

WEATHER DISCUSSION: ...HOT...DRY...AND UNSTABLE CONDITIONS...

Hot, dry, and unstable conditions expected again for today. Heavy smoke inversion will continue over the fire area for the next several days, keeping temperatures cooler and providing shading for fuels. The atmosphere remains primed for unstable conditions (Haines 6) for plume dominated fire if there is any clear air—along with alignment with fuels and topography. If a plume develops, the fire can produce it's own weather, including strong localized winds and whirlwinds. Northwest winds will kick in this evening and continue into the early morning hours with north winds (drainage) by sunrise, coming out of the drainages. A slight cool down is expected for this weekend and into early next week.

WEATHER FORECAST FOR TUESDAY: ...SMOKE INVERSION WITH LIMITED CLEARING...

WEATHER: Sunny, smokey. Smoke heaviest for Branch 1&4. Some clearing for Branch 2&3 in the PM.

MAX TEMPERATURES: 95-102°F. **LITTLE CHANGE**

MIN HUMIDITY: 12-17%. **UP 3%**

EYE-LEVEL WIND: Down-drainage 2-5 mph in the morning, becoming Updrainage 3-6 mph in the afternoon.

20-FOOT WIND:

SLOPE/VALLEY - North 4-8 mph in the morning with gusts up to 15 mph, then becoming Southeast 5-10 mph in the afternoon with gusts to 15 mph.

RIDGETOP- Northwest 10-15 mph gusts 25 mph in the morning, then Southeast 5-10 gusts 15 mph.

HAINES INDEX: 6

TUESDAY NIGHT: ...BREEZY EVENING NORTHWEST WINDS WITH POOR RECOVERY...

WEATHER: Clear and smokey.

MIN TEMPERATURES: 70-78°F. **LITTLE CHANGE**

MAX HUMIDITY: 45-55% near 70% on valley floor. **LITTLE CHANGE**

EYE-LEVEL WIND: Northwest 4-6 mph with gusts to 10 mph in the evening, becoming North 2-5 mph after 0200.

Shifting variable winds, hot and dry with fair humidity recovery overnight.
See Weather Forecast in IAP.

OUTPUTS

GENERAL: **Conditions exist for Plume Dominated Fire Behavior**

Fuels are critically dry and will take considerable time to react to mild increases in forecast humidity.

The topography in the fire area is steep and rugged. The drainages can be narrow and will funnel predominant winds. Ridgetops are also narrow, expect slop overs and spots on fire challenged ridgetops.

In the absence of weather conditions outside the forecast or extreme fire behavior conditions expect:

SPECIFIC:

Branch I

Smoldering with pockets of activity possible. Keep alert to structural hazards and ash pots.

Branch II

If the fire moves southward it will enter the "Arbuckle Wind" corridor. Anticipate more free air conditions from the west/northwest starting approximately 1700-1100. Fire may move with down canyon winds to the south, expect the largest growth to occur overnight as down canyon winds increase. Fuel types convert to lighter and flashier grasses to the south.

Branch III

The fire will follow terrain on both sides of County Line Road. East slope solar heating with upslope/up canyon winds may test established lines to the west. All areas are subject to roll-out and subsequent runs with crown fire up drainages. Keep alert to spot fires below in multiple directions due to variable winds.

Branch IV

Growth to the North will see a fuel type conversion into timber and heavy slash models. Most activity should remain surface fire. Torching could occur contributing to increased spotting distances. Look for areas of fuels treatment, timber harvest or previous fire activity for safety or control objectives. Areas closer to the Sacramento River will see creeping/backing/smoldering with pockets of activity possible. Roll-out potential below line.

AIR OPERATIONS:


Best chances for clear air will be on the West side of the fire.

Mixing height: 3-5,000 ft., Transport winds: SSW 10mph, Sunrise 0606, Sunset 2028.


SAFETY

Backing fire may have areas of roll-out leading to rapid up slope runs.



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

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MAJOR HAZARDS AND RISKS

- **REPOPULATION:** Be aware and respectful of the public returning to their homes.
- **RE-ENERGIZED POWER TRANSMISSION LINES:** Be aware that lines may be live.

Hazardous Trees and Snags: Be alert of snags due to tree mortality and drought. Crews are working in a very hazardous area with numerous dead trees, stay diligent and flag hazardous areas. Avoid taking breaks under trees.

Hydration/Nutrition/Fatigue: Drink plenty of fluids throughout the day and eat accordingly. Address dehydration and fatigue concerns immediately upon symptom onset.

Fire Behavior: Fuels are drought stricken and are receptive to fire spread. A small amount of wind on this dry fuel changes the game dramatically!! Be alert to changes in wind direction and expect changes in fire behavior.

Driving: Steep, narrow, dusty roads throughout fire area. Maintain safe following distances and appropriate speed when traversing roads. Flag unstable roads and other hazards that may be encountered while driving.

Weather: Above average temperatures will continue, reassess your personnel throughout the day. Take rehab breaks, and order sling loads early to stay on top of crew hydration. Be aware of changes in temps and RH's, work at an appropriate pace for conditions presented.

Communication: Confirm all personnel have latest clone, test prior to going to line. Utilize human repeaters as necessary. Try alternative channels if unsuccessful with primary.

Resource Accountability: Maintain prompt communications with your forces, your supervisor and adjoining forces. Give clear instructions and ensure they are understood.

Incident Within Incident (IWI):

Review procedures on 206 at Divisional Breakouts and tailgate safety briefings.

Marijuana Grows: As fire personnel enter into Branch II and III, beware of large marijuana grows and chemicals in the area. If chemicals catch fire take appropriate actions to stay a safe distance away. Flag these areas to prevent accidental entry by fire personnel.

STRUCTURE DEFENSE GUIDE

STRUCTURE TRIAGE DECISION PROCESS (S-FACTS)

SURVIVAL

- Initial Assessment: can you survive here? **If not, LEAVE NOW!**
- Is there a Safety Zone nearby? **If not, LEAVE NOW! (IRPG)**
- Do you have a viable Escape Route?
- What is the decision point at which you will leave based on fire behavior and rate of spread?
- Is there a Temporary Refuge Area (TRA) on site? **If not, LEAVE NOW!**
 - Preplanned area for immediate, temporary refuge
 - Use of fire shelter should not be necessary
 - Is there a viable Escape Route to the TRA or Safety Zone?
- Is "Prep and Go" tactic an option?
- Do you have communications with your supervisor and adjoining forces?
- If safety issues cannot be mitigated, **LEAVE NOW!**

FIRE ENVIRONMENT

- Can you survive based on current and expected fire behavior? **If not, LEAVE NOW!**
- Look up, Look Down, Look Around Indicators:
 - Fuels (characteristics, moisture, temperature)
 - What will the intensity of the fire be when it arrives?
 - How long will it take to consume the fuels?
 - Wind
 - Current speed/direction
 - Expect changing winds
 - Terrain
 - Are you in a chute, chimney, or saddle? **If yes, LEAVE NOW!**
 - Is wind in alignment with topography?
 - What is your position relative to topography?
 - Are you mid slope or on top of a ridge?
 - Atmospheric Stability
 - Fire Behavior (requires constant monitoring)
 - Spotting, crowning, sheeting, rate of spread?
 - Flame length and height?
- Other weather considerations:
 - What is the current relative humidity?
 - Is there an expected change?
 - Are thunderstorms forecasted?

ACCESS

- Is access compatible with time and distance factors necessary to utilize as an Escape Route to a Safety Zone?
 - Road surface adequate for speed necessary?
 - Adequate width?
 - Turnaround/turnouts?
 - Bridges within limits for fire apparatus?
 - Drainage ditches/culverts?
 - Steep grades?
 - Is there a safe place to spot apparatus?

CONSTRUCTION/CLEARANCE

- Does the structure have adequate defensible space, based on topography, fuels, and current and expected fire behavior?
- Can defensible space problems be mitigated quickly?
- Will building materials and yard clutter compromise safety?
- Is the construction wood siding or shake shingle roof?
- Are there vent openings, open eaves, large glass windows facing fire front, decks with vegetation below?
 - Will ember intrusion through attic or foundation vents be a problem?
- What are the contents in the garage and outbuildings?
- Are there hazardous materials present?
- Are there propane tanks, fuel tanks, or power lines?
- Is there an adequate water supply nearby?
- Are additional resources needed to mitigate issues?
- Consider "Prep and Go" or "Prep and Defend" tactics

TIME CONSTRAINTS

- Is there time for an adequate size up of the structure defense problem?
- Is there time to mitigate safety concerns?
- Is there time and adequate resources to properly prepare and defend the structure?
- Is there time to escape, utilizing Escape Routes, to a Safety Zone? **If not, LEAVE NOW!**

STAY OR GO

- Tactical decision based on the S-FACTS
- Is it safe to stay? If no, utilize "Check and Go" tactic
- Is there time to prepare the structure for defense and what will the fire behavior be when the fire gets here?
- "Prep and Go" or "Fire Front Following" tactics should be used when it is not safe to "Prep and Defend"

STRUCTURE TRIAGE CATEGORIES

Not-Threatened

- Safety Zone nearby and TRA present at structure
- Construction features/defensible space make the structure unlikely to ignite
- Residents may/may not have evacuated

Threatened Defensible

- Safety Zone nearby and TRA present at structure
- Construction features/defensible space require structure defense tactics during fire front impact
- Residents may/may not have evacuated

Threatened non-Defensible

- Lack of adequate Safety Zone nearby
- Structure cannot be safely defended
- Residents must be evacuated

Remember, we don't want photographs or videos that depict unsafe, unprofessional or embarrassing circumstances, which are a serious breach of ethics.

The gravity of this event is large. Many of us have been impacted by the events that have occurred as well as past incidents.

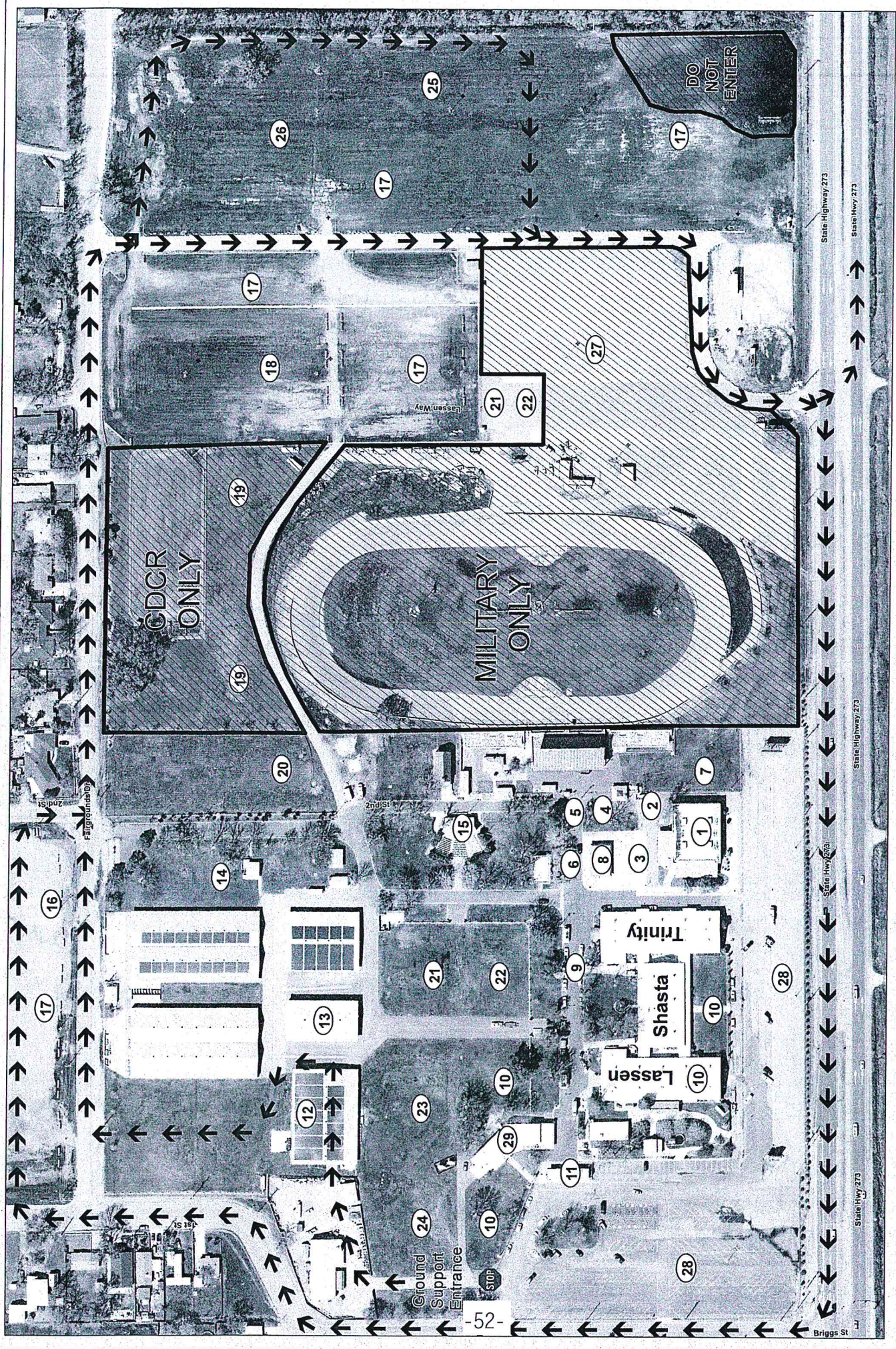
A peer support team has been assembled and Peers are available at the ICP. The Peer Support contact number is (916)-591-9004, which is available 24/7.

