**Medical:** All yellow and red IWIs will be called into ICP using the Medical Incident Report (MIR/8-Line) via radio on the Command channel. Transport off-incident will be coordinated by ICP and Upper Yukon Dispatch. Fixed wing air transport will use the Central airstrip. Ground transport of yellows and reds will rendezvous with the Steese VFD ALS Ambulance at mile marker 88. Non-emergency greens must be reported to the incident using the chain of command. Greens will be assessed and transported as needed.

### Safety:

- Yesterday's boating incident could have happened here. Travel is always a very
  dangerous task: driving to assignments, flying on fires, boating around a division or
  hiking through the tundra. Use the risk management process to identify, assess, develop
  controls to evaluate the risks you are exposed to.
- Repeaters are now linked. Please continue to report areas that have poor reception.
- We now only have one EMT assigned to the incident. If you have more EMS support, please let Safety know.
