FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL:

FWI forecast on Saturday for Fire Area: FFMC 88, DMC 26, DC 285, ISI 7, BUI 43, FWI 15

Saturday will be another day into a drying trend. Clouds will reduce some of the sun's effect, keeping ignition potential down where they shade your fuels. With FFMC's holding at 88 for at least another day, not a lot of change in light fuels like lichen, feathermoss, and litter. Wind remains the most favorable factor for active fire spread and torching/spotting potential in the areas of concern around the fire. Look for hot spots to continue to creep around into adjacent unburned fuels where exposed to the wind, increasing the smoke they produce and possibly torching a tree or two in a given location.

Majority of the fuels within and around the fire

Spruce/Hardwood mix worst case scenario:

FL Head: Up to 4-6 ft

ROS Head: 10-12 ch/hr

Continuous Black Spruce worst case scenario:

FL Head: 10-12 ft

ROS Head: 15-30 ch/hr, based on windspeed/slope

Spotting distance: ¼ mile

Probability of ignition: 40% (shaded) to 70% (unshaded)

SPECIFIC:

Divisions S and A: Smoldering and creeping with occasional torching should increase with sun, making heat easier to find in the afternoon. With ISI's still around 7 or 8, the possibility of small organized flame fronts and small uphill runs in continuous spruce stands in unsecured areas remains.

Division R: With sun more prominent today, expect drying fuels to show the heat that remains. Some interior smokes may torch a few more spruce and make a short run or two like observed on Friday.

Divisions F, K, L, M, N, and P: Fewer and fewer heat sources remain in these divisions. Most remaining smokes within the mopup standard have been addressed and much of the perimeter is in monitor status.

Divisions B and C: Uncontained since early days of the fire, a few smokes may show themselves again – some near unburned fuels. Not much smoke visible on Friday.

AIR OPERATIONS:

No limitations expected today.

SAFETY

Continue to monitor the thresholds for increased fire activity, with temps above 75 and RH below 35%. With that, wind and slope alignments are showing potential for fire movement.

Slow down on the curves and bends in the river giving civilian traffic plenty of room. You may even have to stop and let them pass.







- 2. If life threatening request that the designated radio frequency be cleared for emergency traffic.
- 3. Identify the on-scene point of contact (POC) by resource type and last name (i.e. POC is TFLD Smith).
- 4. Identify the nature of the incident, number injured, patient assessments and location (geographic and GPS coordinates).
- 5. Identify on-scene medical personnel by position and name (i.e. EMT Basic Smith)
- 6. Identify preferred method of patient transport.
- 7. Request any additional resources and/or equipment needed.
- 8. Document all information received and transmitted on the radio and phone.
- 9. Identify any changes in the on-scene POC or medical personnel as they occur.
