#### DISCUSSION...

Light southwest winds are expected to continue through Wednesday with light and variable winds on Thursday before a switch to light northerly winds behind a front Thursday night. Scattered to numerous showers are occurring this evening and are expected to continue through Wednesday. Chances for wetting rains gradually diminish through Thursday with a few lingering showers possible through Friday evening before a drier air mass moves in behind the front. Light north winds usher in a drier air mass for Friday and Saturday with rain chances returning as early as Sunday night. Sunny skies and deep mixing allow min RHs to fall to near 40% over the weekend.

In the case of an IWI, on-scene personnel will announce a medical alert on Roundabout command channel C5 or C6, using the "8-line" medical plan (p. 120 of IRPG). The patient should be assessed and treated by on-scene personnel, and a plan for evacuation formed. Safety Officer Pease-Madore and/or ICP personnel will notify Galena dispatch of the IWI, and coordinate air/boat resources for evacuation to Huslia or Galena airfield. Galena dispatch will coordinate additional transport to definitive care.
