**Medical:** All yellow and red IWIs will be called into ICP using the Medical Incident Report (MIR/8-Line) via radio on the Command channel. Transport off-incident will be coordinated by ICP and Upper Yukon Dispatch. Fixed wing air transport will use the Central airstrip. Ground transport of yellows and reds will rendezvous with the Steese VFD ALS Ambulance at mile marker 88. Non-emergency greens must be reported to the incident using the chain of command. Greens will be assessed and transported as needed.

#### Safety:

- Many fires in Alaska are reporting an increase in camp crud and general sickness.
   Ensure you and your camp compadres are washing your hands and practicing good hygiene.
- Please give plenty of space to large vehicles as they need to stay closer to the center of the road. Heavy vehicles are more likely to roll on soft wet gravel road shoulders. The lug nut rule remains applicable.
- Be aware that we now have a UAS module. Report any private aircraft to the pilots you are working with.
