


















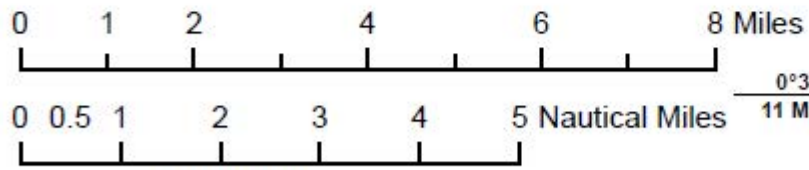


SANTA FE NATIONAL FOREST KNOWN AERIAL HAZARDS MAP

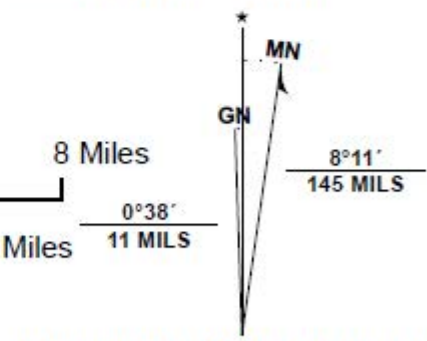
