WEATHER DISCUSSION:

...INCREASING NORTHWEST WINDS TODAY...

The deep marine layer this morning will keep coastal fog around the coast and San Lorenzo Valley area this morning, then burning off later in the morning. Temperatures and humidity will start their warming and drying trend today and continue through the rest of the week. A weak weather system moving through the Pacific Northwest will help to increase our winds today from the northwest. Winds will be breezy on the ridges, as well as along with coast. Tonight, expect to see drier conditions in the higher elevations above 1500ft, but good recovery for the lower elevations and along the coast. Conditions will become hot and very dry by the weekend and into next week.

WEATHER FORECAST WEDNESDAY: ...WARMING AND DRYING TREND BEGINS TODAY...

WEATHER: Mostly sunny with smoke. Coastal fog in the morning.

TEMPERATURES: Highs 75-85.... 65 along the coast. 2-3 DEG WARMER

WEATHER SUMMARY

Marine influence remains over much of the fire but is having only a moderate affect on fuels and burning conditions. A drying trend is beginning today through the rest of the week and into the weekend. Winds will increase slightly especially along the coast and shift more to the West and NorthWest Review the IMET forecast for specific details

OUTPUTS

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL: The fire is burning in heavy timber mix of Hardwoods and Coastal Redwoods along with thick litter and some intermixed grass and brush. The region is experiencing moderate to severe drought due to rainfall for the area at about 50% of average with the last recorded wetting rain occurring more than 90 days ago. The fire continues to burn actively in all fuels due to the prolonged drying and depth of fuel beds. Fuel moistures in the brush are at critical levels, and the 100-hour fuels are around 10% with the 1000-hour fuels moistures around 7%. Heavy dead down fuels will be consumed near 100% leaving deep seated heat in ash pits and large burned out stump holes

SPECIFIC:

Below 1500 foot elevation: The marine layer will be over the fire for these areas for the first part of the shift, burning off mid-morning. This marine layer has had limited affect, transferring very little moisture to the fuels. The heavier 100- and 1000-hour fuels and thick duff layer continue to burn due to the persistent dry pattern the region is experiencing. Fire spread is mainly active backing, flanking and rollout, causing slopovers and short range spotting. Probability of ignition is 30%

Above 1500 foot elevation: The upper elevations of the fire have had some moisture recovery overnight but continue to present resistance to control. Expect humidity recovering to be less than previous shifts, allowing active burning longer into the evening. The fire will continue to burn with active flanking, backing and roll out along with occasional single tree torching due to heavy fuel loading and steep topography. Spotting potential is 400 to 600 feet. Probability of ignition is 45%

AIR OPERATIONS: Smoke and marine layer will prevent air operations until the air starts clearing around midmorning.

SAFFTY

- Mop up should be more extensive in areas that could generate wind blown embers across the line.
- Fire weakened trees and branches continue to release, falling with little warning and can easily block roadways.

Copies of the Crew Evaluations (ICS-224s) and Personnel Evaluations (ICS-225s) are sent to your home unit or business office. Therefore, it is imperative to provide the home unit or business name and address on the evaluation form.

FIRING PLAN AND GO / NO GO CHECKLIST

Test Firing Plan

The size and location of the test burn will be large enough and representative of the fuels of the proposed burn area.

Communications:

A radio net announcement at the incident will be made prior to firing operations. This will be communicated on tactical and command nets and will identify general location of geographic area to be burned. Special frequencies may or may not be used.

Slop-overs and Escapes:

If an escape/slop-over occurs notify the Division/Group Supervisor, who will take appropriate suppression actions. The Firing Group Supervisor will evaluate whether or not to continue firing and communicate such to the Division Group Supervisor. At all times, appropriate information will be transmitted through the chain of command to the Operations Section Chief.
