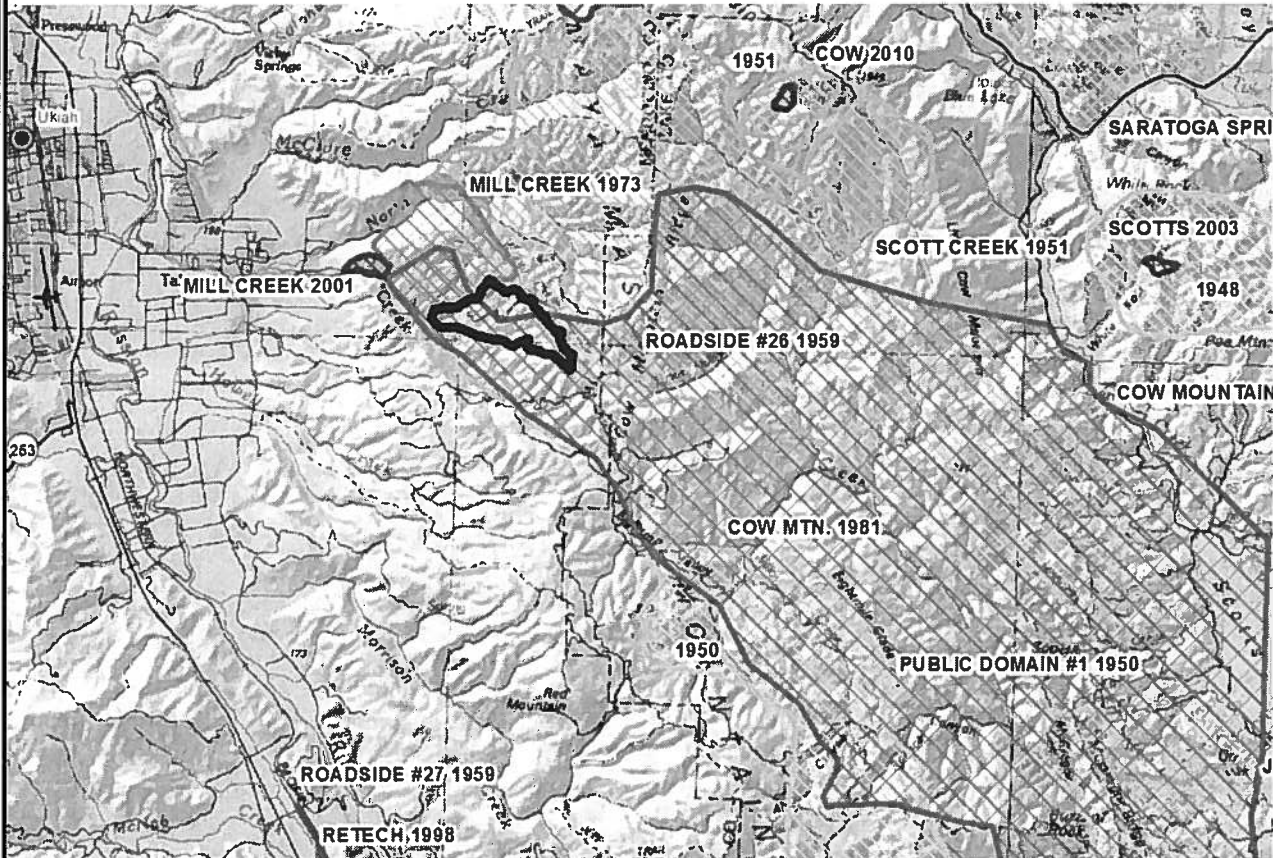

A SLOW WARMING TREND WILL CONTINUE ACROSS THE REGION THROUGH THE WEEK AS HIGH PRESSURE BUILDS INTO THE PACIFIC NORTHWEST. THE WARMING ALOFT WILL KEEP THE MARINE RELATIVELY SHALLOW THROUGH MOST OF THE WEEK. SLIGHT INTRUSION IS STILL EXPECTED UP THE EEL AND VAN DUZEN THE NEXT FEW DAYS HOWEVER. WINDS FOR THE MOST PART WILL BE DIURNAL AND TERRAIN DRIVEN...EXCEPT OVER THE EXPOSED COASTAL RIDGES WHERE STRONG NORTHERLIES AND NORTHEASTERLIES WILL OCCUR DURING THE NIGHT AND MORNING HOURS.
