WEATHER DISCUSSION:

A deep marine layer continues to affect the coast and San Lorenzo Valley this morning with fog and stratus, burning off around mid-day in the San Lorenzo Valley. Stratus will hang along the coast through the day. We will continue to see warming and drying over the next few days as high pressure strengthens over California. Thermal belts will continue to dry out each night with good recovery below the marine layer. The marine layer will push in again tonight up to 1500ft with coastal fog pushing into the San Lorenzo Valley once again. Temperatures will become above normal by the second half of the week with very dry conditions, increasing northwest winds, and a shallower marine layer.

WEATHER SUMMARY

Marine influence will have less influence over the upper elevations of the fire. Lower elevations will continue with the marine layer influence. A warming and drying trend continues and will become much hotter and drier into late next week. Light winds over the fire area from the Southwest Review the IMET forecast for specific details

OUTPUTS

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL: The fuels in the fire area are made up of a heavy timber mix of Hardwoods and Coastal Redwoods along with thick litter and some intermixed grass and brush. The region is experiencing moderate to severe drought due to rainfall for the area at about 50% of average with the last recorded wetting rain occurring more than 90 days ago. The heavier 100 and 1000-hour fuels and thick duff layer continue to burn due to the persistent dry pattern the region is experiencing. Fuel moistures in the brush are at critical levels, and the 100-hour fuels are around 10% with the 1000-hour fuels moistures around 8%. Heavy dead down fuels will be consumed near 100% leaving deep seated heat in ash pits and large burned out stump holes

ERC currently at 80% for Dense Conifer fuels, but is trending up

SPECIFIC:

Below 1500 foot elevation: The marine layer and smoke will be over the fire for these areas for the first part of the shift, burning off midday. This marine layer is affecting the lighter fuels and moderated fire activity. Fire spread is occurring mainly in the North Zone with active backing, flanking and rollout, causing slopovers. Deep seated heat in the duff layer continues to smolder and uncontrolled edges of Interior islands and pockets will continue to burn, and may cause ember production and control issues. Probability of ignition is 40%

Above 1500 foot elevation: Active creeping and smoldering ground fuels can burn through control lines in dirty burn areas loaded with thick duff. Widespread isolated heat signatures are still showing in most areas still with heavier ground fuels consuming near 100%. Fuel orientation is changing with trees and brush falling over stump holes and smoldering duff layers. Probability of ignition is 50%

AIR OPERATIONS: Smoke and marine layer may remain over the fire for a good portion of the morning, should burn off midday.

SAFETY

- Weather is getting hotter and drier. Watch for poor overnight humidity recovery at the upper elevations
- Be aware of ash pits and stump holes across the incident, watch where you step!
- Fire weakened trees and branches continue to release, falling with little warning and can easily block roadways.



Properly identified members of the news media should not be restricted from entering locations specified within the code. However, this does not include crime scenes, private property and does not imply that the news media may interfere with incident operations while they are in the areas of concern. More information can be found here.

CAL FIRE SOCIAL MEDIA POLICY – When assigned to a CAL FIRE incident, you will adhere to the CAL FIRE Social Media Policy, Section 0691. You can find further information about the CAL FIRE Social Media Policy here.

PHOTOGRAPHS AND VIDEOS OF INCIDENT — We are in a new era of media. Media no longer means news/broadcast industry, but now refers to anyone that has the capability to shoot video, photographs and post them onto social media sites in a matter of minutes. Unfortunately, we have seen some instances of photographs or videos that have depicted unsafe, unprofessional or embarrassing circumstances which are a serious breach of ethics. When this happens, it reflects poorly on all that are attached to this incident. Posting an inappropriate video, photo or blog comment could expose oneself to unwanted ramifications. It may be unsafe to shoot photos or video and a firefighter who is concentrating on a camera loses their situational awareness.

The Public Information Office would like copies of the video and pictures that you safely took while not in an emergency situation, fire suppression activity or in an overhead assignment. Bring your video and pictures to the Public Information trailer; they will be reviewed and possibly uploaded to our many CAL FIRE social media sites. Remember, we don't want photographs or videos that depict unsafe, unprofessional or embarrassing circumstances, which are a serious breach of ethics.

LOST AND FOUND — The Information Section will manage lost and found items for the incident. If you have lost an item please leave your contact information and what you have lost at the Information Section. If you have found an item on the incident, bring the item to the Information Section with your contact information as well. All items left in Lost and Found will be turned over to the local CAL FIRE Senta Cruz Unit.

In the subject line enter:

Contract Crew/Equipment:

We need for you to send us the following information (even if you have submitted it to the CAL FIRE finance unit):

- Contact name, phone number, and email for on-site "leader"
- Resource Order
- Contract (Pages 1-2 and any additional pages referencing equipment/resource information)
- Crew Manifest
- Inspection (if one was done)
- Shift Tickets (signed by you and your incident supervisor) / CTRs (signed by your incident supervisor)

Administratively Determined (AD) Resources:

We need for you to send us the following information:

- Contact phone number and email
- Resource Order
- Casual Hire Form
- CTRs (signed by your incident supervisor)

Federal Employees:

As of right now, we are not planning to create OF-288s for Federal "regular" employees. Each of you can utilize your CTRs as your backup documentation for submitting your time sheets.

IF, however you require an OF-288, we will do our best to accommodate your needs. If you are claiming Hazard Pay, just like always, you must provide a justification for the claim ("H=Hazard") is NOT enough. Use "action verbs" to explain what/why you are claiming the hazard.

WHEN YOU ARE CLOSE TO DEMOB:

- Give Finance a "Courtesy Email" 1-2 days prior to make sure all your documents have been received.
- Submit all time documentation (including travel home) ahead of demob.
- Send an email the morning of your demob to the Support email so the demob process can be started from the virtual finance group.

Please do not wait until the end of your assignment to get us your information. Since we are virtual, the process will take additional time.


Strike Team Leaders only submit one 214 for your resource and not multiple Unit Logs for each engine.







Facilitie₃₄Map - ICP






