Moderate to heavy rains continue through the day Friday along with gusty southwest winds. A Flash Flood Watch and Wind Advisory remain in effect through Friday at 1600 for the burn area. Rainfall totals for the event remain up to 6 inches with locally higher amounts possible for the north and east sides of the fire. Rain becomes light to moderate Friday night, ending by 1200 Saturday with dry conditions expected for the next few days. Gusty northeast winds develop across the ridgelines and in wind-aligned drainages beginning Saturday night as a ridge of high pressure builds aloft. Next round of showers move into the area as soon as Tuesday.

WEATHER FORECAST FOR FRIDAY: ... HEAVY RAIN AND GUSTY SOUTH- SOUTHWEST WINDS...

#### HAZARD TREES

FIRE DAMAGED TREES IN and AROUND the FIRE AREA

#### Watch Out

- Working under and around conifers and oak trees
- Be aware of snags and widow makers
- · Fire weakened and drought stressed trees

#### Mitigation

- Be vigilant and alert, "Look-Up" when working under and around any trees
- Post lookouts when necessary to mitigate a hazard within a stand of trees
- Isolate HAZARD trees with red and white, "THREE STRIPES you're out" flagging

#### **INCLEMENT WEATHER**

INCREASED POTENTIAL FOR ACCIDENT DUE TO RAIN AND WIND

#### Watch Out

- Vehicle maintenance records and annual maintenance
- First rains for this year / Wet and Oil slick roads in and around the fire perimeter
- The dirt roads within and around the fire perimeter are known for thick and deep mud production

#### **Mitigation**

- Confirm your vehicle maintenance is up-to-date and perform a daily safety inspection prior to going out on the line
- Drive for the conditions and not the speed limit, be cognizant of roadside workers
- Keep fire engines and other heavy equipment on asphalt and improved roads, pre-plan for smaller use to make emergency access to remote areas.

#### CITIZEN REPOPULATION

**EVACUEES WILL BE RE-ENTERING FIRE EFFECTED AREAS** 

#### Watch Out

- Increased holiday weekend traffic and distracted drivers
- Potentially highly emotional citizens as repopulation continues and the reality of loss this community has suffered
- · Unknown hazards by citizens re-entering burned areas

#### **Mitigation**

- Drive slowly and defensively. Calm the citizens, calm yourself. Set the example
- Remain patient and compassionate as we continue to be this areas fire department. Drive slow and be courteous, cautious and caring when travelling the area
- Be diligent and supportive to assist residence re-entering their properties

## ARE YOU IN AN AREA SUBJECT TO FLASH FLOODING, MUD OR DEBRIS?

#### Watch Out For

- Rapidly Changing Conditions Expect the Unexpected!
- Increase water flows or raising waters
- Tree fall during storm conditions
- The need to support early and immediate evacuation of civilians
- One way in One Way Out Situations
- Washouts and Sinkholes
- Mud, silt and reactivated retardant causing road slick hazards

#### **Mitigation**

- Avoid entering the water if you must, you must wear a PFD!
- React early to increasing flows and raising waters escape early
- Don't be Complacent these are not routine emergencies don't under estimate the power of hydraulics
- React to unstable looking conditions Mud Slides, Leaning Trees and undermined roads
- LCES Early!

L-ookouts posted - Post early with a lookout that understands the situation

C-ommunications (Establish a Plan and make it known using Face to Face and Radios)

E-scape Routes are recognized and made known to emergency personnel. In Flood conditions, consider shorter routes and earlier trigger points – Get to high ground

**S**-afety Zones are identified and large enough to assemble lots of equipment and personnel, perform a PAR

 Be on the lookout of other hazards such as hazardous materials, contaminated water, large debris in current and electrical hazards as examples







