# **WEATHER DISCUSSION:**

The marine layer is deepening as we continue to see good onshore flow into the CZU fire area. Breezy west to southwest winds are expected again this afternoon with little change in the temperatures and humidity from what we saw yesterday. Expect to see good recovery at all elevations tonight. This onshore flow pattern will continue through at least mid-week, with warming and drying trend as we go into the weekend.

# **WEATHER FORECAST TUESDAY:**

WEATHER: Mostly sunny with smoke. Coastal fog possible in the morning.

TEMPERATURES: Highs 74-84.... 64 along the coast. LITTLE CHANGE

HUMIDITY: 45-55%... except below 1500ft 55-70%. LITTLE CHANGE

20 FT WINDS:

ABOVE 1500ft - West and Southwest 5-10 mph with gusts up to 15 mph.

BELOW 1500ft - West and Southwest 5-10 mph.

STABILITY: Marine layer up to 800ft along the coast. HAINES: 4 above 2000ft level....2 below.

### **WEATHER SUMMARY**

Marine influence has occurred over most of the fire and is having an increasing affect on fuels and burning conditions.

# **OUTPUTS**

### **FIRE BEHAVIOR**

**GENERAL:** The fire is burning in heavy timber mix of Hardwoods and Coastal Redwoods along with thick litter and some intermixed grass and brush. The region is experiencing moderate to severe drought due to rainfall for the area at about 50% of average with the last recorded wetting rain occurring more than 90 days ago. The fire continues to resist control efforts due to the prolonged drying and depth of fuel beds. Fuel moistures in the brush are at critical levels, and the 100-hour fuels are around 10% and 1000-hour fuels moistures are around 7%. Heavy dead down fuels will be consumed near 100% leaving deep seated heat in ash pits.

Despite the marine influence, the heaviest fuels are still very dry and will continue to burn with intensity.

### SPECIFIC:

Below 1500 foot elevation: The marine layer will be over the fire for these areas for the entire shift. This marine layer has begun to affect the 1 and 10 hour fuels, especially along the coast. This moisture has had some effect on the heavier 100 and 1000 hour fuels and thick duff layer, but they continue to burn due to persist dry pattern the region has experienced. Probability of ignition is 20%

Above 1500 foot elevation: The upper elevations of the fire have remained dry for the past 8 days but have had good humidity recovery yesterday for the first time during the fire. These areas will continue to burn with active flanking, backing and roll out, but should have less opportunity for increasing significant fire spread. Occasional single tree torching is still possible due to heavy fuel loading and the spotting potential is 200 to 500 feet. Expect humidity to recover much more at night than previous shifts, moderating fire behavior. Probability of ignition is 40%

AIR OPERATIONS: Smoke and marine layer in the morning will prevent air operations until the air starts clearing after 1100.

### SAFETY

- Mop up should be more extensive in areas that could generate wind blown embers across the line.
- Limited visibility may give you a false sense of security. Use LCES to ensure you know what the fires are doing around you.
- Snags/trees can burn in the upper portions. Look up! Just because there is no fire in the lower trunk doesn't' mean it's safe

- Increase your hydration, electrolytes and nutrition with fruits and vegetables.

- Heavy equipment and falling modules working on opening narrow roads.
- STOP COVID-19! (Distance 6 Feet, Cover Nose and Mouth, Wash Hands).

### **Ash Pit Awareness**

- Observe the remnants of the vegetation model.
- Look for depressions in the ground.
- Use your hand tool to sound your way into the burn.
- White ash may be an indicator of an ash pit.
- Ensure that PPE is worn and properly fitted.




Strike Team Leaders only submit one 214 for your resource and not multiple Unit Logs for each engine.
