.DISCUSSION...

Upper-level high over the fire will continue to bring hot and dry weather through the week. Slight chance of thunderstorms possible between 1400 and 2200 AKDT in the afternoons. However the main concentration of the storms will be to the S/SE. Better chances for storms near the fire on Tuesday and Wednesday. Temperatures will continue to slowly warm, reaching the near 80 by Wednesday. RHs will be at their lowest in the late afternoon around 30 percent, becoming brier each day. However, good overnight RH recovery is expected. Surface winds are expected to be increasing Wednesday with a shortwave dropping down from the NE.
