delivery requirements are as follows: The Government requires that units are to be received within a 24 hour period of the initial order. Units shall be shipped next day air. Units shall be packaged, wrapped with foam or bubble wrap within the container (box). The contractor shall be responsible for tracking of their equipment at all times in order to substantiate invoicing charges for shipping, rental period, etc.

The contractor must be able to arrange for special delivery for locations that do not allow for next day delivery. In this case, the contractor shall be paid on delivery costs to the Incident Location based on a per mile charge after a 100 mile minimum one way at the current GSA Federal Travel rates. A special handling fee of \$200 may also apply.

Logistics charges acceptable are as follows: (a) Federal Express billed with Contractors Invoice as a delivery charge (b) Commercial airline billed on Contractor Invoice with delivery charges.

Payment: All payments for this BPA will be processed by a commercial invoice delivered with equipment to the incident. Finance will execute an I-Suite Invoice along with the contractor's commercial invoice and submitted for payment. Payments are then forwarded to the Albuquerque Service Center (ASC). No payment shall be made by credit card under this agreement.

A commercial Invoice from the vendor shall include the following: (a) Resource Order with assigned "S" number (b) fire name (c) fire number (d) location of the fire (e) quantity and type of items being requested and shipping costs to and from the incident (estimated), (f) contact person to receipt of equipment ordered (g) timeframe estimated for rental shall be stated as End of Incident (h) Each incident resource order shall be considered the financial ordering document/call order for this BPA. Contractor shall invoice on a monthly basis.

Loss, Damage, or Destruction: For equipment furnished under this BPA the Government will assume liability for any loss, damage, or destruction of such equipment, except that no reimbursement bill be made for loss, damage or destruction due to (1) ordinary wear or tear, (2) mechanical failure, or (3) the fault or negligence of the contractor or the Contractor's agents or employees or Government employee owned and operated equipment.

2013 Process for installation of required software and other security concerns for USFS Region 5 Computer Equipment - BPA

Step 1: Initial Installation:

All Computer equipment – computers, plotters, printers, scanners, network equipment, and peripheral devices will be delivered wiped clean of any data content stored on the device. Computers, plotters, printers, scanners, network equipment, and peripheral devices are referred to as “equipment” in this document.

GISS installation software and data will be provided on a distribution media (DVD or USB drive) with installation sequence and instructions provided. The contractor will first do a clean install the software per the instructions provided for the sole use of this contract. The User Account will have Full Administrative rights. The software and data will not be used for any other purpose or contract. Upon completion of the software installation the installs will be tested to ensure they are working properly as documented in the instructions provided. Images can be created or the use of a virtual machine is allowed to support the reloading process (Step 2). The computer equipment will be distributed as needed under the specifications of the contract.

Step 2: Reloading Computers Returned from an Incident: Computers that are returned after use on an incident will be completely wiped, image, or virtual machine destroyed. There will be no backups of any of the software or data that is left on these computers. The computer will be reimaged or virtual machine loaded as per the instructions in Step 1. Software will be tested to ensure it is fully functional.

Step 3: Completion of Contract: All computers used under this contract will be completely wiped, all images destroyed on computers and supporting servers and external media. Original media provided will be returned to the Contracting Officer on this contract. No copies of the installation software or data provided will be kept, nor will any backups be made of the returning computers or the originally provided software and data.

Step by Step outline of process:

Step 1: Initial GISS Installation:

- Detailed instructions will be provided including software and data on distribution media
- Contractor does clean install and can either image or use a virtual machine to support the reloading effort (Step 2).
- Contractor will test software installs per instructions provided to ensure all software installed is working correctly
- No other use of the software or data is allowed.
- Computer equipment will be pre-staged and available for incident needs.

Step 2: Reloading Computer Returned from an Incident:

- Computers, printers, and/or plotters will be wiped or virtual machine destroyed.
- No backups of the returned equipment will be made.
- Computer will be reimaged or virtual machine loaded.
- Software will be tested to ensure it is fully functional

Step 3: Completion of Contract:

- All equipment used under this contract will have their hard drives completely wiped, all images, and all virtual machine images destroyed.
- All backups on supporting servers or external media will be destroyed
- Original media provided for this contract will be returned to the contracting officer
- No copies of the installation software or data will be kept, including any backups

- 1.) **Ordering categories are:**
 - a. Ordered for use on an Incident – (Duration of the Incident Only)
 - b. Equipment noted on Computer/Printer,(Fire Laptops-I-suite Server- GIS Computers, Printers, Consumables, etc.)
 - c. Orders can be placed by extended authority given in BPA. (Includes: CO of signature, Incident Contracting (Regional), Dispatch, FSC/PUL on IMT's, Designated CO from Service Areas, Buying Teams).
- 2.) **Resource Order will state the following:**
 - a. Resource Order Number
 - b. Fire Name and Number
 - c. Time period for the rental is stated as **duration of the incident**
 - d. Location of Fire/ Delivery Location
 - e. Description of equipment types to be ordered and quantity requested.
 - f. Contact name, phone number, and email address of who placed the order at the fire and or who will receipt and hold accountability of the equipment at the fire location.
 - g. Contact name, phone number, and email address for individual placing the order.
 - h. Contact information for Contractor including phone, fax, e-mail address.
- 3.) **ORDERING Process for ALL categories above is as follows:**
 - a. Place order thru dispatch for number and types of equipment needed.
 - b. Dispatch will process order thru Contractor under Region BPA.
 - c. Contractor will arrange for the rentals to fill the resource order and contact Dispatch regarding the shipment information and contents of shipment. A copy of the shipping log shall be forwarded to the ordering individual for supporting documentation.
 - d. Resource order executed shall include items noted under (2).
 - e. A copy of resource order and supporting documents will be forwarded to the FSC or designated individual on the IMT.
 - f. Information regarding the resource order placed shall be shared with team members such as CTSP and COML for final receipt and accountability.
 - g. Full documentation including packing slips and confirmation of order placed, location of each piece of equipment is to be provided to the FSC and maintained current throughout the incident.
 - h. Any unit missing or received damaged and not in working order shall be returned and the contractor notified immediately. Supporting documentation of the return of any equipment is to be supporting in written format and put in the file for FSC and Designated Service Area CO of the host agency.
- 4.) **End of incident/Team transfers:**
 - a. ALL Equipment returns to vendor. This is the responsibility of the IMT / Host Unit-Agency/Designated Service Area CO.
 - b. If a new team is transitioned in under the INCIDENT NAME /FIRE NUMBER AS ORDERED ALL Equipment shall be transferred to the new team on a property transfer form. This form is to be put into the FSC packet for payment and documentation.
 - c. Equipment shall be closed out and payment processed from the original team if a transfer of property is done.
 - d. Transfer of equipment shall only occur if the Incident is ON GOING and the location, fire number and fire name remains unchanged.
 - e. **Important: Orders for Computer/Printers** requires a transfer of property from one team to another on the same incident. Payments remain based on a monthly invoice, however, the transfer of property between teams must be included in the payment package and the contractor notified of the new key team contact information.
 - f. Host agency/IMT Teams shall utilize the most cost-efficient method to return units.
- 5.) **Invoicing/Payment Process:**
 - a. Final invoice done-I suite. (Weekly/Monthly rates-MOH) **Payment ASC ONLY – NO P-CARD!**
 - b. Units returned to vendor noting receipt at vendor end.
 - c. Concurrence of both parties of goods shipped and received and condition of goods- no claims or issues.
 - d. Release of contractor from claims.
 - e. Ultimately, host unit or agency is responsible to finalize all payments to the vendor.
 - f. Claims shall be dealt at Service Area Level.
