DISCUSSION...

Cool but gradually warming weather with continuing shower activity is expected through the week, with highs rising from the lower 60s Tuesday into the upper 60s by Friday. Min RH values will also slowly fall from the mid-60s Tuesday to the lower 50s by Friday. Scattered showers this evening will become numerous to widespread from overnight tonight through tomorrow evening. Rain will likely be light for the most part, although totals through Wednesday may exceed a tenth of an inch. Winds will generally blow from the southwest between 5 and 12 mph at the lower levels, with elevated winds at between 15 to 25 mph tonight weakening a bit by Tuesday. Some of the "ridgetop" winds may make it down to the lower levels in the form of gusts at times. Consistent cloudy and rainy weather will limit the potential for any inversions to form during the overnight periods for at least the next few days.

Galena dispatch will coordinate additional transport to definitive care.
