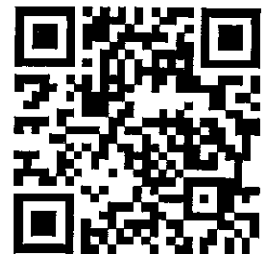



### WEATHER DISCUSSION:

Moisture associated with low pressure aloft off the California coast and from the remnants of Hurricane Linda will move over the area Sunday and Monday. Isolated afternoon thunderstorms may develop over the highest terrain each day, but development would occur east of the fire with storms then traveling northeast. There is potential for isolated light showers or rain later Sunday and again on Monday.



## INPUTS

### WEATHER SUMMARY:

Today will see another day of an inversion preventing smoke from lifting out of the fire area until the afternoon hours. The temperature will be 84-94 degrees and relative humidity 12-22% during the day. Overnight the temperature will be 65-77 degrees and relative humidity 28-40 percent. Wind during the day will be southeast becoming southwest 7-10 mph in the afternoon in the valleys/slopes and southwest 6-10 mph on the ridges. The overnight hours will bring northeast winds in the valleys/slopes and west to southwest wind 6-10 mph on the ridges.

**Probability Of Ignition: 90-100% Day 60% Night**

## OUTPUTS

### FIRE BEHAVIOR

#### GENERAL:

The fuels in the north and east portions of the fire is a mix of oak woodland with a grass and brush understory and fields of brush with a light grass understory. The fuels to the west and south are dominated by grass with a sparse oak overstory. The fuels are highly stressed and the fuel moisture in the brush is at critical levels, below 60 percent. Single and group tree torching during peak burning conditions will create spots  $\frac{1}{2}$  to  $\frac{3}{4}$  of a mile away. The head of the fire is progressing at a rapid rate of spread and will increase when in the open grass areas influenced by the wind. The slopes and ridges influenced by the wind have complete consumption of the fuels. The backing and flanking fire is dominated by surface fire with occasional torching of individual trees. The temperature will lower today with a slight increase in humidity, however this will not have an effect on the fire behavior, due to the fuel conditions. The slight moderation in weather will have little effect on the fire since the larger fuels will carry the fire.

#### SPECIFIC:

The northeast portion in the Mokelumne River drainage will be active with a southwest wind increasing spread to the east. The drainage splits into two main branches with a dominant ridge in-between. If fire becomes established in both sides of the canyon there will be two separate head fires. The east side of the fire has transition areas from trees and brush into grass fields. Spotting into these fields is a strong possibility. These spots will have a rapid rate of spread and will transition again into brush and timber. The south portion of the fire is in the grass oak woodland, which has the high potential for spot fires, however the wind should be more favorable for control efforts. The east side of the fire is also in the grass oak woodland and will have favorable winds during and changing directions across the line in the overnight hours. Spotting potential will be reduced in the overnight hours but is still a strong possibility.



Air operations will be limited until the smoke lifts out of the area in the afternoon.


## SAFETY


The cooler weather will not have a dramatic change in the fire behavior due to the lag time in the heavier fuels. Continue to monitor your surroundings for spot fires.

### WATER USAGE PLAN

#### *California Drought Emergency*

The following shall be considered and implemented by all fire resources as a means to provide maximum efficiencies when utilizing water resources, while minimizing the impacts to private and public water supplies. Accountability shall be maintained for all water supplies that are utilized and care should be applied to ensure proper replacement and/or reimbursement to the supplier/ owner.

#### **Fireline personnel-** (During mop up operations)

- Use of Pencil Hose and Garden Nozzles with Shut-Offs.
- Use of Back pumps.
- Dry Mop-up and consolidation of heavy fuels to areas where they can burn out safely
- Locate/ Relocate Firelines to lighter fuels or natural barriers when safe.
- Set up and use portable tanks in anticipation of longer transport times for Water Tenders.
- Use of foams, gels and other water enhancers.
- Evaluate need to mop up in excess of 200 feet from fireline

#### **Road Maintenance and Repair-**

- Monitor and water roads only when and where needed.
- Water when most effective (evening and nights).
- Use chemical treatments when available (Magchloride, Omni bind ect).
- Consider use of tertiary or treated water (sp)

#### **Aviation Operations-**

- Use of Gels, Foams and Retardants. Set up portable plants.
- Consider Blivits and Pencil hose for interior mop up operations as opposed to numerous bucket drops.
- Establish and use pre-use agreements for existing and known water sources.
- Use large watershed dip sites when able. Minimize use of small, static ponds and lakes.
- Maintain accountability of water used and locations of dip sites.
- Evaluate need for interior bucket drops

#### **Private Water Supplies-**

- Notify property owner as early as possible.
- Minimize usage and develop alternative water supplies when and where appropriate.
- Track usage (meter, 214 form) and develop a plan to replace water.
- Make arrangements for reimbursement and damage claims if needed.

#### **Public/ Municipal Water Supplies-**

- Notify Agency as soon as possible and request a representative to the incident.
- Identify fill areas and request metering devices. Place on incident map.
- Use alternative or reclaimed water sources when available. Place on incident map.
- Make arrangements for reimbursement and damage claims if needed.

#### **Management and Supervision-**

- Use leaders intent and establish Water Conservation as an Management Objective.
- Consider complexity of water use on incidents. Establish a Water Supply Group Supervisor to coordinate additional resources to support the incident needs.
- Complete the Water Usage Report daily and turn in to Finance
- Review this check list and brief daily.
