OBJECTIVES:

1. Ensure firefighter and public safety through risk-informed tactical decisions and continuous situational awareness.
2. Protect human life and safety, the community of Huslia and associated infrastructure including the Hogatzka Mine, numerous Native allotments, subsistence values, and natural/cultural resources.
3. Contain fires at the smallest acreage reasonably possible in order to limit short and long-term threats to values.
4. Maintain and enhance relationships with residents, cooperators, and the public and ensure timely, accurate, consistent communication with cooperators, stakeholders, and the public.
5. Minimize fire impact on the Koyukuk River which is the major travel corridor and vital to local residents and their economy.
6. Minimize smoke impacts to local residents and Tribal activities involving treaty rights.
7. Backhaul unnecessary supplies and tactical gear/equipment as conditions and fire activity warrant.

Spot Forecast for 279 Moldy...Bureau of Land Management National Weather Service Fairbanks AK 511 PM AKDT Fri Jul 18 2025 Forecast is based on forecast start time of 1900 AKDT on July 18.

DISCUSSION... Showery conditions build through Saturday with numerous showers by Saturday afternoon and evening. Increased showery conditions will moderate temperatures Sunday through much of next week as well as keep RHs high. Light winds through Saturday shift southerly overnight Saturday and then southwesterly and strengthen Sunday night into Monday. Winds will slowly increase through the week with gusts up to 15 mph possible Monday and Tuesday. No thunderstorms are expected amongst these showers through the week.

SATURDAY... Sky/weather.....Mostly cloudy (65-75 percent). Numerous rain showers in the afternoon. CWR.....1 percent. Tstm Coverage.....None.

Max temperature.....Around 73. Min humidity.....54 percent.

Wind (20 ft).....Light winds becoming south 5 to 7 mph in the afternoon. Ridgetop wind.....Light winds becoming south around 10 mph in the afternoon. Mixing height.....400 ft AGL increasing to 3400 ft AGL in the late morning and afternoon. Transport winds.....South around 7 mph. Inversion burnoff...11am burns off completely

SATURDAY NIGHT... Sky/weather.....Mostly cloudy (80-90 percent). Numerous rain showers in the evening, then scattered rain showers overnight. CWR.....19 percent. Tstm Coverage.....None.

Min temperature.....Around 56. Max humidity.....90 percent.

Wind (20 ft).....South winds 5 to 8 mph in the evening becoming light. Ridgetop wind.....South winds around 10 mph. Mixing height.....3400 ft AGL decreasing to 500 ft AGL in the late evening and overnight. Transport winds.....South around 11 mph. Inversion setup.....Showery conditions keep inversion from forming.

SUNDAY... Sky/weather.....Mostly cloudy (80-90 percent). Scattered rain showers in the morning, then numerous rain showers in the afternoon. CWR.....13 percent. Tstm Coverage.....None.

Max temperature.....Around 68. Min humidity.....65 percent.

Wind (20 ft).....South winds 5 to 7 mph. Ridgetop wind.....South winds around 10 mph. Mixing height.....2300 ft AGL. Transport winds.....South around 8 mph. Inversion burnoff...Showery conditions kept inversion from forming. .
