

.DISCUSSION...A second surge of moist unstable air will move over the spot location later overnight through Monday morning. There are favorable conditions for additional elevated thunderstorms to develop as this occurs. These thunderstorms will behave similarly to those that developed last night with frequent lightning and erratic outflow winds. These storms may bring more precipitation than Saturday nights thunderstorms however they are still expected to move quickly making wetting rains where lightning strikes unlikely. Winds will be entirely driven by inflows and outflows of thunderstorms though some ambient light onshore sea breeze will exist nearshore, with much weaker winds inland. Signs of a reforming marine layer along the coast will increase overnight humidity recovers at least alongshore with drier conditions inland. Hot and dry conditions will persist again on Monday and possibly through the week ahead. Higher elevations will see little to no humidity recovery overnight through the duration of the heatwave.
