WEATHER SUMMARY:

Today will be partly cloudy with high temperatures of 89-100 degrees, and minimum relative humidity 8-18 percent. Slope and valley winds will be northwest in the morning becoming west to southwest 4-8 mph in the afternoon. Ridge winds will be southwest 6-10 mph becoming west in the afternoon. Tonight will have a low temperature of 65-77 degrees with maximum humidity 24-32 percent. The wind will be light and variable becoming east to northeast 2-4 mph in the valleys and slopes, and 3-7 mph on the ridges.

Probability Of Ignition: 90-100%

OUTPUTS

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL:

The fuels in the north and east portions of the fire is a mix of oak woodland with a grass and brush understory and fields of brush with a light grass understory. The fuels to the west and south are dominated by grass with a sparse oak overstory. The fuels are highly stressed and the fuel moisture in the brush is at critical levels, below 60 percent. Single and group tree torching during peak burning conditions will create spots 1/2 to 3/4 of a mile away. The head of the fire is progressing at a rapid rate of spread and will increase when in the open grass areas influenced by the wind. The slopes and ridges influenced by the wind have complete consumption of the fuels. The backing and flanking fire is dominated by surface fire with occasional torching of individual trees. The temperature will lower today with a slight increase in humidity, however this will not have an effect on the fire behavior, due to the fuel conditions.

SPECIFIC:

The north side of the fire will continue to be lower activity as it backs up slope against the wind. The fire in the Mokelumne River will continue to flank at a slow rate of spread to the east. The west side of the fire will lower fire intensity in the grass fuels, it is also very receptive to firebrands. The lighter fuels will be influenced by the wind increasing the rate of spread. The south side of the fire has a mixture of fuels, from heavy 100 and 1000 hour to light 1 and 10 hour. This will increase the potential for spot fire with the torching trees creating fire brand and a very receptive fuel bed. The east side of the fire has several areas will it will transition from Oak and brush to lighter fuels, the transition will increase the rate of spread and the spotting potential. In the areas with light fuels influenced by the wind the fire can progress at 2 mph or more.

AIR OPERATIONS


Air operations will be limited in the morning until the smoke begins to lift. As the fire increases activity the smoke column may limit air operations at the head of the fire.


SAFETY

CAL FIRE INCIDENT MANAGEMENT TEAM WATER USAGE PLAN

California Drought Emergency

The following shall be considered and implemented by all fire resources as a means to provide maximum efficiencies when utilizing water resources, while minimizing the impacts to private and public water supplies. Accountability shall be maintained for all water supplies that are utilized and care should be applied to ensure proper replacement and/or reimbursement to the supplier/ owner.

Fireline personnel- (During mop up operations)

- Use of Pencil Hose and Garden Nozzles with Shut-Offs.
- Use of Back pumps.
- Dry Mop-up and consolidation of heavy fuels to areas where they can burn out safely
- Locate/ Relocate Firelines to lighter fuels or natural barriers when safe.
- Set up and use portable tanks in anticipation of longer transport times for Water Tenders.
- Use of foams, gels and other water enhancers.
- Evaluate need to mop up in excess of 200 feet from fireline

Road Maintenance and Repair-

- Monitor and water roads only when and where needed.
- Water when most effective (evening and nights).
- Use chemical treatments when available (Magchloride, Omni bind ect).
- Consider use of tertiary or treated water (sp)

Aviation Operations-

- Use of Gels, Foams and Retardants. Set up portable plants.
- Consider Blivits and Pencil hose for interior mop up operations as opposed to numerous bucket drops.
- Establish and use pre-use agreements for existing and known water sources.
- Use large watershed dip sites when able. Minimize use of small, static ponds and lakes.
- Maintain accountability of water used and locations of dip sites.
- Evaluate need for interior bucket drops

Private Water Supplies-

- Notify property owner as early as possible.
- Minimize usage and develop alternative water supplies when and where appropriate.
- Track usage (meter, 214 form) and develop a plan to replace water.
- Make arrangements for reimbursement and damage claims if needed.

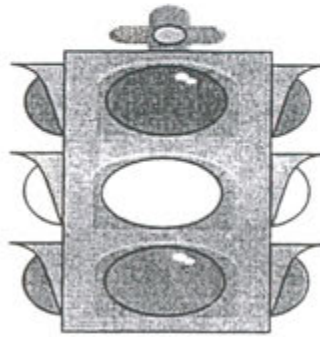
Public/ Municipal Water Supplies-

- Notify Agency as soon as possible and request a representative to the incident.
- Identify fill areas and request metering devices. Place on incident map.
- Use alternative or reclaimed water sources when available. Place on incident map.
- Make arrangements for reimbursement and damage claims if needed.

