Unfortunately we have seen some instances of video or photographs that have depicted unsafe, unprofessional or embarrassing circumstances which are a serious breach of ethics. When this happens it reflects poorly on all that are attached to this incident. Posting an inappropriate video, photo or blog comment could have unwanted effects. It may be unsafe to shoot photos or video and a firefighter who is concentrating on a camera can't be looking up, down and all around.

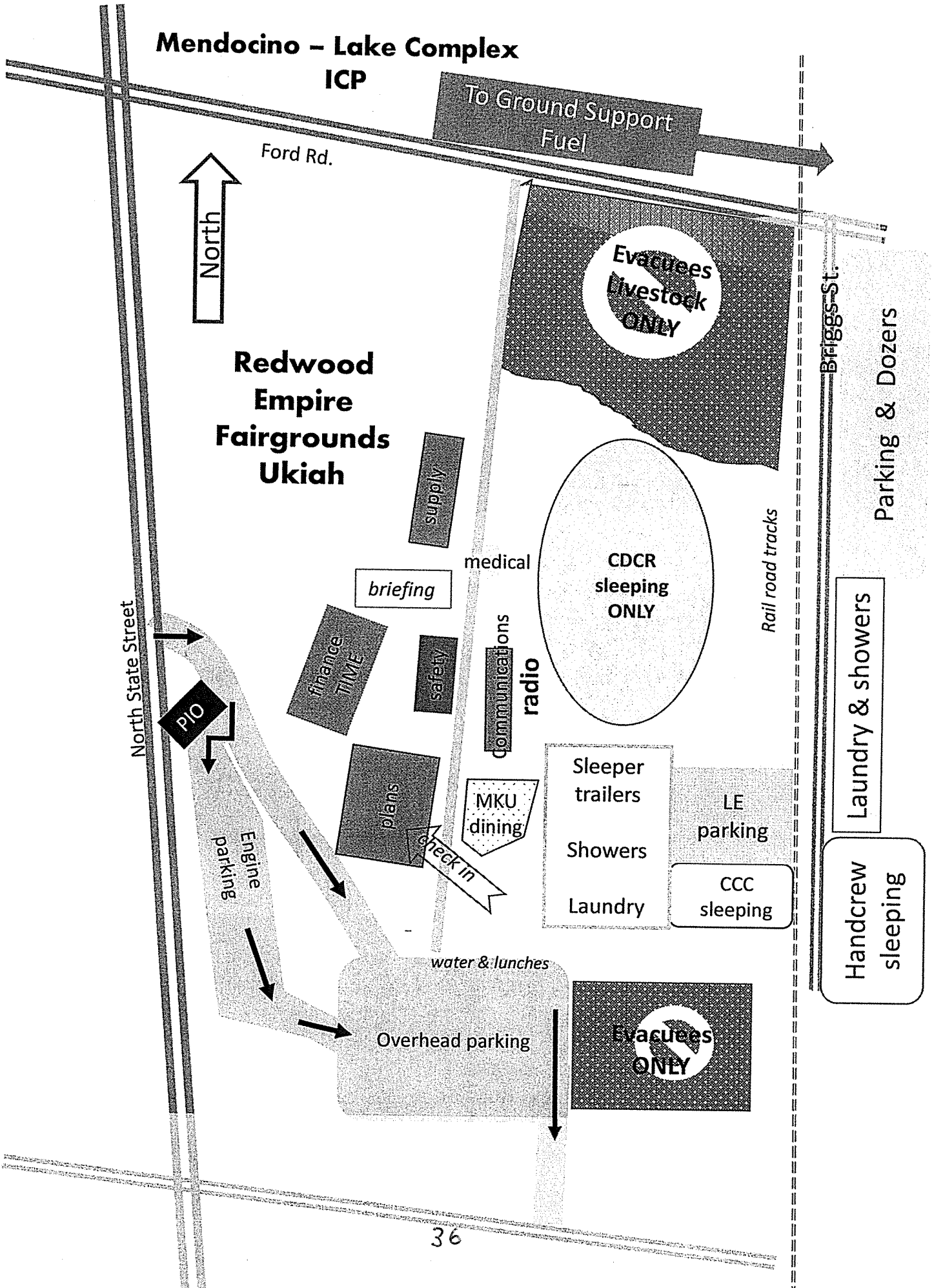

Mendocino - Lake Complex ICP

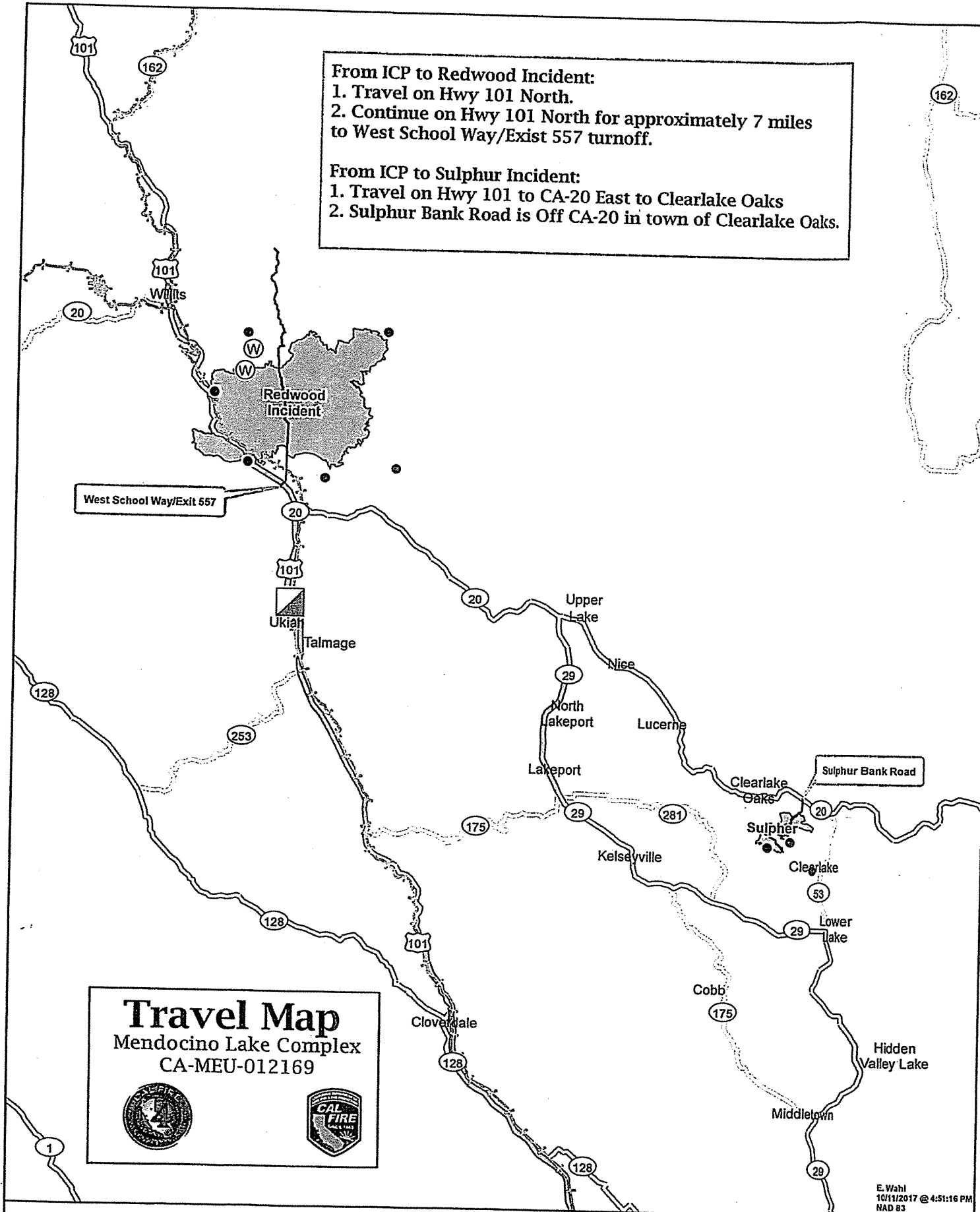


From ICP to Redwood Incident:

2. Continue on Hwy 101 North for approximately 7 miles to West School Way/Exit 557.

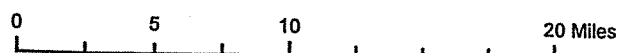
From ICP to Sulphur Incident:
