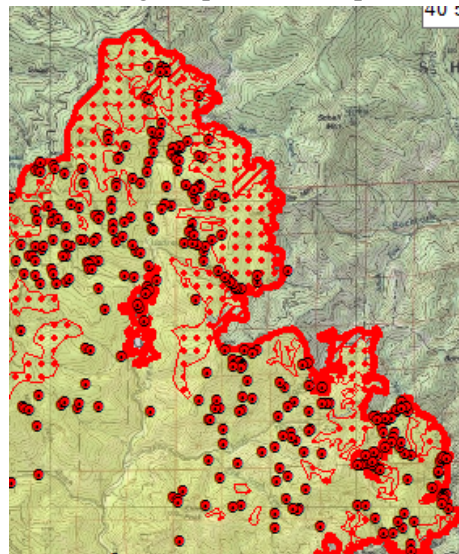
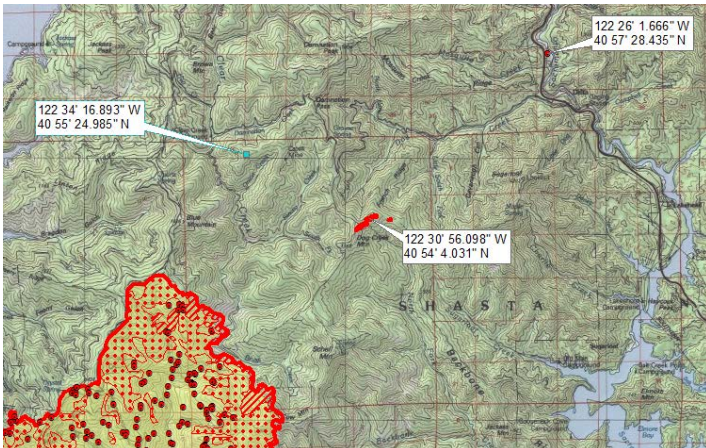

Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:

I started my interpretation with the 08/08/2018 fire perimeter provided by incident. New growth – 2,683 acres. The fire grew mainly to the north, northeast, and southwest. Burnout operations were visible to the north, near Onion Creek and Dog Creek Mountain.

Yellow is 8/08/2018's IR heat perimeter. Red line is current IR heat perimeter.

North and northeast growth; in DIV M,N,O, P Fire continues to grow to the north and east. There is intense heat as well as scattered heat in this area and some isolated heat sources. Burnout operations were visible to the north, near Onion Creek and Dog Creek Mountain. Isolated heat spot near the Sacramento River again, possible camp fire.

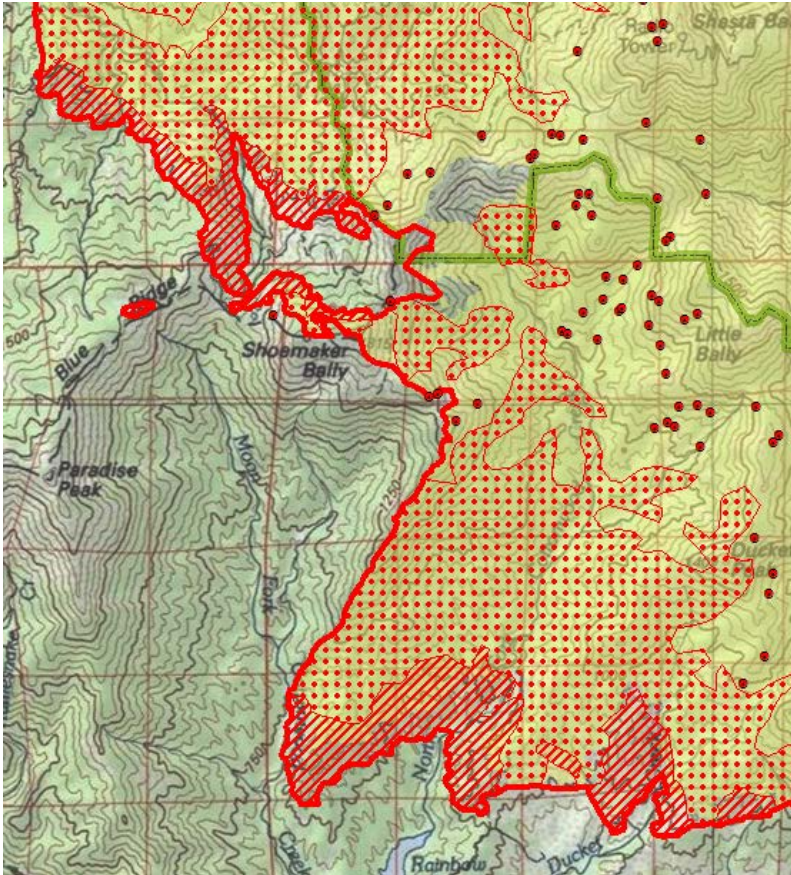

Western Perimeter – The fire is stable along the west with areas of Isolated heat and Scattered heat.

East / South Eastern Perimeter: – Fire line was stable along this side. Showing quite a bit of isolated heat in this area and small patches of scattered heat.

There is additional growth and intense/scattered heat on the Southwest side toward Rainbow Lake and Cottonwood Creek as expected. As well as around Shoemaker Bally.
