Medical: Notify line supervisor whether medevac or non-emergency medical transport. Line supervisor will notify ICP. Dispatch will be notified of all medicals. All **Yellow** and **Red** Medicals will be transmitted over Command. Primary life-flight will be out of Central Airstrip. Secondary plan is to activate EMS out of Steese FD by calling 911. Patient will be transported via ground to Steese Highway milepost 80, where care will be transferred to Steese FD. Minor injuries may be evaluated at Circle Clinic, open M-F, 0900-1500, (907) 978-3036.

Safety: Change is in the air. There are a lot of new faces on the line. Different tactics may be implemented. Weather might be around the corner. Know your chain of command; know your mission during this transition.

Notes: Call in orders to logistics by 1300 for next day delivery. Send in all CTRs and shift tickets through line supervisors.

1. Provide for firefighter and public safety.
2. On 242 & 243 limit fire spread and prevent impact on values at risk to the north, east & Steese Hwy. Utilize Birch Creek as a holding feature to prevent westward movement.
3. Mop-up and secure 265.
4. Monitor 264, take action as needed to protect identified values at risk.
5. Monitor 256, take action as needed to protect values at risk, and limit growth beyond existing footprint.
6. Patrol 214.
7. Develop rehab plan for the complex.
8. Be prepared to provide IA support as necessary.
