

.DISCUSSION...Winds will shift to the north to northwest over the fire and remain so through much of the next week. Expect mostly clear, warm and dry conditions with breezy afternoon winds to continue for much of the week, with very warm temperatures mid to late next week. Inversions are expected each night, but they should break by roughly 9 or 10 AM each day. No rain is likely over the next week, but some isolated thunderstorms may be possible in the region next weekend.

RED FLAG CONDITIONS ENDED. WINDS SHIFTING TO NORTH NORTHWEST OVER THE NEXT SEVERAL DAYS. CLEAR, WARM AND DRY FOR MUCH OF THE NEXT WEEK. SEE SPOT FORECAST.

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL:

WINTER PRECIPITATION IN THIS AREA WAS 50% OF NORMAL. FUEL MOISTURE IN THE LIVE BRUSH FUELS IS SLIGHTLY BELOW NORMAL FOR THIS TIME OF YEAR. MANZANITA FUEL MOISTURE IS 80% WHICH IS CONSIDERED CRITICAL. THE ENERGY RELEASE COMPONENT OF THE NATIONAL FIRE DANGER RATING SYSTEM IS APPROACHING HISTORIC HIGH FOR THIS DATE. PROBABILITY OF IGNITION NEAR 100% MID AFTERNOON IN FULL SUN. DAY LENGTH NEARLY 15 HOURS.

SPECIFIC:

BRANCH II

THIS PART OF THE FIRE IS APPROACHING CONTAINMENT. SPOTTING POTENTIAL IN THE HORN BROOK AREA IS STILL VERY HIGH. AREAS OF OAKS AND PINES THAT ARE UNDER BURNED MAY FALL WITHOUT WARNING. POST A LOOKOUT WHEN MOPPING UP IN THESE STANDS OF TREES.

BRANCH III

FUELS IN THIS BRANCH ARE THE HEAVIEST ON THE FIRE WITH MIXED BRUSH/GRASS AND JUNIPERS AND CONIFERS. SOME SINGLE TREE AND GROUP TORCHING WILL OCCUR IN FIRE RUNS THAT ARE ALIGNED WITH SUN, WIND AND SLOPE.

BRANCH IV

THIS BRANCH HAS THE GREATEST POTENTIAL FOR GROWTH TODAY DUE TO THE CHANGE IN WIND DIRECTION. THE SOUTHEAST SIDE OF THE FIRE COULD MOVE THROUGH GRASS FUELS TOWARD THE KLAMATH RIVER. ACCESS WILL BE BETTER AS THE FIRE MOVES THAT DIRECTION.

SMOKE INVERSIONS POSSIBLE IN THE KLAMATH AND COTTONWOOD DRAINAGES IN THE MORNING HOURS.

SAFETY

- FIRE IN GRASS FUELS CAN MOVE INCREDIBLY FAST. REACTION TIME IS SHORT. DO NOT GET IN THE GREEN AHEAD OF A MOVING GRASS FIRE
- MONITOR THE FIRE COLUMN DEVELOPMENT THROUGH THE DAY. IF YOU FEEL A SUDDEN CALM OR FEEL RAIN DROPS IT COULD MEAN THE COLUMN IS COLLAPSING AND DOWNBURSTS MAY RESULT. WINDS WILL BE ERRATIC.

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SNAGS

TREES ARE DROUGHT STRESSED, BEATLE IMPACTED AND FIRE DAMAGED

Watch Out

- Ground cover has burned loosening the stability of the root system
- Some of the fire area is within the tree mortality area
- Large oak trees are drought stressed

Mitigation

- Remove the hazard if safe to do so
- Flag and report the hazard to personnel
- Be alert while working and driving in hazard area

GENERAL ILLNESS

FATIGUE, HOT WEATHER, HARD EXHAUSTIVE WORK PUTS US AT RISK

Watch Out

- **Hot weather** causes dehydration, heat exhaustion and serious medical emergencies
- **Hard exhaustive work** increases core temperature, weakens the body's ability to function healthy and causes fatigue
- **Fatigue** Causes poor judgement and decreased work performance affecting safety

Mitigation

- Proper nutrition, rest and hydration reduces fatigue and exhaustion emergencies
- Drink plenty of water and eat right- START EARLY – reduce caffeine input
- Take breaks throughout the work-period and take measures to cool down

TOUGH COUNTRY TO WORK IN!

Watch Out

- Steep slopes may cause rolling material hazards
- This terrain will cause quick, unexpected upslope fire behavior
- Significant slip hazard exists throughout the incident

Mitigation

- Post lookouts and monitor changes in fire behavior
- Watch out in areas with steep slopes, watch your footing and drive appropriately
- Listen for rolling rocks and boulders and 'yell out' to others around you



EVACUATION NOTIFICATION SUMMARY

LEVEL 1 – Be Ready

Residents should be aware of the danger that exists in their area, monitor emergency services websites and local media outlets for information. This is the time for preparation and precautionary movement of persons with special needs, mobile property and (under certain circumstances) pets and livestock. If conditions worsen, emergency services personnel may contact you via an emergency notification system.

