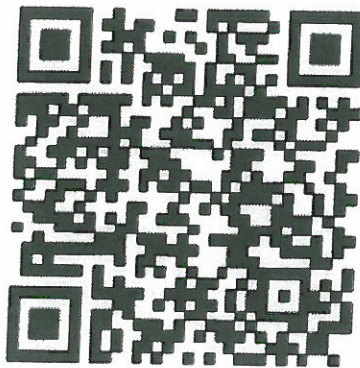



**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** Fog produced by high morning humidity will combine with smoke to reduce visibility and delay inversion break up. Skies will be mostly sunny through much of the day allowing warmer temperatures and lower relative humidities. The fire will be in between two systems which will allow ridge top winds to be lighter than Monday. Winds will be mainly from the west/northwest through the day with an increase in speed and shift to the northwest in the late evening. On Wednesday the chance of rain will increase with a tenth of an inch of rain possible over the fire.

**FORECAST FOR TODAY:** Mostly Sunny (10-30%)...Becoming Partly Cloudy (30-50%) after 1600.

#### FIRE BEHAVIOR

#### GENERAL:

The first burning period had unprecedented fire behavior with the fire growing to over 35,000 acres. Long range spotting and critical rates of spread were key contributors to fire growth. The past two burning periods displayed lower levels of intensity. Fire progression and structure loss was aided by areas with heat sources that had yet to have available resources mitigate. Lower temps and higher RH with a mix of light rain minimized fire activity in the flashy fuels but increased the smoke production in the still burning heavy fuels.

#### SPECIFIC:

Branch XV - I

Scarcity of resources has allowed fuels to continue to burn extending into structures and become seated in the canyons. Crews continue to discover new areas of heat.

Branch XIII Geysers

Fire potential is higher in this area based on fuel volatility, terrain with rollout and increased wind speeds.

Branch XI – IX

The perimeters have not been ground truthed, this area was moderately active yesterday, expected to increase in activity with reintroduction of solar radiation.

Branch VII – V

The SE edge could be influenced by the W wind along Butts Canyon. To the East the introduction of fuels that have proven to burn at higher levels of intensity (JERUSALEM / ROCKY).

Branch III

Any flare ups from a sleeper would be in optimal alignment for a new start.

#### AIR OPERATIONS:

AM Fog and early smoke may delay air operations.

#### SAFETY

Wildfire environment with weakened trees, hidden areas of heat and possible footing hazards with ash root cavities. If moisture develops the slick surface will add an additional footing hazard.

# SAFETY MESSAGE

**SAFETY DOESN'T STOP AT THE BRIEFING! ENSURE EVERYONE ON THE LINE RECEIVES ONE!**

- Monitor FIRE BEHAVIOR very closely and adjust suppression activities accordingly. Ensure Escape Routes, Temporary Refuge Areas and Safety Zones are identified.
- Manage yourself and those around you for excessive fatigue. TAKE BREAKS as needed to ensure you are rested.
- Use caution when working around burned or damaged structures numerous hazards still exist.
- Ensure radios are properly programmed for today's IAP and that crews are trained in communications procedures for the incident.
- Stay hydrated!!! Time to think = time to drink. Document rest and hydration on 214.
- ALL PPE must be worn when working on the fireline.
- SLOW down when driving to and from assignments even if the roads are closed for emergency personnel only.
- HEADS UP!!! LOOKOUT for SNAGS when working around areas with burned trees or burned powerpoles.