Management and Supervision-

- Use leaders intent and establish Water Conservation as an Management Objective.
- Consider complexity of water use on incidents. Establish a Water Supply Group Supervisor to coordinate additional resources to support the incident needs.
- Complete the Water Usage Report daily and turn in to Finance
- Review this check list and brief daily.

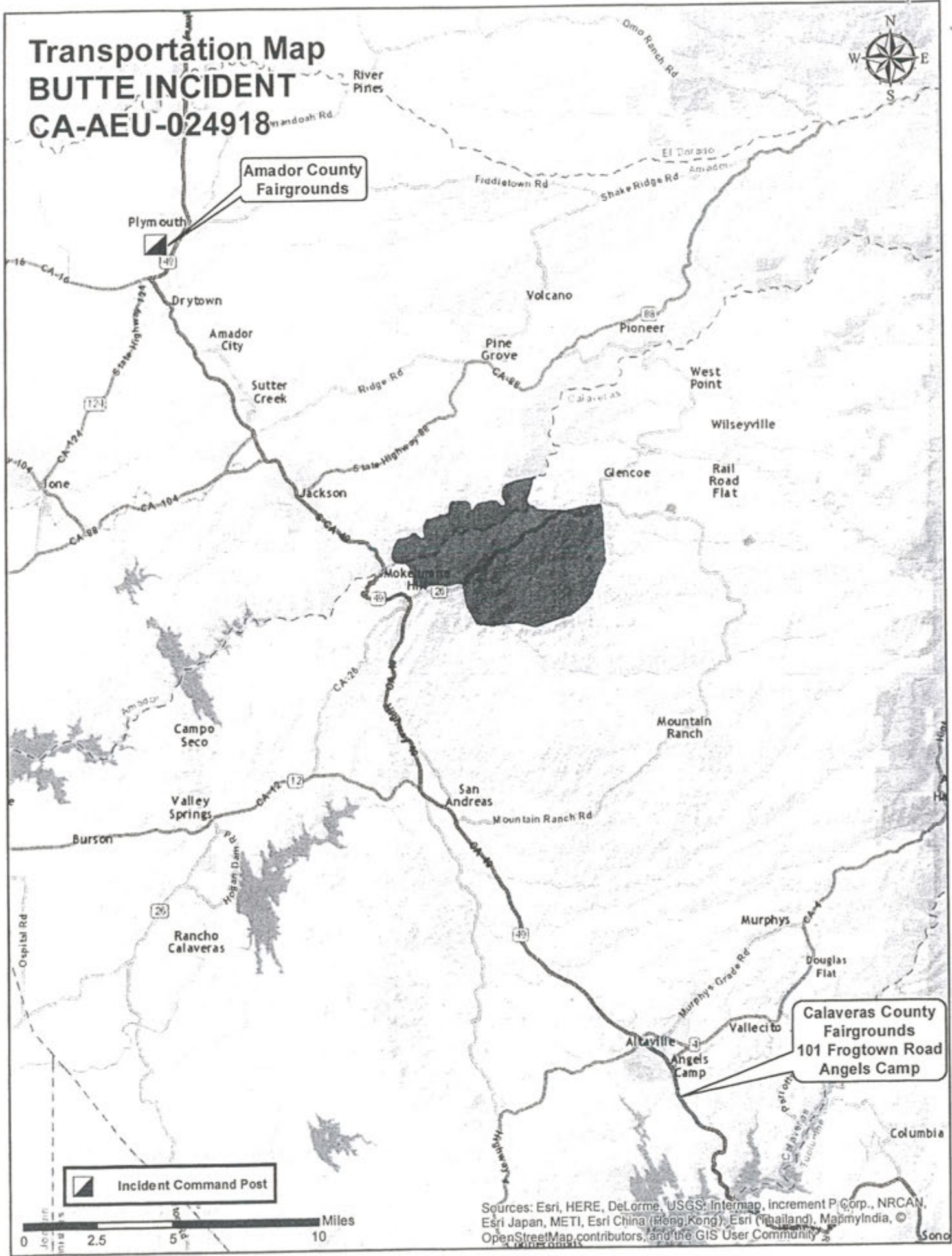

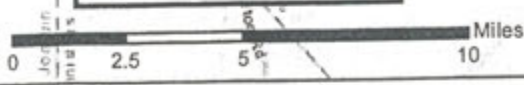
