DISCUSSION...A frontal system will pass through the area this evening with scattered showers beginning around 1900. These will persist through the night before a brief period of clearing on Monday morning between about 0400 and 1900 Monday. A more organized band of showers moves in Monday night with higher chances for wetting rain with showers continuing Tuesday. Temperatures cool each day through Tuesday before a ridge of high pressure begins to build over the area Wednesday. By next weekend, temperatures may rise into the upper 70s to low 80s yet again as a pattern more typical for June than August takes shape.

The patient should be assessed and treated by on-scene personnel, and a plan for evacuation formed. Safety Officer Pease-Madore and/or ICP personnel will notify Galena dispatch of the IWI, and coordinate air/boat resources for evacuation to Huslia or Galena airfield. Galena dispatch will coordinate additional transport to definitive care.
