

GENERAL:

FWI for Thursday (Stuart Creek-Manchu): FFMC 87-88, DMC 21-37, DC 270-378, ISI 5-6, BUI 37-60, FWI 11-17

Though codes forecast for Thursday don't change much from Wednesday, sun in the afternoon and evening will produce more favorable burning conditions later in the day. Spruce fuels on SW slopes will be favored, and torching activity could kick off some spread in unburned fuels. Ignition potential is rising, but still moderate, even in unshaded fuels. Burn period is shortening.

Majority of the fuels within and around the fire

Spruce/Hardwood mix worst case scenario:

FL Head: Up to 4-6 ft

ROS Head: 10-12 ch/hr

Continuous Black Spruce worst case scenario:

FL Head: 9-12 ft

ROS Head: 16-25 ch/hr

Spotting distance: ¼ mile

Probability of ignition: 30% (shaded) to 60% (unshaded)

SPECIFIC:

Divisions S and A: Smoldering and creeping with occasional torching should increase with sun, making heat easier to find in the afternoon. With ISI's up to 6, there is possibility of small organized flame fronts and small uphill runs in continuous spruce stands remaining in unsecured areas.

Division R: With sun coming out in the afternoon, expect drying fuels to show the heat that remains. Some interior smokes may torch a few more spruce.

Divisions F, K, L, M, N, and P: Scattered smoldering will continue. Exposed to forecast winds, expect occasional interior torching to increase in spruce patches. Most remaining smokes within the mopup standard have been addressed and much of the perimeter is in monitor status.

Divisions B and C: Uncontained since early days of the fire, a few smokes remain – some near unburned fuels. Any significant heat remaining should show later in the burn period.

AIR OPERATIONS:

Overall a good day, ceilings will lift early in the period.

SAFETY

"Know what your fire is doing at all times." As resources mobilize or move from quite divisions to more active ones, pay attention to the fire behavior head- ups mentioned by those giving briefings and listen for reported fire activity. Be prepared to report what you see yourself.



1. Line supervisor (i.e. FFT1, CRWB, STLD, TFLD) notifies DIVS on **Command frequency** and states nature of illness/injury. Is it life threatening?

LIFE THREATENING = MEDIVAC NON-LIFE THREATENING = MEDICAL TRANSPORT

- 2. If life threatening request that the designated radio frequency be cleared for emergency traffic.
- 3. Identify the on-scene point of contact (POC) by resource type and last name (i.e. POC is TFLD Smith).
- 4. Identify the nature of the incident, number injured, patient assessments and location (geographic and GPS coordinates).
- 5. Identify on-scene medical personnel by position and name (i.e. EMT Basic Smith)
- 6. Identify preferred method of patient transport.
- 7. Request any additional resources and/or equipment needed.
- 8. Document all information received and transmitted on the radio and phone.
- 9. Identify any changes in the on-scene POC or medical personnel as they occur.