# GEYSERS

## SAFETY MESSAGE

**This Safety Message applies to any resource assigned the Geysers Geothermal Fields (Calpine) in addition to the Valley Incident Safety Message.**

- ⇒ Steep winding UNMARKED roads are throughout the Geysers. Drive defensively with headlights on and use hands free devices.
- ⇒ The Geysers area contain numerous vertical and horizontal mines shafts, look down for vertical mines and stay away from horizontal mine openings.
- ⇒ Earthquakes are prevalent throughout the Geysers, LOOK OUT for rolling rocks and take earthquake precautions if earthquakes are felt.
- ⇒ Hydrogen Sulfide (H<sub>2</sub>S) in parts per million can be hazardous, if available utilize air monitoring equipment to detect for this hazard.
- ⇒ Natural steam vents exist in many areas. DO NOT mistake steam for smoke you may be BURNED.
- ⇒ Reclaimed hydrants are painted PURPLE do not drink water from the hydrant system in the Geysers.
- ⇒ CALPINE is a power distribution operation DO NOT CUT ANY DOWN POWERLINES.

California State Penal Code Section 409.5(d) allows the news media to enter scenes of disaster, riot, or civil disturbance. Properly identified members of the news media should not be restricted from entering the locations specified within the code, even if the area presents a danger to them. Media members should be advised of the nature of possible danger. Members of the media do not have the right to access crime scenes or any area where their presence may interfere with incident operations, mitigation or evidence collection.

- The media may only access private property with the property owner's permission. Fire personnel cannot provide members of the media with authorization to enter private property.
- If approached and questioned by the media and/or the public, talk about your assignment or task at hand. If need be, direct the questioning party to the incident PIO.
- Do not speculate or give opinions
- There is no such thing as an "off the record" comment.

### CAL FIRE SOCIAL MEDIA POLICY (Social Media 0691)

Social Media is increasingly being used by public agencies, the media and the public. This form of communication continues to grow rapidly in order to supply the public's desire for instant information gratification. All personnel assigned to a CAL FIRE incident will adhere to the CAL FIRE Social Media Policy. Further information about the CAL FIRE Social Media Policy can be obtained from the Information Officer. If you are uncertain, please ask. **Do not post:**

- Inappropriate information, pictures or videos
- Opinions regarding the incident or policy
- Endorsements of any kind

### PICTURES AND VIDEO OF INCIDENT

We are in a new era of media. Media no longer means the news/broadcast industry but now refers to anyone that has the capability to shoot video and or photographs and post them onto social media in a matter of minutes. Unfortunately we have seen some instances of video or photographs that have depicted unsafe, unprofessional or embarrassing circumstances which are a serious breach of ethics. When this happens it reflects poorly on all that are attached to this incident. Posting an inappropriate video, photo or blog comment could have unwanted effects. It may be unsafe to shoot photos or video and a firefighter who is concentrating on a camera can't be looking up, down and all around.

### LOST AND FOUND

The Information staff will manage *Lost and Found* items for the incident. If you have lost an item, leave your contact information and what you have lost at the Information trailer. If you have found an item on the incident, bring the item to the Information trailer.

### MAIL SERVICE

The Information staff will assist you in mailing and receiving letters and packages.

**Archaeological and Historic Properties:  
General Fire-line Guidance for the BLM Ukiah Field Office.**

**Do not compromise safety for the protection and preservation of archaeological and historic properties.  
When possible and prudent:**

1. Be on the lookout for prehistoric and historic archaeological sites. These sites typically occur adjacent to streams and springs, confluences are often especially sensitive. However, sites can occur in other areas too. The most common indicators of prehistoric sites in this area (North Coast Ranges) are scatters of shiny black obsidian flakes from tool making activities and dark midden soils. Historic-era sites include homesteads that contain foundations, rock chimneys, and stone / brick-lined wells. Historic-era mining sites are possible as well.
2. Note, that much of the area has never been surveyed for archaeological resources and many sites out there have yet to be discovered.
3. If you observe archaeological resources, flagged or unflagged, attempt to avoid with ground disturbing activities altogether.
4. If avoidance is not possible, minimize ground disturbance. Use a hand crew rather than a dozer to remove fuels from control lines that must cross site areas if possible.
5. Leave all artifacts in place as some may have been intentionally placed for religious or ceremonial reasons.
6. Note locations of discovered resources on a map, better yet, take site coordinates with a GPS. Leave information for the archaeologist so that the sites can be relocated and protected during Fire Suppression Repair. Flag the site in red if possible.
7. If you encounter a burial or other human remains, cease work in that area and contact the archaeologist immediately.

