DISCUSSION...

Cooler conditions are expected at the fire site through Wednesday, with highs in the upper 60s and min RH values in the lower 40s. Scattered showers will be possible this afternoon and evening, with mostly dry weather thereafter for the next few days. Winds will generally blow from the southwest through tonight at between 5 and 10 mph, with elevated winds blowing higher at about 15 to 20 mph. These 15 to 20 mph elevated winds may at times gust to the lower levels during periods of surface heating and during showers. Winds will become lighter Wednesday, with warmer and drier weather to return Thursday.
