#### .DISCUSSION...

Hot and dry this afternoon before a cold front passes early tomorrow morning. Isolated to widely scattered thunderstorms are possible this afternoon and evening, with wetting rain chances increasing into Tuesday. Rain showers are also possible this afternoon/early evening before definite showers are expected starting Tuesday morning. Temperatures will drop into the mid 60s by tomorrow, with min RH values increasing to over 50% overnight. Winds are expected to be out of the south/southwest today with winds strengthening going into tomorrow. Winds are expected to then weaken and shift towards the west/northwest overnight Tuesday.
