

### <u>WEATHER DISCUSSION:</u> ...RED FLAG WARNING IN EFFECT THROUGH TUESDAY MORNING FOR DRY THUNDERSTORMS AND GUSTY OUTFLOW WINDS...

The remnants of former Hurricane Genevieve off the Baja Coast will bring up moisture Sunday through Monday into the California Coast, bringing dry thunderstorms and gusty outflow winds to the region. The best chances for thunderstorms over the CZU Lightning Complex will be late today into early Monday morning. Even though there is a 50-50 chance that a storm will directly hit the fire, the impacts could be potentially severe. In addition to abundant lightning, gusty outflow winds up to 60 mph are possible if a storm directly hits the fire area, especially in the upper elevations. Little to no rainfall is expected. This is a similar event to what happened this past week that started the wildfires across northern California.

### **WEATHER FORECAST SUNDAY:**

GENERAL: The fire is burning in heavy timber mix of Hardwoods and Coastal Redwoods along with thick litter and some intermixed grass and brush. The region is experiencing moderate to severe drought with rainfall for the area at about 50% of average. The fire continues to resist control efforts due to the prolonged drying and depth of fuel beds. Fuel moistures in the brush are at critical levels, and the 100 hour and 1000 hour fuels moistures are around 7%. Heavy dead down fuels will be consumed near 100% leaving deep seated heat in ash pits.

With the shift in winds, the fire behavior may increase on the south aspects of the drainages and slopes within Branch 2 and Branch 9.

### SPECIFIC:

Below 1500 foot elevation: The marine layer will be over the fire for these areas for most of the shift. This marine layer has limited moisture except directly nearest the coast. This moisture has had little effect on the heavier fuels and thick duff layer. The fuels conditions continue to allow for fire spread at a steady pace. Probability of ignition is 50%

Above 1500 foot elevation: The upper elevations of the fire have remained dry for the past 6 days and have burned with active flanking and backing, roll out and slope driven runs. Single and group tree torching is possible, with the spotting potential at ½ to 1 mile. Expect this to continue for the entire shift, with the potential of increased activity due to predicted thunderstorms and lowering humidity levels through the night. Probability of ignition is 85%

AIR OPERATIONS: limited air operations due to smoke and marine layer. Best chances for clear air will be on the west and southwest portions of the fire.

### SAFETY

- Outflow winds can rapidly increase fire behavior and cause widowmakers and snags to fall with little warning!
- Fire in drainages can dislodge rolling objects and firebrands.
- Identify safety zones early before predicted thunderstorms occur

### Safety Alert

### Thunderstorm Safety

Approaching thunderstorms may be noted by a sudden reverse in wind direction, a noticeable rise in wind speed, and a sharp drop in temperature. Rain, hail, and lightning occur only in the mature stage of a thunderstorm.

### **Situational Awareness**

Observe the 30/30 rule: If you see lightning and hear the thunderclaps following in less than 30 seconds take the storm precautions identified below. Do not resume work in exposed areas until 30 minutes after storm activity has passed.

### **Hazard Control**

- Take shelter in a vehicle or building if possible.
- If outdoors, find a low spot away from tall trees, wire fences, utility lines and other elevated conductive objects. Make sure the place you pick is not subject to flooding.
- If in the woods, move to an area with shorter trees.
- If only isolated trees are nearby, keep your distance twice the tree height.
- If in open county, crouch low with feet together, minimizing contact with the ground. You can use a pack to sit on, but never lay on the ground.
- If you feel your skin tingle or your hair stand on end, immediately crouch low to the ground. Make yourself the smallest possible target and minimize your contact with the ground.
- Don't group together.
- Don't stay on ridge tops, wide open areas, or near ledges or rock outcroppings.
- Don't operate landlines telephones, machinery, or electric motors.
- Don't handle flammable materials in open containers or metal hand tools.


Strike Team Leaders only submit one 214 for your resource and not multiple Unit Logs for each engine.






