Introduction

This intention of this guide is to explain where, when, how, how many of each and by whom we post prevention posters. During fire restrictions, Mountain Zone fire staff are responsible for posting fire prevention or restriction posters and orders at major entry portals on the forest. Major entry portals are the primary access points to areas on the forest and include major drainages that lead to secondary trails and roads or major highways entering the San Isabel from other forests.

How to use this guide...

If you are assigned posting duties, please consult the following guidelines.

Stage 1 Restrictions – Mountain zone fire and fuels staff are responsible for posting stage I restrictions posters at all major entry portals on the zone. Stage I posting locations do not include designated campgrounds as campfires are still allowed there.

- 1. Determine which response area you will be posting
- 2. Consult the map pages for that response area. Determine how many of each size and what kind of posters you will need. Be aware that while posting some areas (i.e. along major entry portals such as highway 50) you may encounter signs along your route that are in adjacent response areas. Post those along the way as well.
- 3. Posters may be found in the engine bay. Acquire the appropriate number of copies of the special order to post where identified.
- 4. When posting please follow the directions for stapling and pulling staples found on page 4.
- 5. Use the posting log found in the back of this guide to record when and where posters were displayed.

Stage II Restrictions – Mountain zone fire staff are responsible for posting stage II restrictions posters at the same locations as in Stage I. Unlike stage 1 restrictions, stage II prohibits all campfires including those in developed campgrounds and picnic areas.

- 1. Consult with the Mountain Zone overhead or duty officer to determine if there is a need to post campgrounds.
- 2. As in stage I, consult the map pages for that response area. Determine how many of each size and what kind of posters you will need. Be aware that while posting some areas (i.e. along major entry portals such as highway 50) you may encounter signs along your route that are in adjacent response areas. Post those along the way as well.
- 3. Posters may be found in the engine bay. Acquire the appropriate number of copies of the special order and transparent protective sleeves to post only where identified.
- 4. When posting please follow the directions for stapling and pulling staples found on page 4.
- 5. Use the posting log found in the back of this guide to record when and where posters were displayed.

Stage III Restrictions – Mountain zone fire and fuels staff will coordinate posting with law enforcement and recreation staff. See FMO or AFMO for specific instructions

General Prevention Posting – Mountain zone fire and fuels staff are responsible for posting general prevention messages and "no fireworks" in place of restrictions posters when we come out of restrictions. Consult with the MZ AFMO to determine the message theme.

- 1. Determine which response area you will be posting
- 2. Consult the map pages for that response area. Determine how many of each size and what kind of posters you will need. Be aware that while posting some areas (i.e. along major entry portals such as highway 50) you may encounter signs along your route that are in adjacent response areas. Post those along the way as well.
- 3. Posters may be found in the engine bay. Acquire the appropriate number of copies of the special order and transparent protective sleeves to post where identified.

- 4. When posting please follow the directions for stapling and pulling staples found on page 4.
- 5. Use the posting log found in the back of this guide to record when and where posters were displayed

Poster Types

Throughout the year we use five categories of posters. Photographs of these are included this guide. General categories include:

- 1. **Prevention** provide a general message about fire prevention. Used throughout the year except when in fire restrictions. Some examples include:
- "do you have defensible space", "one careless match...", "Smokey help prevent wildfires"
- 2. **Stage 1 Restrictions** Restricts campfires and charcoal grills to developed campgrounds or picnic areas only. Used during elevated fire conditions when a special order has been enacted by the forest supervisor that restricts these activities. Some examples include:
- Yellow signs of various size with campfire and charcoal grill icons that say, "designated campgrounds and picnic areas only" (see photos for examples)
- 3. **Stage II Restrictions** Prohibits campfires and charcoal grills anywhere on the forest. Used during extreme fire conditions when a special order has been enacted by the forest supervisor that prohibits these activities. Some examples include:
- Yellow signs of various size with campfire and charcoal grill icons that say, "fire restrictions"
- 4. **Stage III Restrictions** Prohibits entry to the forest. Used in rare or unusual circumstances during extreme fire conditions or in areas where fires are actively burning. During Stage III restrictions, Mountain Zone staff will coordinate posting with law enforcement and recreation staff.
- **5. Fireworks Posters "**No fireworks" signs remind user of year-round restrictions against the use of fireworks on National Forest and BLM lands. A "no fireworks" sign should be permanently posted at all kiosks and campgrounds.

Poster Sizes

There are 4 poster sizes used on the Mountain Zone Fire's area of responsibility. Photographs of these are included this guide. Poster sizes are:

- 1. **11"** x **14"** Usually posted at kiosks such as on campground entrance information boards and some trailheads. During restrictions a Special Order from the Forest Supervisor is posted in a clear plastic sleeve here as well.
- 2. **16"** x **44"** Also known as a "long skinny". These are usually posted along the right of way along well-traveled forest and county roads. **No Special Order is posted here**.
- 3. **42"** x **34"** Posted along well trafficked larger roads such as highways. Large sign size helps to attract the attention of motorists travelling at higher rates of speed that might not see the smaller sign sizes. **No Special Order is posted here**.
- 4. **54"** x **45"** Posted along well trafficked larger roads such as highways. Often made of larger lumber to withstand high winds such as on Poncha Pass. **No Special Order is posted here**.
- 5. **Smokey Bear Fire Danger** This is the typical Smokey Bear fire danger sign used throughout the USFS. Displays fire danger ratings from low to extreme. Requires a Yale key to access. While no poster is used here, Mountain Zone personnel are responsible for changing ratings based on fire danger. **No Special Order is posted here**.

Posting SOPs...How to run a stapler

Staple Requirements

- 11x14: 4, one staple per corner.
- 16 x 44: 6, one staple per corner and one in the middle of the top and bottom edge.
- 42x34: 8, one staple per corner and one in the middle of all the edges.
- 54x45: 9, one staple per corner, one in the middle of each edge, and one in the middle of sign.

Pulling posters

- Remove in a way that will not destroy the poster.
- Pull out all staples from signs.
- Remove all staples from posters before returning to the cache.
- Properly dispose of staples, do not throw them on the ground.
- Make sure to remove the orders when pulling restriction posters

Posting

- Post on kiosk or sign face, not on the sign legs.
- If no room to post on kiosk face, rearrange the other signs to make room for prevention poster.
- Post only in designated areas identified in this guide.
- Do not staple flush to sign surface, it makes for difficult poster/staple removal.
- Pull off original poster before posting new, do not staple new poster over old.





PSICC - MOUNTAIN ZONE










Response Area 3 & 4