Your help preserving California's non-renewable cultural resources is appreciated.

## **FC-315 INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE**

### **INITIAL AND EXTENDED ATTACK INCIDENTS:**

The Incident Commander approves replacement request based on Engine Accountability sheets or other fire equipment inventory documents approved by the requesting resource's home unit.

- If equipment and supplies are available at the incident for replacement, the request is filled at the incident host unit.
- If equipment and supplies are unavailable at the incident for replacement AND the requesting resource is not being immediately demobilized, the hosting unit will place a resource order for needed items through appropriate channels to the servicing fire cache or vendor. The order will be shipped to the incident and replacement will take place at the host unit.
- If equipment and supplies are unavailable at the incident for replacement, AND the requesting resource is being demobilized, an FC-315 will be completed by the host unit, 'S' number issued, signed by the authorizing official and given to the requesting resource.
- On an Initial or Extended Attack incident, where a Supply Unit has not been established, approvals are limited to the Incident Commander or Agency Representative.

### **LARGE INCIDENTS WHERE A BASE HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED:**

The incident Supply Unit Leader (SPUL) will be responsible for handling incident replacement requisitions when a incident base is established. The SPUL approves replacement request based on Engine Accountability sheets or other fire equipment inventory documents approved by the requesting resource's home unit.

- If equipment and supplies are NOT available at the incident for replacement, AND the requesting resource is not being immediately demobilized, The Supply Unit will place a resource order for needed items through appropriate channels to the servicing fire cache or vendor. The order will be shipped to the incident and replacement will take place at the Supply Unit.
- If equipment and supplies are unavailable at the incident for replacement, AND the requesting resource is being demobilized, an Incident Replacement Requisition (FC-315) will be completed by the Supply Unit, a 'S' number issued, signed by the authorizing official and given to the requesting resource.
- Authorized approvals and signatures MUST be included on the FC-315. For large incidents where a Base has been established, these approvals are limited to Incident Supply Unit Leader, Logistics Section Chief, Incident Commander or Agency Representative.

Replacement orders will be based on approved OF-315's and must be processed within 30 days of control of incident. A copy of the FC-315 will be attached to all pay documents charged against an incident number.

## Instructions for Use of CDF 101 Property Certification of Location or Damage

**Document Number:** for use as a local number system or when attached to a FC-40 document.

**Location / Incident Name:** Enter the CDF facility property is assigned to. If submitting to an incident base, enter the Incident Name.

**Incident Number:** Enter the appropriate incident number

**Unit:** Enter the Unit the property is assigned to. If submitting to an incident base, enter the request number of the person certifying damage example E-320, C-14 or O-355.

**Region:** Enter the CDF Region where the property was assigned. If submitting to an incident base, enter the CDF Region responsible for the incident.

**Date:** Enter the date the P.L. or D. was completed.

**The following items were:** Enter either 'Broken', 'Left on Line', 'Damaged' or other status of the property.

**Reminder,** this form cannot be used in place of the STD-152 to certify Lost, Stolen, Worn Out or Damaged beyond repair property.

**Date of Occurrence:** Enter the date the property was broken, left on line or damaged.

**Quantity:** Enter the quantity for the line item.

**Unit of Measure:** Enter the unit of measure for the line item (example ea = each).

**CDF Stock Number:** Enter the PIN or stock number.

**Description:** Enter the description of the line item, indicate size, make, model and type. Clearly describe the item and provide adequate data to effectively identify equipment or property.

**Property Number:** Enter the CDF property number assigned to the line item, Capitalized or sensitive property must have their property number entered here.

**Location of Items:** Where is the property now (example, left on Division B night shift 8/1/04, Drop Point 2). A GPS coordinate, Station 22 or Unit Service Center may also be used to describe Location.

