Medical: Notify line supervisor whether medevac or non-emergency medical transport. Line supervisor will notify ICP. Dispatch will be notified of all medicals. All **Yellow** and **Red** Medicals will be transmitted over Command. Primary life-flight will be out of Central Airstrip. Secondary plan is to activate EMS out of Steese FD by calling 911. Patient will be transported via ground to Steese Highway milepost 80, where care will be transferred to Steese FD. Minor injuries may be evaluated at Circle Clinic — Open M-F, 0900-1500 — (907) 978-3036.

Safety: Statistically, heart attacks are the number one killer of firefighters — the latest, on September 28, 2024, was Stephen A. Scott, age 39, a multi-year smokejumper. Both Helibase and ICP have AEDs on standby. Number two is vehicle accidents. Please drive defensively and wear your seat belts! Number 3 is aircraft accidents. Please review the blue pages in the IRPG, especially the 12 aviation watch outs.
