

Safety Message

The hazards and risks have not diminished nor downsized even though the level of complexity of this incident has. Please recognize this fact and continue to pay attention to them. Here are a few and I'm sure each of you has focused on them and more.

- -Hazard trees: identify, leave alone if need be until a safer time to deal with them, then cut them down.
- -Water travel: use those PFD's, watch your allowable loads, take your time.
- -Helicopter use: you know the drill, briefings, load calculations, be deliberate in your actions.
- -UXO: if found, use the 3 R's: Recognize, Retreat, Report.

There is a smaller support staff behind you to assist in any emergency, think things through and talk about how you will respond before that situation crops up. You have to know what you are going to do. Thanks- Paul van Hees, Tom Greiling

1. Line supervisor (i.e. FFT1, CRWB, STLD, TFLD) notifies DIVS on <u>Command frequency</u> and states nature of illness/injury. Is it life threatening?

LIFE THREATENING = MEDIVAC NON-LIFE THREATENING = MEDICAL TRANSPORT

- 2. If life threatening request that the designated radio frequency be cleared for emergency traffic.
- 3. Identify the on-scene point of contact (POC) by resource type and last name (i.e. POC is TFLD Smith).
- 4. Identify the nature of the incident, number injured, patient assessments and location (geographic and GPS coordinates).
- 5. Identify on-scene medical personnel by position and name (i.e. EMT Basic Smith)
- 6. Identify preferred method of patient transport.
- 7. Request any additional resources and/or equipment needed.
- 8. Document all information received and transmitted on the radio and phone.
- 9. Identify any changes in the on-scene POC or medical personnel as they occur.