**Remarks:** Enter specific remarks here, how was the property damaged, what specifically is wrong with it.

**Signature of Person Certifying Occurrence as Described:**

**Signature:** The CDF Employee certifying the occurrence must sign.

**Printed Name:** Enter the printed name of the signature.

**Title:** Enter the title of the signature.

**Date:** Enter the date of the signature.

### Unit Supervisors Approval:

If submitted on an incident this section must be completed by the supervisor of the property custodian. This may be the Strike Team Leader, Division Supervisor, Receiving and Distribution Manager, Supply Unit Leader, Logistics Section Chief, Agency Representative or Incident Commander.

If submitted at the home Unit this section must also be completed by the supervisor of the property custodian. This may be a Battalion or Division Chief.

**Comments:** Supervisors may enter comments of approval or disapproval.

**Signature of Unit Administrator:** Signature of Unit Supervisor reviewing the certification described.

**Title:** Title of the signature.

**Date:** Date of the signature.

**Notes:**

This document is NOT required if exchanging property at an incident base with the exception of capitalized or sensitive property assigned a CDF property number.

This document is required as certification when submitting an MRT to your local Service Center for replacement of property.

An OF-315 (Incident Replacement Requisition) is required as authorization to purchase fire replacement items at your local Unit. This document is required when submitting an MRT to you local Service Center for fire replacement items. A CDF-101 and/or A STD-152 are required for the certification of the status of property being requisitioned for replacement.

# WATER USAGE PLAN

### *California Drought Emergency*

The following shall be considered and implemented by all fire resources as a means to provide maximum efficiencies when utilizing water resources, while minimizing the impacts to private and public water supplies. Accountability shall be maintained for all water supplies that are utilized and care should be applied to ensure proper replacement and/or reimbursement to the supplier/owner.

#### **Fireline personnel- (During mop up operations)**

- Use Pencil Hose and Garden Nozzles with Shut-Offs.
- Use Back pumps.
- Use Dry Mop-up and consolidation of heavy fuels to areas where they can burn out safely.
- Locate/Relocate Firelines to lighter fuels or natural barriers when safe.
- Set up and use portable tanks in anticipation of longer transport times for Water Tenders.
- Use of foams, gels and other water enhancers.
- Evaluate need to mop up in excess of 200 feet from fireline.

#### **Road Maintenance and Repair-**

- Monitor and water roads only when and where needed.
- Water when most effective (evening and nights).
- Use chemical treatments when available (Magchloride, Omni bind etc.).
- Consider use of tertiary or treated water.

#### **Aviation Operations-**

- Consider use of Gels, Foams and Retardants. Set up portable plants.
- Consider using Blivits and Pencil Hose for interior mop up operations as opposed to numerous bucket drops.
- Establish and use pre-use agreements for existing and known water sources.
- Use large watershed dip sites when able. Minimize use of small, static ponds and lakes.
- Maintain accountability of water used and locations of dip sites.
- Evaluate need for interior bucket drops.

#### **Private Water Supplies-**

- Notify property owner as early as possible.
- Minimize usage and develop alternative water supplies when and where appropriate.
- Track usage (meter, ICS-214, IMT3 Water Usage Reports) and develop a plan to replace water.
- Make arrangements for reimbursement and damage claims if needed.

#### **Public/Municipal Water Supplies-**

- Notify Agency as soon as possible and request a representative to the incident.
- Identify fill areas and request metering devices. Note locations on incident map.
- Use alternative or reclaimed water sources when available. Note locations on incident map.
- Make arrangements for reimbursement and damage claims if needed.

#### **Management and Supervision-**

- Use leaders intent and establish Water Conservation as a Management Objective.
- Consider complexity of water use on incidents. Establish a Water Supply Group Supervisor to coordinate additional resources to support the incident needs.
- Complete the Water Usage Report daily and turn in to Situation Unit.
- Review this check list and brief daily.

