**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** Another round of showers is expected and, likely, a thunderstorm, Wed afternoon-evening w/lesser shower potential Thu as low pressure lingers across N CA. High RHs & cool temperatures will result in fog, at times, across the fire area thru Thu, and in valley bottoms around sunrise into the weekend. Cold morning lows are likely, especially at ICP, Thu-Sat mornings. Warming & drying is expected under high pressure & clearing skies later Thu- early Sat w/some late day showers possible this weekend.

#### Wednesday (0700-1900 PDT):

- **WEATHER:** Mostly cloudy w/areas of fog in the morning. A slight chance of showers in the morning. Showers &, likely, a thunderstorm in the afternoon-evening.
- WIND (20 FT): Variable 5 mph or less becoming SW 5-15 mph afternoon. (24hr Trend: Up 5-10mph)
- MAX TEMPERATURES: 55-62°F, except 65-70°F at ICP. (24hr Max Trend: Little change)
- MIN RH: 60-70%. (24hr Trend: Little change)
- CHANCE OF WETTING RAIN (> or = to 0.10"): 90%. Additional rainfall 0.10-0.30".
- CHC of LIGHTNING: 55%.
- MIXING HEIGHT: Inversion breaking late morning. Increasing to 3500ft AGL mid-afternoon.
- **TRANSPORT WIND:** NE 5 mph early, SW 5-10 mph late morning, & SW 10-20 mph afternoon.




