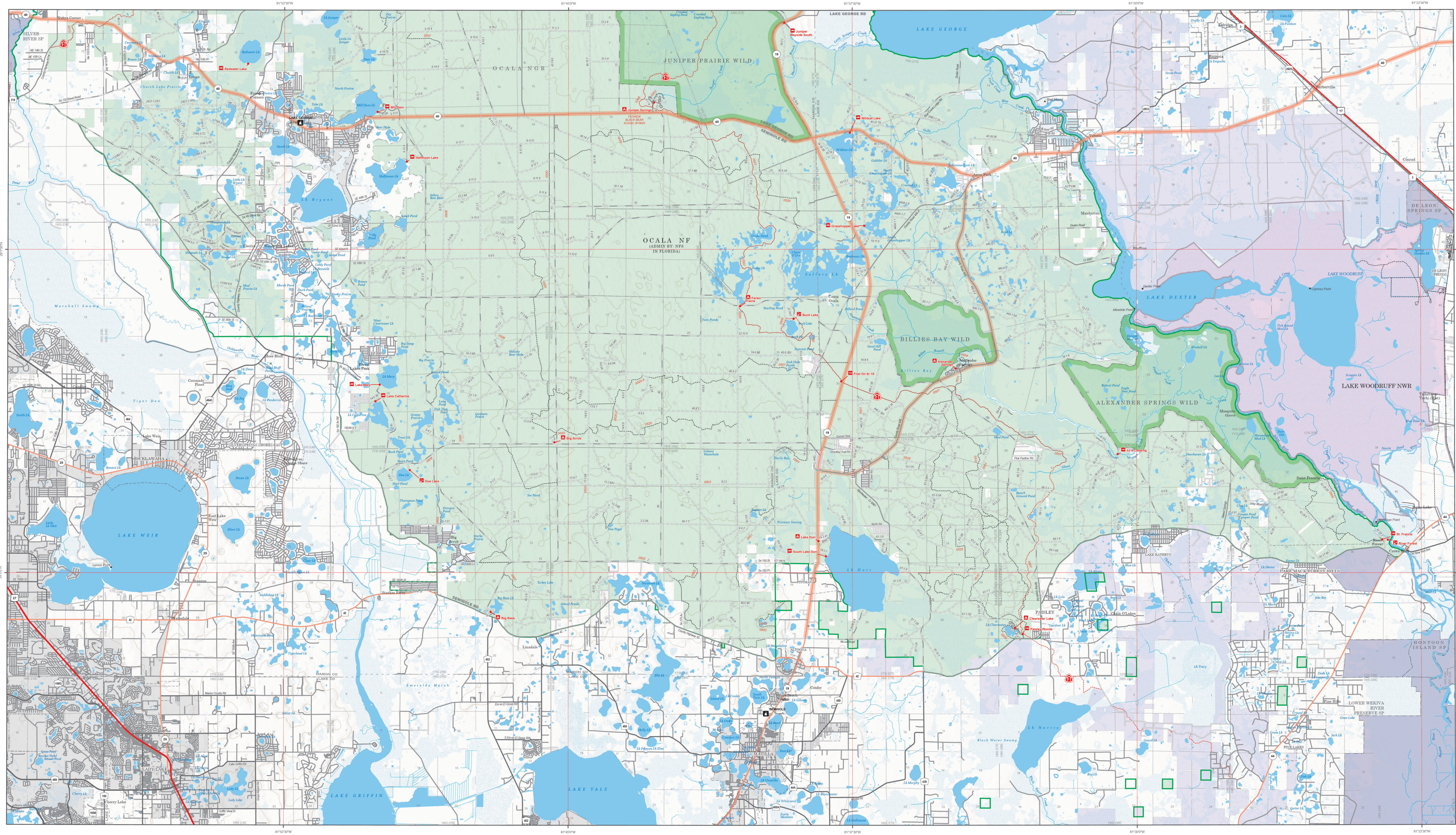
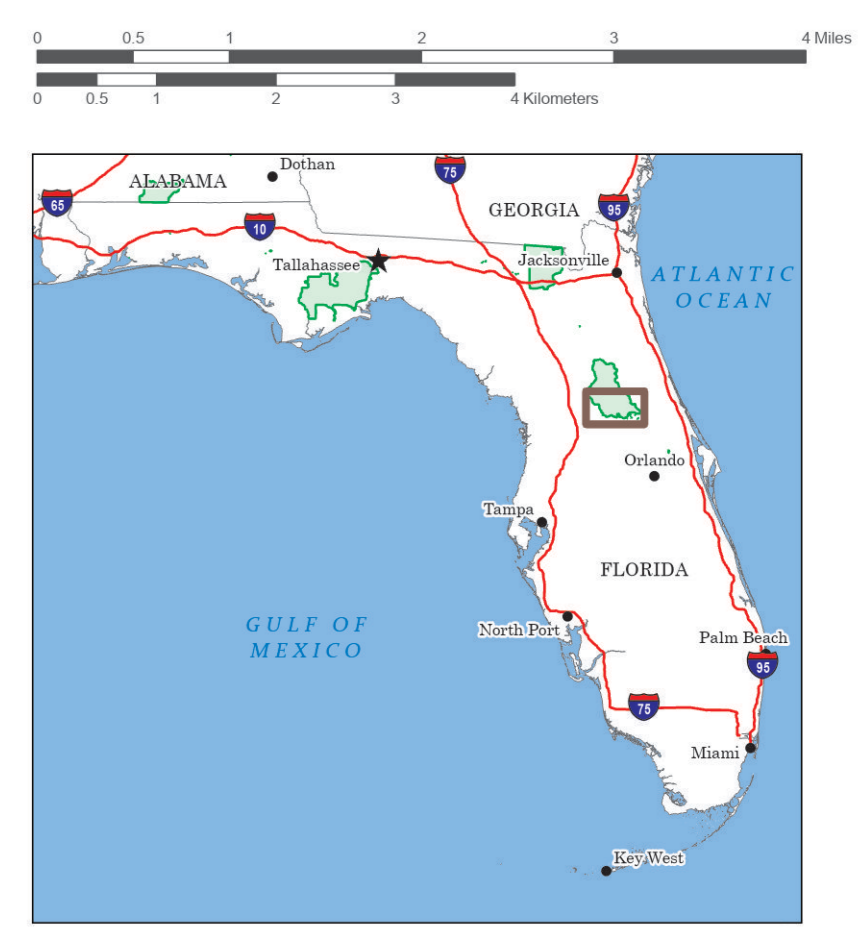


# Seminole Ranger District National Forests in Florida
