

#### INPUTS

#### WEATHER SUMMARY:

The sky will be clear with high temperatures and low humidity again today. The temperature will be 87-92 degrees during the day and 59-66 degrees overnight. The humidity will be 17-25% during the day with a slight recovery to 23-30% overnight. Winds will be light from the southwest to west 5-8 mph with gust to 14 mph slopes/valleys and 7-10 mph with gusts to 18 mph on the ridges during the day. Overnight winds will be southeast 3-6 mph with gust to 9 mph in the valleys and slopes and ridge winds will be 5-8 mph with gusts to 14 mph.

#### **OUTPUTS**

#### FIRE BEHAVIOR

#### GENERAL:

There was minimal to no humidity recovery the past 3 nights, keeping the light fuels at a low moisture level. The winds will increase tomorrow but it will bring in some moisture from the delta. This will help to lower the Probability of Ignition to 60-90%, depending on what aspect you area working on. The will increase the spotting distance, however unless there is column development the ember production and distance should be minimal. Continue to watch for smoldering material increasing in activity in the afternoon, especially in the interior islands.

#### SPECIFIC:

The Mokelumne River portion of the fire may start to see more leaf and needle litter on the surface as the winds increase, creating more smoldering material. Post lookouts to watch for increases in fire activity which could cause ember cast. The east and south side of the fire will continue to have smoldering in the islands of unburned fuels, which will become active in the late morning to afternoon. On the south side of the fire watch for rolling material in the steeper sections of the islands. The rolling material may increase the fire activity allowing for short range spotting along Fricot City Road. Pay attention to the masticators along the road, the equipment has the potential to start a new fire in the dry conditions. Any area that has an understory burn with standing brush the leaves will start falling and creating a new surface layer with cured fuels. These leaves and needles will readily ignite when in contact from an ember or smoldering fuels.

#### AIR OPERATIONS

There should be no issues for aircraft during the operational period.

#### SAFETY

The winds will be increasing, watch for ember cast as fire activity increases in the afternoon, especially in the interior islands.

#### MAJOR HAZARDS/RISKS

DEMOBILIZATION: Travel safely to your home base or next assignment. Get proper rest and have a travel and communications plan. Ensure your equipment is accounted for and ready for inspection.

MASTICATORS, CHIPPERS, and other HEAVY EQUIPMENT: Maintain safe distances when working near Heavy Equipment. Beware of flying debris. Maintain communications with operators and personnel.

MINE SHAFTS and other MINING HAZARDS: Identify and flag mine shafts and other hazards. Beware of shafts hidden in brush and debris.

## INCIDENT MANAGEMENT TEAM WATER USAGE PLAN

#### California Drought Emergency

The following shall be considered and implemented by all fire resources as a means to provide maximum efficiencies when utilizing water resources, while minimizing the impacts to private and public water supplies. Accountability shall be maintained for all water supplies that are utilized and care should be applied to ensure proper replacement and/or reimbursement to the supplier/ owner.

#### Fireline personnel- (During mop up operations)

- · Use of Pencil Hose and Garden Nozzles with Shut-Offs.
- · Use of Back pumps.
- Dry Mop-up and consolidation of heavy fuels to areas where they can burn out safely
- · Locate/ Relocate Firelines to lighter fuels or natural barriers when safe.
- Set up and use portable tanks in anticipation of longer transport times for Water Tenders.
- Use of foams, gels and other water enhancers.
- · Evaluate need to mop up in excess of 200 feet from fireline

#### Road Maintenance and Repair-

- Monitor and water roads only when and where needed.
- Water when most effective (evening and nights).
- Use chemical treatments when available (Magchloride, Omni bind ect).
- · Consider use of tertiary or treated water (sp)

#### **Aviation Operations-**

- Use of Gels, Foams and Retardants. Set up portable plants.
- Consider Blivits and Pencil hose for interior mop up operations as opposed to numerous bucket drops.
- Establish and use pre-use agreements for existing and known water sources.
- Use large watershed dip sites when able. Minimize use of small, static ponds and lakes.
- · Maintain accountability of water used and locations of dip sites.
- Evaluate need for interior bucket drops

#### **Private Water Supplies-**

- · Notify property owner as early as possible.
- Minimize usage and develop alternative water supplies when and where appropriate.
- Track usage (meter, 214 form) and develop a plan to replace water.
- · Make arrangements for reimbursement and damage claims if needed.

#### Public/ Municipal Water Supplies-

- Notify Agency as soon as possible and request a representative to the incident.
- Identify fill areas and request metering devices. Place on incident map.
- Use alternative or reclaimed water sources when available. Place on incident map.
- Make arrangements for reimbursement and damage claims if needed.

#### Management and Supervision-

- Use leaders intent and establish Water Conservation as an Management Objective.
- Consider complexity of water use on incidents. Establish a Water Supply Group Supervisor to coordinate additional resources to support the incident needs.
- Complete the Water Usage Report daily and turn in to Finance
- Review this check list and brief daily.

## DEMOBILIZATION PLAN - SUMMARY Butte Incident CA-AEU-024918

#### GENERAL INFORMATION

The Demobilization Plan is developed to facilitate the orderly removal and checkout of resources on the incident. By definition, surplus personnel are available for release if they have rested for a minimum of 8 hours.

#### **GENERAL GUIDELINES**

- o NO RESOURCES WILL LEAVE THE INCIDENT UNTIL AUTHORIZED TO DO SO BY THE DEMOB UNIT.
- DEMOB list will be posted around camp and also will be added to the CAL FIRE IMT 1 online folder. (Scan QR code to read DEMOB list or http://calfire.box.com/calfireimt1)
- o Efforts will be made to ensure that all released personnel arrive at their destination prior to 2200 hours.
- All government and hired vehicles leaving the incident will have a safety inspection. If a vehicle is within 1,000
  miles of a "B" service, it is the responsibility of the resource to contact Ground Support and have an oil change prior
  to their scheduled DEMOB time.
- All trainees are to keep their time up to date and report to the Training Specialist with their task books and evaluations prior to completion of the demobilization process.
- All strike team leaders are responsible to call North Ops at 1-800-237-3703 immediately upon being released from the incident.

#### RESPONSIBILITIES

Unit Leaders will declare resources excess to their Section Chief. Section Chiefs will declare excess resources to the Planning Section Chief through the Resource Unit Leader. This should be done 36 hours in advance of anticipated release. Use the Declaration of Excess Resources sheet or General Message Form (ICS-213) to list all excess resources. Include the resource name, request number, name of person, date and time of declared excess, and time in which the resource will be eligible to leave. Send to the RESOURCE UNIT where the resource will be determined to be surplus to the incident. Surplus resources will then be able to report to the DEMOB UNIT, receive a Demobilization Checkout Form (ICS 221), get the appropriate ICS 221 signatures, and then return the completed ICS 221 to the DEMOB UNIT prior to final release or reassignment.

#### **RELEASE PRIORITIES**

- 1. Organized fire departments
- 2. OES engines
- 3. Hired personnel and equipment
- 4. Other agencies (USFS, BLM, etc.)
- 5. Out of region Cal Fire forces
- 6. Within Region Cal Fire Forces
- 7. Unit CAL FIRE Forces

#### TRAVEL INFORMATION

All resources will meet agency specific requirements on hours of travel per day. For CAL FIRE hand crews, a full 24 hour reset period shall be adhered to before departing from the incident. After a crew's last operational period they shall begin the demobilization release procedure during their 24 hour off shift. In addition, they must use the following complete 24 hour period as reset time before they depart from the incident.






