

5. General Control Objectives for the Incident (include alternatives)

Control Objectives:

Keep Fire:

- North of the Salcha River.
- East of a line along the Transmitter Road, north to the Chena River and south along the Trans-Alaska Pipeline to the Salcha River.
- West of the South Fork Chena River, south along eastern boundary of the Training Area, south to the Salcha River.
- South of the Chena River.

Management Objectives:

- Provide for firefighter and public safety utilizing LCES, 10 / 18, and risk management from IRPG and required UXO briefings.
- Protect military infrastructure, private residences, cabins, improvements and jurisdictional lands within and adjacent to the fire area.
- Minimize or mitigate threats to known cultural resources by utilizing READs and/or archeologists.
- Avoid application of retardant within 300 feet of stream channels and water ways.
- Coordinate and communicate fire information with the public and all stakeholders.
- Coordinate, develop and implement fire suppression repair.
- Support local unit initial attack as requested.

<u>WEATHER DISCUSSION:</u> A series of disturbances in fast west to southwest flow aloft will bring more clouds and moisture than what we have seen the last several days. Though a shower or two could fall at any time over the next few days, the best chance at a wetting rain through late Wednesday will be from after midnight tonight through mid-morning Wednesday. West to southwest winds will remain nearly the same.

WEATHER SUMMARY:

High Temperature: 65 to 72 degrees Minimum RH: 44-48% Winds (Eye-Level): RIDGETOPS: West to Southwest 5 to 10 mph with gusts to 18 mph. SHELTERED VALLEYS: Light upslope/upvalley winds. Gusty outflow winds near heavier showers possible.

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL:

A slight cooling and dampening trend has started. This will start to noticeably affect the fine flashy fuels but drying will continue in the deeper duff and heavier fuels.

Divisions B, C, F: Expect little to no fire movement in areas retaining heat. Fire will generally fester in place today where it was yesterday.

Divisions K, L, M, N and P: Fire will be reduced to smoldering and short flame lengths except in areas where heavy fuels in large concentrations retain heat. Any fire movement will be minimal.

Division R: Smoldering in isolated areas.

Division S, A: Fire growth will be minimal via smoldering, creeping, and shorter flame lengths and will require an established heat source to dry fuels ahead of it as long as RH remains above 40%. Areas retaining heat underneath spruce trees may allow for a low amount of torching but spot fire potential is greatly reduced. Any small spot fires from the previous two shifts will likely fester in place undetected today. Areas with significant heat in the duff are likely to smolder in place rather than go out on their own without moisture.

Drought Code (DC): The potential for significant ground or sub-surface fire activity is relatively minimal at levels less than 300. The tendency for persistent smoldering increases as values of 500 are approached in which case mop-up and extinguishment gradually becomes more difficult as the DC continues to rise.

#### Unexploded Ordinance (UXO)Still a danger: Page 25 IRPG

- Be especially mindful as mop up intensifies in the western divisions
- Report any suspected ordinance to your supervisor immediately.
- Do not transmit radio near suspected UXO's
- Never touch, move, disturb.
- Isolate and flag the area and deny entry.
- · Clearly flag off area

#### Wildlife:

- More and more sightings of moose on Johnson Road
- Spike Camps (Div P and Div A) are especially vulnerable and exposed to bears.
- Do not threaten a bear and force it to fight back.
- Allow the bear a way out with dignity.
- · Pretend you are not afraid. Yeh Right...
- Be aware of wind direction. If the wind is in your face the bear may not smell you.

#### **Hazard Trees:**

- Native trees especially White Spruce have shallow roots systems and are weakened after ground fire.
- Follow Hazard Tree Safety Guidelines
- Limit number of personnel around snags and their exposure time; fallers must be qualified for trees being fallen, clear the area before falling, YELL OUT!
- Be especially alert around snags AND green trees during wind events.

#### Injuries:

- Minor injuries are on the rise; sprained ankles, blisters, burns are showing up.
- Check with your crew. Catch foot problems before they get infected.
- Spikes, plan ahead for your medical needs. Turnaround time from order to sling delivery can be two days.

# If Declaring an "Incident within the Incident"

The closest DIVS will respond to manage the incident. They are responsible for giving an accurate size up, ensuring scene safety, setting priorities and initiating an appropriate response.

The closest Safety Officer and Line EMS will respond to the scene to assist the Branch Director or DIVS. Secure site and begin initial investigation when situation is stabilized.

# PREVENT SEXUAL HARASSMENT

SEXUAL HARASSMENT at work, including emergency incidents, occurs whenever unwelcome conduct on the basis of gender, adversely affects a person's ability to do their job, and contributes to a hostile work environment. Sexual harassment includes, but is not limited to, the following types of conduct:

- **Unwelcome** sexual advances
- Requests for sexual favors
- Discussing sexual activities
- Telling off-color jokes
- Unnecessary touching
- Displaying sexually suggestive pictures
- Using demeaning or inappropriate terms
- Using indecent gestures
- **Using crude and offensive language**
- **Commenting on physical attributes**

"Inappropriate behavior is harassment including sexual and racial harassment and shall not be tolerated". Fireline Handbook, Chapter 6, Common Responsibilities.