LEVEL 2 – Be Set

YOU MUST PREPARE TO LEAVE AT A MOMENTS NOTICE

This level indicates there is significant danger to your area, and residents should either voluntarily relocate to a shelter or with family/friends outside of the affected area, or if choosing to remain, to be ready to evacuate at a moment's notice.

Residents MAY have time to gather necessary items, but doing so is at their own risk.

THIS MAY BE THE ONLY NOTICE THAT YOU RECEIVE

Emergency services cannot guarantee that they will be able to notify you if conditions rapidly deteriorate. Area media services will be asked to broadcast periodic updates.

LEVEL 3 – Leave Immediately

Danger to your area is current or imminent, and you should evacuate immediately. If you choose to ignore this advisement, you must understand that emergency services may not be available to assist you further. DO NOT delay leaving to gather any belongings or make efforts to protect your home.

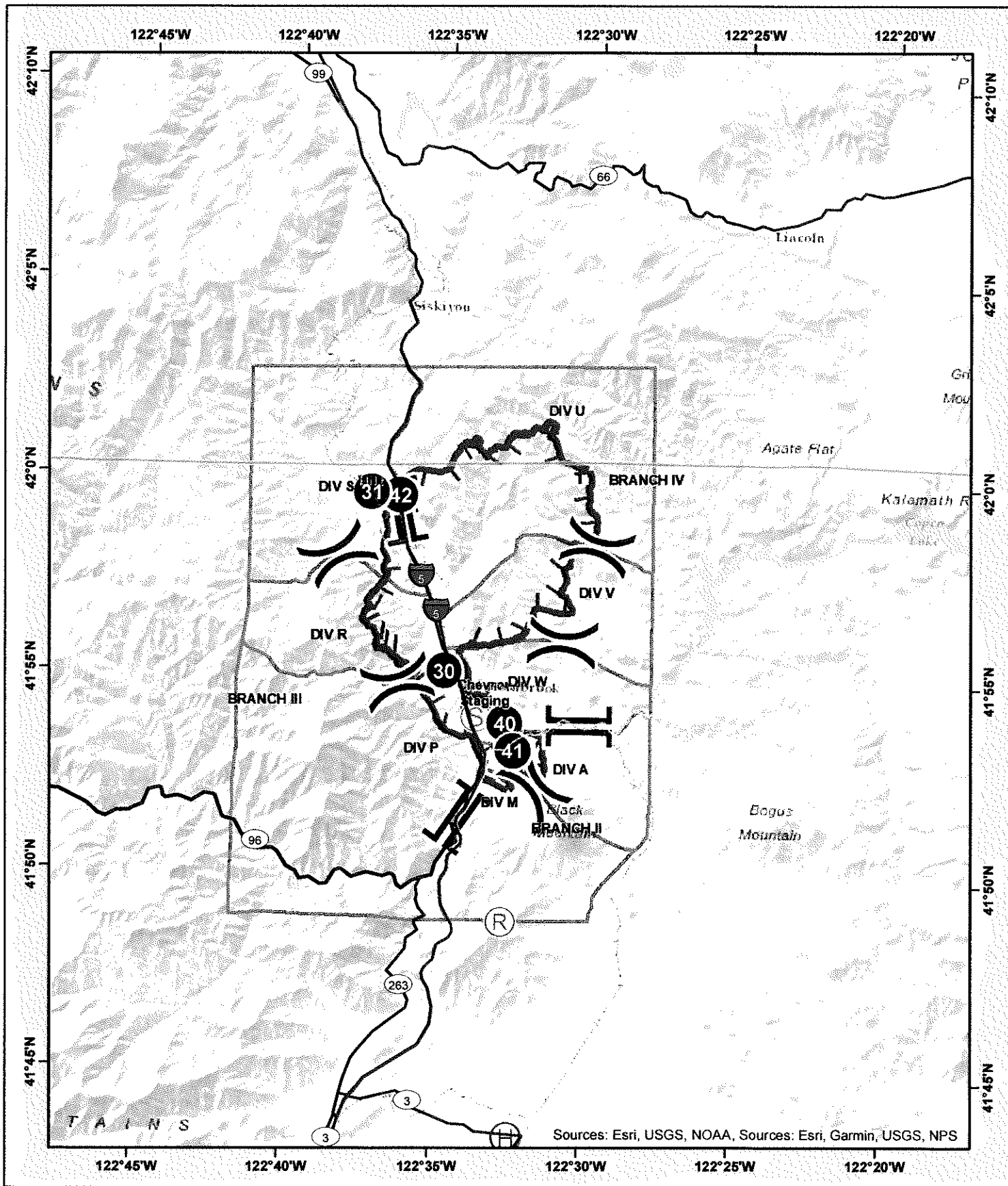


KLAMATHON INCIDENT Transportation Map
