## Amendment to Otis NWR-BellroseWPA, Unit 8S Prescribed Burn Plan

## Rationale:

The prescribed fire plan for Otis NWR-Bellrose WPA was written in 2017. It went through the technical review process in 2017 as well, and signatures of the original prescribed fire plan preparer, and the technical reviewer are within the original plan.

## Element 4: Description of the Prescribed Fire Area modification:

The original burn unit boundary was delineated using both the full extent of Otis NWR and Bellrose WPA. Unit 8 S is a very small portion of Bellrose WPA. Unit 8 S is bounded on the south side by a gravel road $\left(27^{\text {th }}\right.$ Ave NW), the east side by mow line and open water/wetland, the north side by mow line, and the west side by mow line. Adjacent landowners to the east and south are privately owned and will remain a requirement to be contacted as part of the pre-ignition notifications made by the burn boss or the designee. The north and west adjacent lands, however, are FWS-owned lands, and as such the adjacent landowner contacts in these directions are not required to be contacted. The required notifications are detailed in the amended IAP(attached).

The Otis NWR-Bellrose WPA burn plan, as originally written consists of upland and marsh grasses and forbs, (both native and tame species) totaling 499 acres. This amendment, as shown by the map has significantly reduced the unit size to 49 acres. As such, the resources needed to implement this burn unit also has been changed with this amendment. The original burn plan calls for a minimum of 11 personnel, using 2 type 6 engines, and 5 UTVs. That amount of resources is excessive for the small, 49-acre unit 8 S . Therefore, the number of required (minimum) resources is shown below in the ICS 204. The number of required resources is derived by an analysis of the amount of mow line, amount of hard (gravel) holding features, the fuel type, and the total burn unit size.

Other than the burn unit being reduced to 49 acres and reducing the required adjacent landowner contacts, the remainder of the burn plan is unchanged, and remains valid (once signed by the Agency Administrator). This amendment will be sent to the Agency Administrator for signature at the same time as the original burn plan. The amended burn plan will allow for other resources within the ND Fire Zone to focus on other priorities while not tying up un-necessary resources on a simple, 49-acre unit.
