DISCUSSION: A quiet pattern will continue during the day today, but with the warming and drying trend beginning. Tonight, a stronger downslope wind will take place overnight with some gusts to 25 mph possible on the western upper slopes of the Butte Creek drainage. Winds will also be stronger downslope in all drainages. RH recovery will be fair tonight, not as good as last night, but better than seen early in the incident. 



Watch Out - Maintain a high level of situational awareness in all driving situations and while working near roadways "SLOW DOWN"

- Very narrow, steep roads exist throughout the fire area

- If you're feeling drowsy, don't drive, stop and rest, change drivers or contact ground support and request a relief driver

FATIGUE

FATIGUE MAY COMPROMISE SAFETY!

Watch Out - Be on the lookout for signs of fatigue - look out for one another

- Chronic feelings of exhaustion, feeling "spacey."
- Impaired decision-making and judgment Low motivation Moodiness.
- An inability to pay attention and short-term memory problems, confusion.
- Slowed reflexes and responses.

Mitigation - Proper nutrition reduces fatigue

- Eat foods, which provide steady energy limit sugary, fatty, fried foods.
- Hydrate proper hydration prevents fatigue.
- Manage work rest ratio while performing work.
- Take full advantage of time off line to rest.

TOPOGRAPHY

STEEP TERRAIN TO WORK IN

Watch Out - Be on the lookout for topography driven fire conditions, loose rocks and boulders throughout the incident area

- Steep slopes may cause rolling material hazards
- Downhill line construction with potential slope reversal
- Significant slip hazards exist on steep slopes throughout the incident

Mitigation - Maintain high level of situational awareness

- Post lookouts and monitor changes in fire behavior.
- 10's & 18's
- Listen for rolling rocks and boulders and yell out, "ROCK" to others around you

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HIRED EQUPMENT FIRELINE SAFETY MESSAGE



To prevent accidents and injuries to personnel when working with hired equipment on a fire assignment.

CAL FIRE requires annual firefighter safety training for all operators of equipment hired for fireline and/or suppression repair assignments. Specific requirements are outlined in the Fire Service Training and Education Program (FSTEP) Fireline Safety Awareness for Hired Vendors curriculum, approved by the Office of the California State Fire Marshal, State Fire Training Program. Each operator who successfully completes the required annual training is issued a course completion card valid for one year from the class completion date (due to COVID 2019 & 2020 cards are accepted). Operators shall retain this course completion card, and present it to incident personnel upon request. Incident personnel shall verify that all operators operating equipment under an EERA have a copy of the safety training completion card in their possession.

Driver's License

- All operators of vehicles covered by the EERA must possess a current driver's license
 appropriate for the type of vehicle being operated. Operators of any motor vehicle or
 combinations having a Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR) of more than 26,000 lbs. must have
 a Commercial Driver's License (with any/all endorsements required by law), valid for the State of
 California.
- <u>Drivers of hired equipment</u> are not exempt from the limitations on driving hours or the logbook requirements of the Federal Motor Carrier Regulations
- PPE Standards and Requirements for Equipment Operators
 - Operator personal protective equipment (PPE) shall comply with applicable Cal/OSHA requirements and the following regulatory standards.

Required PPE

One hard hat, one set of goggies, one pair of gloves, boots lace-up minimum 8" leather lugtype soles in good condition, one flashlight (for night operations), one quart drinking water per hour per person, nomex shirt, trousers, and face shroud: Cal/OSHA approved, one fire shelter: USFS approved, one radio, refer to form FC-100R for minimum radio specifications. Supervisors shall confirm with hired equipment operators that radios are operating properly to maintain communication during assigned shifts.

Safety Inspections

- All privately-owned vehicles requiring commercial drivers' licenses and with 26,001 lbs or greater GVWR, or at the discretion of the CAL FIRE Hired Equipment Coordinator, under agreement with CAL FIRE shall be safety-inspected annually. CAL FIRE personnel shall verify this inspection has occurred prior to hire each year. This includes California Special Equipment licensed vehicles, commercially licensed vehicles, and vehicles registered in other states. Proof of Inspection under the Biennial Inspection of Terminals (BIT program) is not acceptable. CAL FIRE shall accept an inspection as valid for one year only. An inspection date greater than twelve months' prior shall be rejected.
- NOTE: Each operator who successfully completes the required annual training is issued a
 course completion card valid for one year from the class completion date (due to COVID
 2019 & 2020 cards are accepted).

Suppliers are not allowed to work operators for 24-hour shifts and must have the appropriate number of relief operators for each piece of equipment to meet the agreement needs. <u>Line supervisors</u> ensure 12-hour shift exchange takes place.

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

CAL FIRE INCIDENT MANAGEMENT TEAM WATER USAGE PLAN

California Drought Emergency

The following shall be considered and implemented by all fire resources as a means to provide maximum efficiencies when utilizing water resources, while minimizing the impacts to private and public water supplies. Accountability shall be maintained for all water supplies that are utilized and care should be applied to ensure proper replacement and/or reimbursement to the supplier/ owner.

Fireline personnel- (During mop up operations)

- Use of Pencil Hose and Garden Nozzles with Shut-Offs.
- Use of Back pumps.
- Dry Mop-up and consolidation of heavy fuels to areas where they can burn out safely
- Locate/ Relocate Firelines to lighter fuels or natural barriers when safe.
- Set up and use portable tanks in anticipation of longer transport times for Water Tenders.
- Use of foams, gels and other water enhancers.
- Evaluate need to mop up in excess of 200 feet from fireline

Road Maintenance and Repair-

- Monitor and water roads only when and where needed.
- Water when most effective (evening and nights).
- Use chemical treatments when available (Magchloride, Omni bind ect).
- Consider use of tertiary or treated water (sp)

Aviation Operations-

- Use of Gels, Foams and Retardants. Set up portable plants.
- Consider Blivits and Pencil hose for interior mop up operations as opposed to numerous bucket drops.
- Establish and use pre-use agreements for existing and known water sources.
- Use large watershed dip sites when able. Minimize use of small, static ponds and lakes.
- Maintain accountability of water used and locations of dip sites.
- Evaluate need for interior bucket drops

Private Water Supplies-

- Notify property owner as early as possible.
- Minimize usage and develop alternative water supplies when and where appropriate.
- Track usage (meter, 214 form) and develop a plan to replace water.
- Make arrangements for reimbursement and damage claims if needed.

Public/ Municipal Water Supplies-

- Notify Agency as soon as possible and request a representative to the incident.
- Identify fill areas and request metering devices. Place on incident map.
- Use alternative or reclaimed water sources when available. Place on incident map.
- Make arrangements for reimbursement and damage claims if needed.

Management and Supervision-

- Use leaders intent and establish Water Conservation as an Management Objective.
- Consider complexity of water use on incidents. Establish a Water Supply Group Supervisor to coordinate additional resources to support the incident needs.
- Complete the Water Usage Report daily and turn in to Finance
- Review this check list and brief daily.