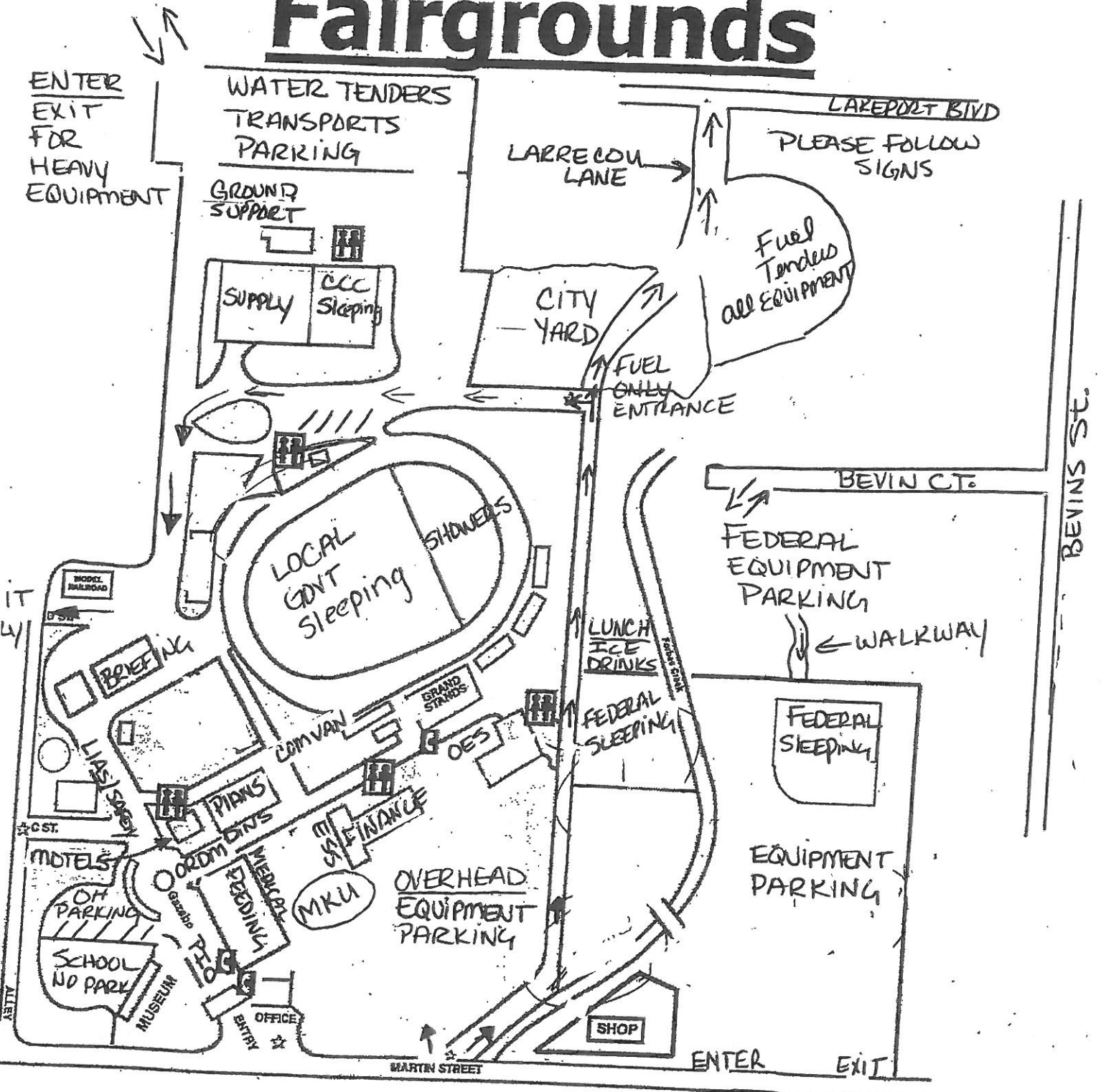

