.DISCUSSION...

Current SITREP:

Over July 3rd, stations near the area reported max temperatures in the low 80s, with RH dropping to the upper 20 percent. Winds were out of the northeast with gusts reaching below 20mph. This morning observations indicated excellent RH recovery in sheltered valleys, with exposed ridges seeing 60 percent. FAA Web camera views from Central, Alaska, showed clear skies with minimal smoke.

All fire indices highlight critical values, with FFMC values above 93.

FORECAST:

Moving through Friday expect hotter and drier conditions. Temperatures will climb into the mid 80s, with RH plummeting to the mid 20s, perhaps even reaching 20 percent. Northeast winds will also increase this afternoon as a band of stronger winds moves in a few thousand feet above us. While this will bring gusty winds of 15 to 20 mph to the surface, it will also limit inversions from setting up tonight and RH recovery, even more so on ridges. Saturday more hot, dry and breezy conditions take place.

Sunday or Monday a pattern shift is in the works, bringing cooler temps and higher RH, along with increasing chances for thunderstorms.