Irritability, lack of sleep, quick to anger, withdrawal, above average tobacco use, an increase in negative coping mechanisms such as excessive alcohol and/or substance abuse. You might experience lack of appetite, isolate yourself, and various other unexplained responses to normal every day events.

You may not be experiencing these symptoms now or during this fire incident. However, you may find yourself experiencing them when you return to your home or unit. You may find yourself being triggered by a past event that has impacted you, while assigned to future incidents. A sight, sound, smell, or touch could trigger a memory that previously existed, but you may not have been aware of.

If you find yourself in this situation and need to talk to someone contact your Employee Assistance Program (EAP). EAP programs are here to help. It is important to be able to talk to someone and get stuff off your chest vs carrying this around for your career.

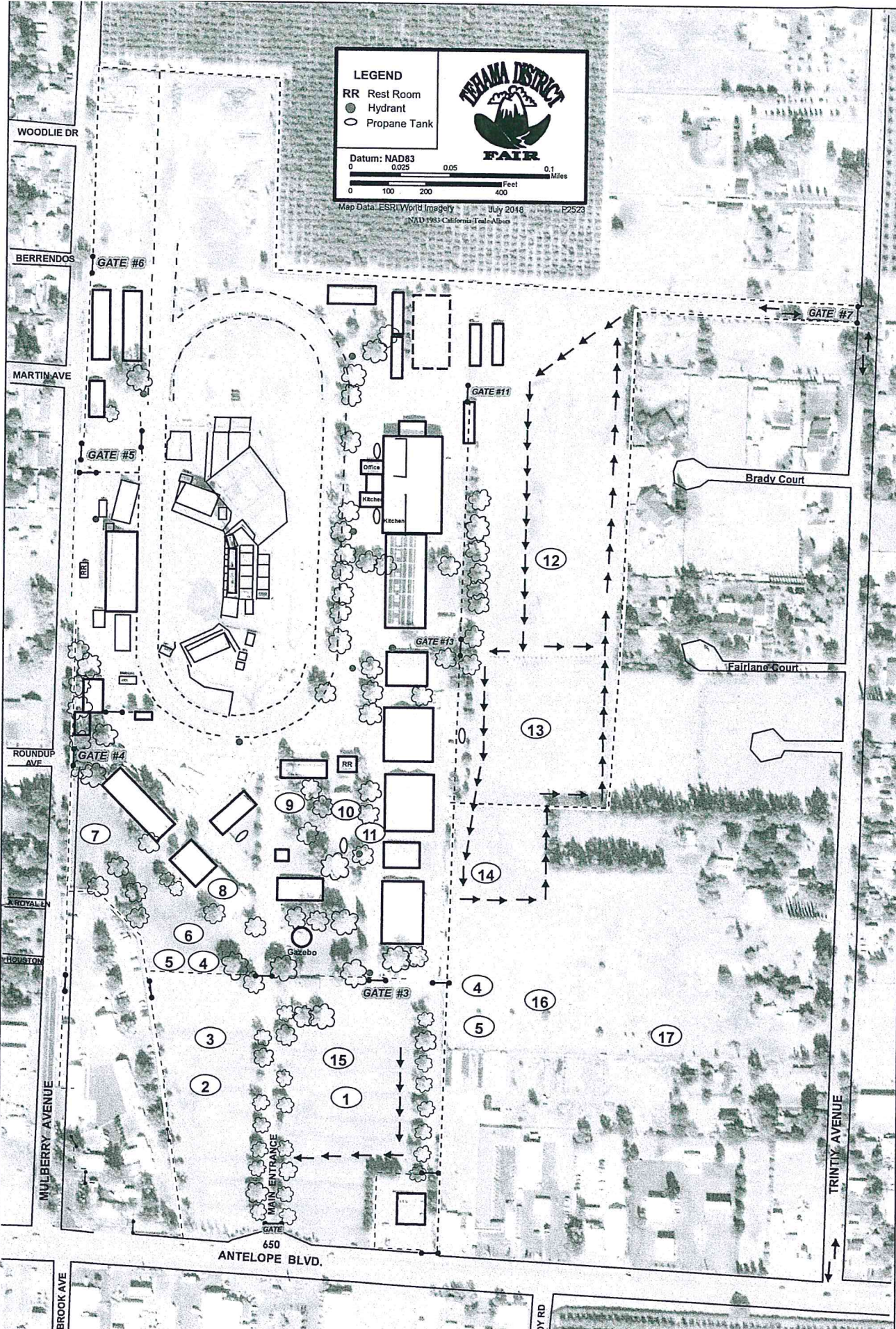

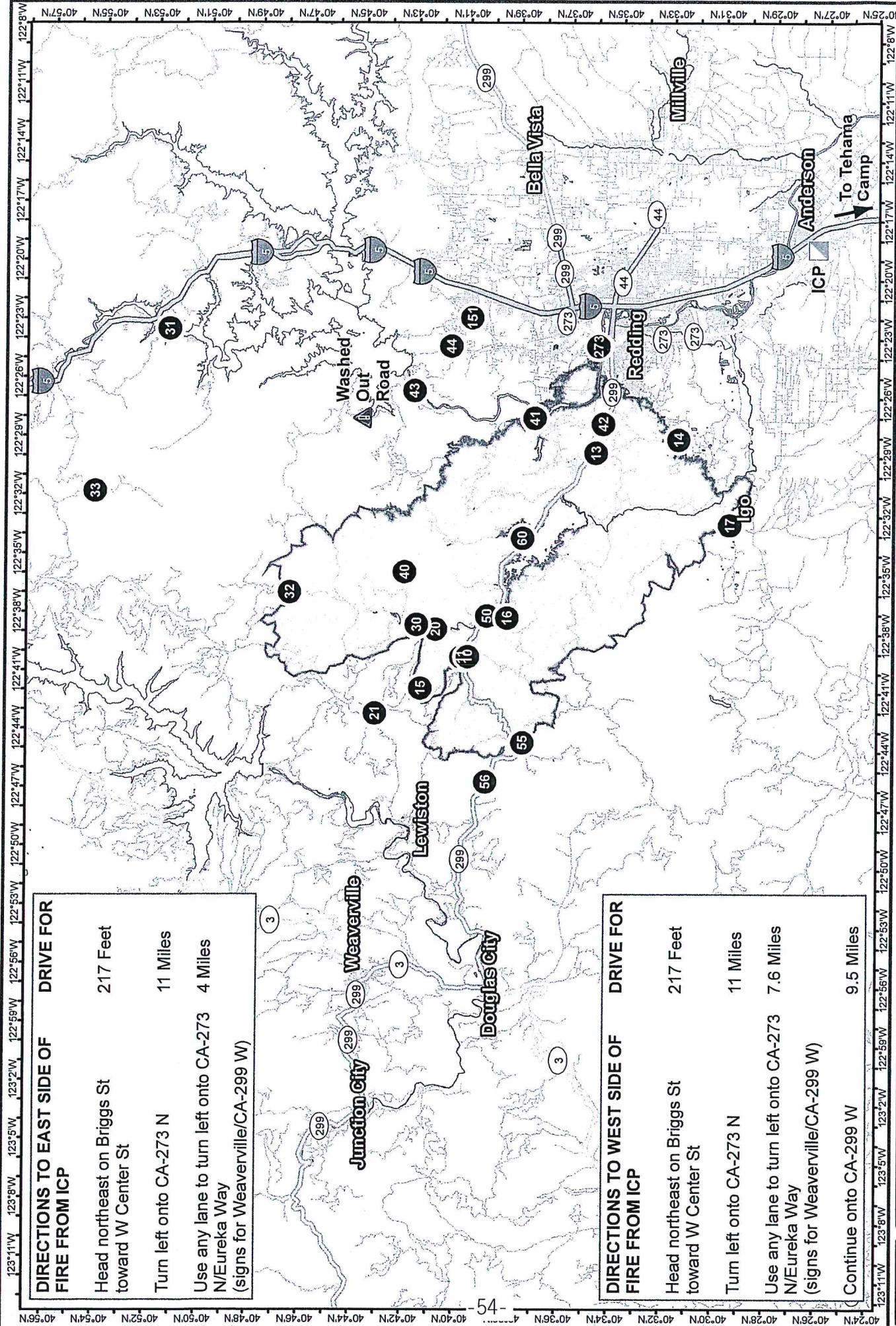

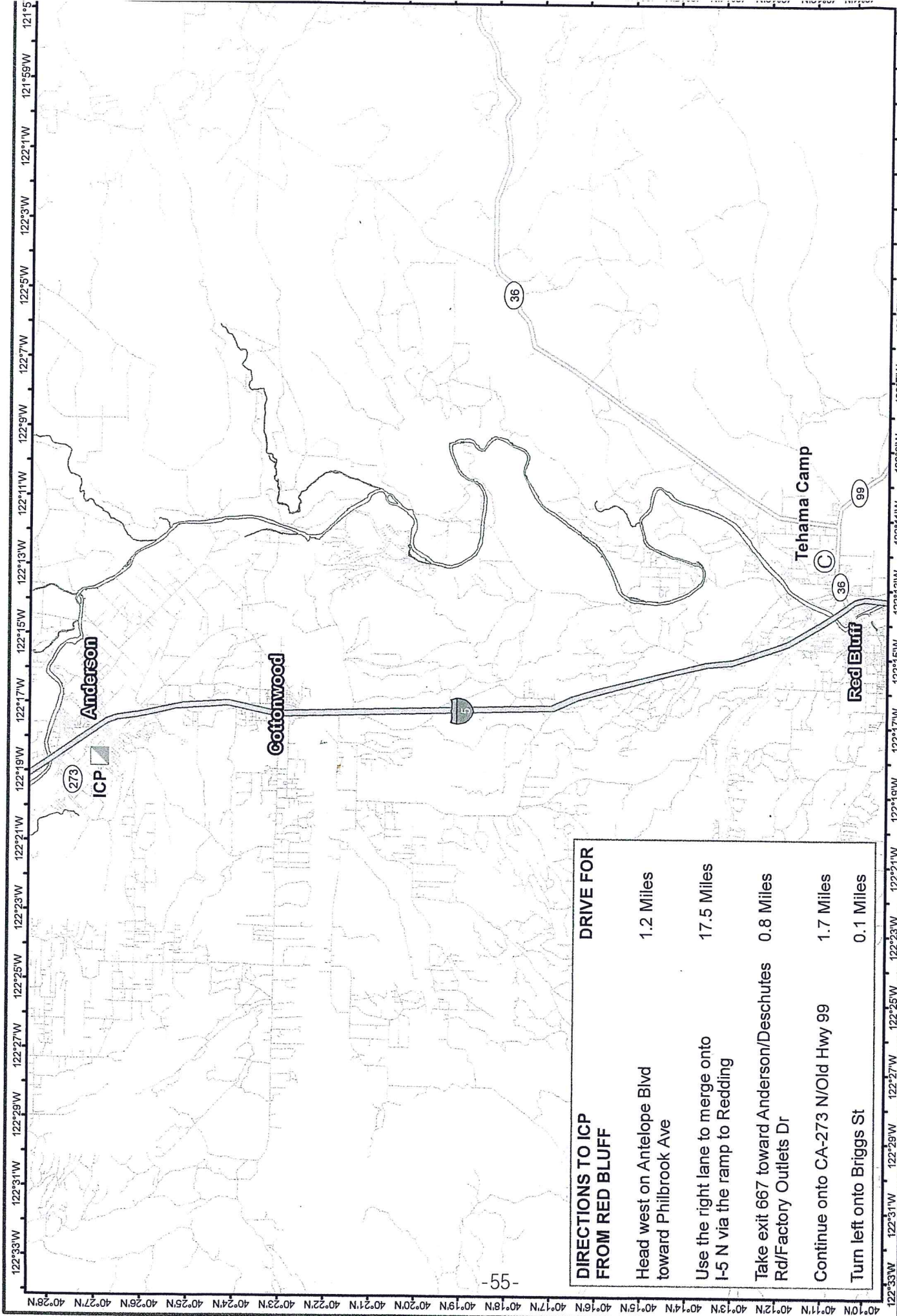