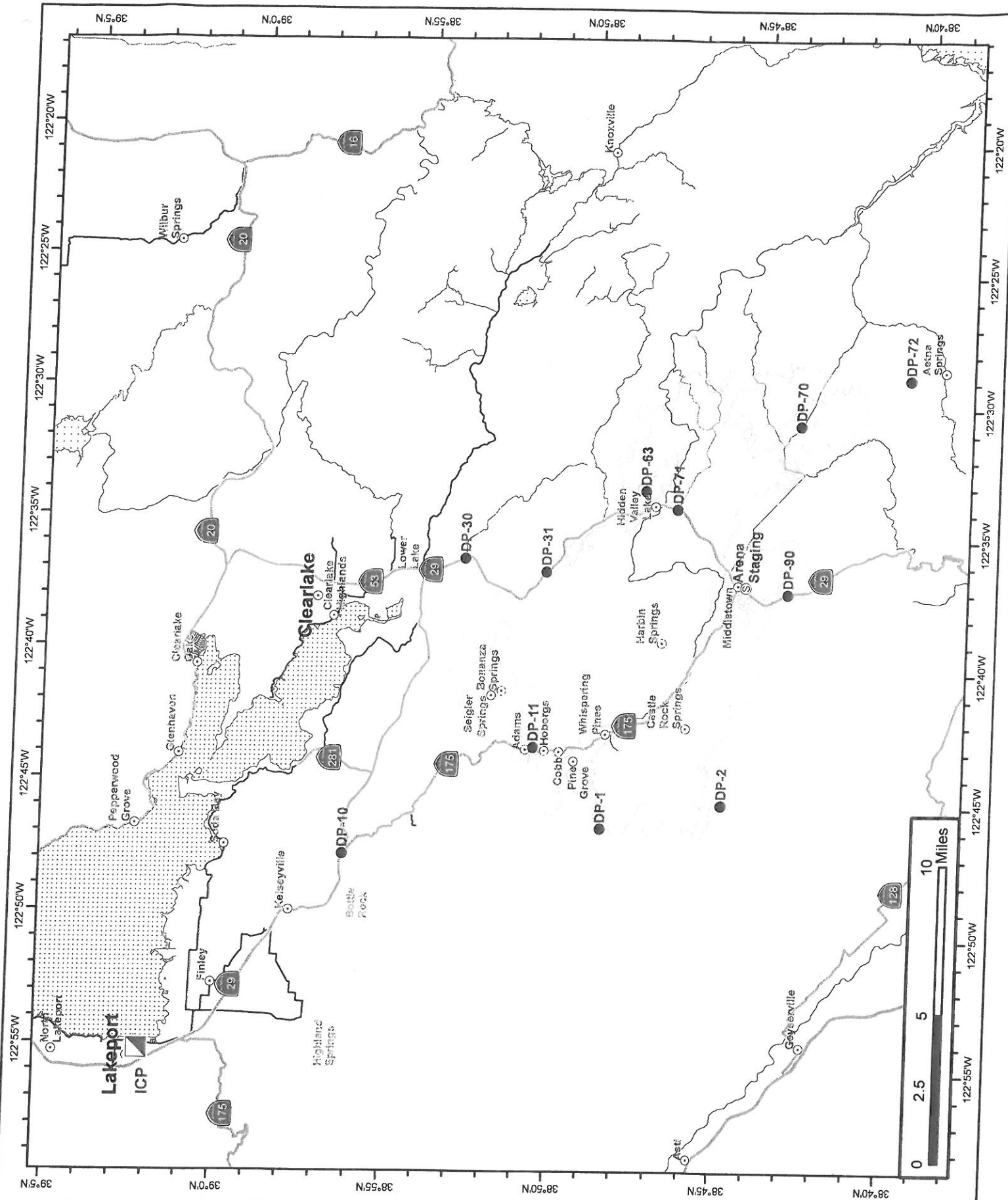
