Medical plan: Notify line supervisor whether medevac or non-emergency medical transport. Line supervisor will notify ICP. All **Yellow** and **Red** Medicals will be transmitted over Command. Primary life-flight will be out of Central Airstrip. Secondary medical plan is to activate EMS out of Steese F.D. via 911. Patient will be transported via ground to Steese Hwy, milepost 80, where care will be transferred to Steese F.D.

Safety: “Our search and rescue group has never searched for a person wearing a life jacket.” – Greg Kahoe

5. Suppress Fire 214 (Deadwood) 100%.
6. Continue aerial recon and monitoring of Fire 241 (Little Mosquito).
7. Develop rehab plan for Fire 214 (Deadwood).
