

DISCUSSION: Critical fire weather conditions continue today! Strong winds with low humidities will continue this morning, especially over the ridges. Winds diminish late this morning and afternoon, but it will remain very dry this afternoon,

WEATHER SUMMARY

RED FLAG Warning will run through this morning. Expect a north wind to linger over the fire in the morning and low relative humidity to remain throughout the day. As the high pressure moves to the east, the winds will transition and you may experience a shift by the afternoon. Cooler temperatures will aid in fire suppression but low relative humidity will have a direct impact on light flashy fuels. Overnight recovery will be fair on the ridges and good in the valleys. This fire has seen substantial growth **without** high winds and low humidity in extremely receptive fuels.

The fire is burning in Oak woodland with a heavy grass load. Heavy pockets of brush are more promenade north aspects and contain large amounts of dead loading due to years of drought conditions. Live fuel moisture are at critical levels and the 100 hour fuels are at historic lows. Energy Release Component are above the 90th percentile and at historic highs.

SPECIFIC

<u>Atlas</u>

Fire growth has slowed slightly in the last operational period but moderate growth continues mainly on the north and east side of the incident. Predicated north winds have not surfaced at the time of forecast but situational awareness is imperative for all operations. In areas where wind and slope align, fire spread will be critical and reaction time to safety zones MUST be a part of every plan. Long range spotting may be present in the morning into receptive fuels. Down dead oaks will increase rollout potential and slope reversal in steep drainages will increase fire behavior. Look for the fire to continue to burn toward Lake Berryessa to the northeast and toward Hwy 128 south of Lake Berryessa. Expected rates of spread in the grass to be 225 ch/h with flame lengths to be at 28 ft. Rates of spread in the brush will be 150 ch/h and flame lengths at 22 ft. In wind, prone areas rates of spread and flame lengths could double predicted values.

Partrick

An influx of resources and favorable weather have aided in suppression efforts and the fire showed only moderate growth in the previous operational period. Predicted winds have not surfaced at the time of forecast but if winds develop, the fire may push to the southwest in the into Sonoma and Vineburg. Predicted high winds will remain in the area for the morning hours and high fire growth potential remains high. Division M will have the most opportunity for fire growth toward Las Amigas Rd to the south and Hwy 12 to the west. The Norrbom fire to the north may influence or impact Division N if the wind becomes aligned and line is not contained. Expected rates of spread in the grass to be 215 ch/h with flame lengths to be at 25 ft. Rates of spread in the brush will be 140 ch/h and flame lengths at 22 ft. In wind, prone areas rates of spread and flame lengths could double predicted values.

AIR OPERATIONS

- Identify where crews are in the area before drops.
- Smoke conditions may limit air operations
- High winds in the morning may make drops ineffective

SAFETY

- Spots willestablish rapidly so escape routes must be short and effective. 4x flame length separation distance minimum.
- When developing strategies and tactics, safety zones and escape routes you should be evaluating potential fire behavior (worst case scenario), not just observed fire behavior.
- Firefighter and public life safety will the top priority for all emergency responders.


