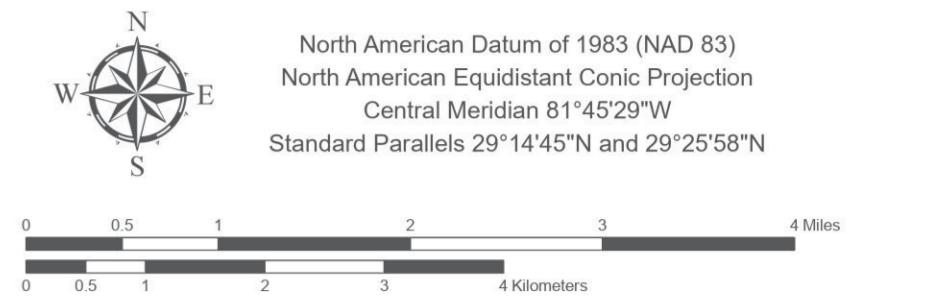
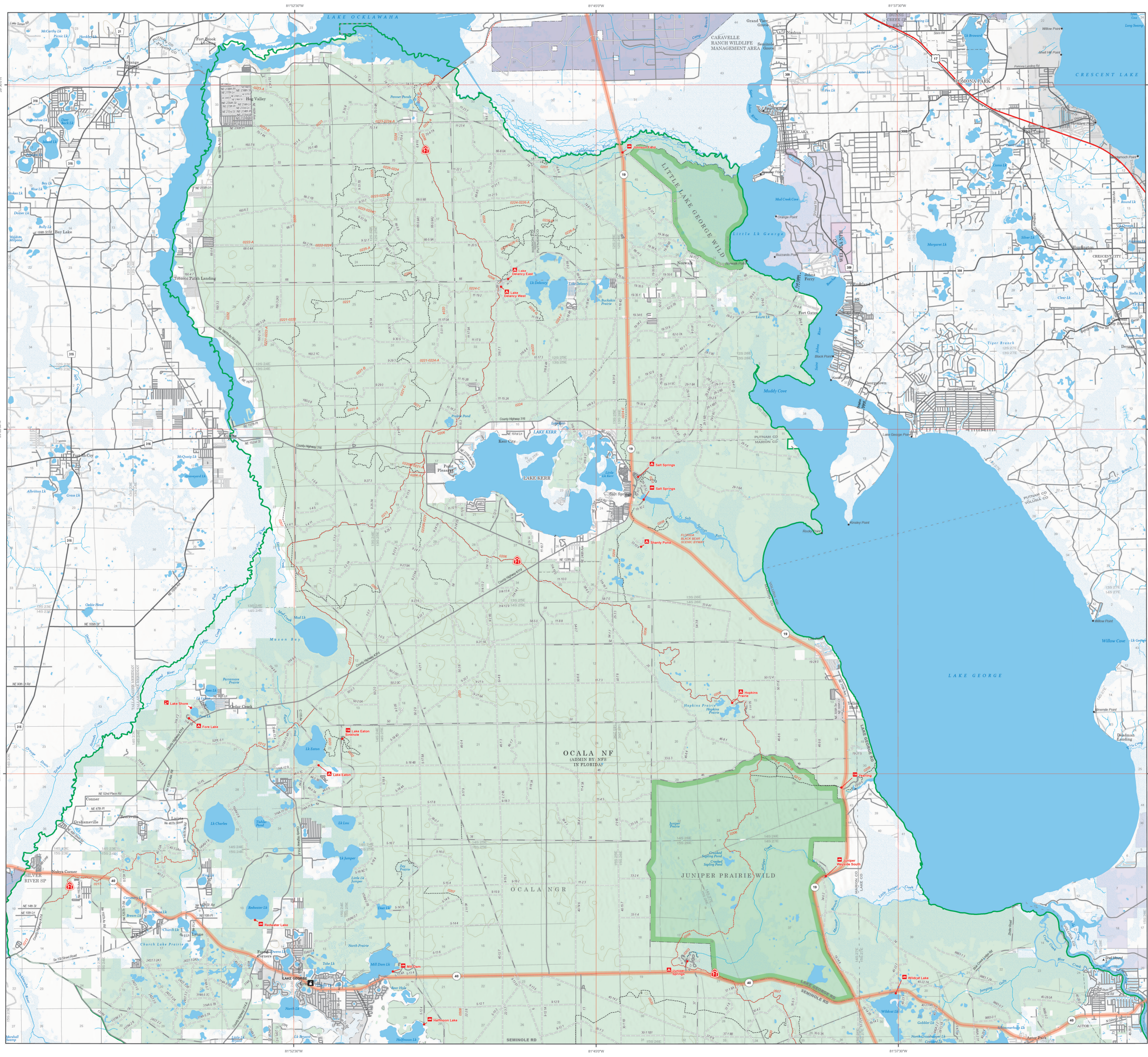


Lake George Ranger District National Forests in Florida
