.DISCUSSION...

More of the same weatherwise for this fire complex. High pressure will continue to dominate the weather with hot and dry conditions. Highs will again be near 80 and min RHs will be near 29%. Low level instability will increase today. It will get more smoky. Winds will be westerly today but remain light. They turn more southwesterly Monday and Tuesday. The high pressure ridge shifts east into Canada with some upper air disturbances moving through Monday through Wednesday. This will increase shower and thunderstorms chances. The best chance looks to be Monday night. Wetting rains are possible only if a storm moves directly overhead - so not likely to happen. The smoky conditions should improve by late Monday. High pressure returns late Wednesday into next weekend for another hot and dry spell.
