WEATHER DISCUSSION:

The fog layer will burn off in the valley late this morning with stratus over the coast through the day. The marine layer will continue to lower each day this week as high pressure squashes down on the inversion. This will mean that more and more of the fire area will be exposed to the hotter and drier conditions each day above the inversion in the thermal belts. The fog will push in again tonight, but only up to 1000ft as the marine layer continues to trend lower each night. Temperatures will become above normal by the second half of the week with very dry conditions, increasing northwest winds, and a shallower marine layer.

WEATHER: Valley fog burning off by late morning. Mostly sunny with smoke. Coastal fog through the day.

WEATHER SUMMARY

Marine influence will have less influence over the upper elevations of the fire. Lower elevations will continue with the marine layer influence, but will burn off earlier today. A warming and drying trend continues and will become much hotter and drier later into the week. Light winds over the fire area from the South to Southwest

OUTPUTS

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL: The fuels in the fire area are made up of a heavy timber mix of Hardwoods and Coastal Redwoods along with thick litter and some intermixed grass and brush. There is no significant recorded fire history for much of the fire area, allowing for an excessive buildup of dead and down fuels with a thick duff layer in the lower slopes. Fuel moistures in the brush are at critical levels, and the 100-hour fuels are around 10% with the 1000-hour fuels moistures around 7%. Expect persistent burning conditions around the fire but be aware of the upcoming change in weather conditions later in the week.

ERC currently at 90% for Dense Conifer fuels, trending up

SPECIFIC:

Below 1200 feet: The marine layer will be over the fire for these areas for the first part of the shift, burning off midmorning which is earlier than the previous few shifts. Fire activity is mainly creeping and smoldering in most areas with ash pits and heavy down fuels. Fire spread in Branch 1 has active backing, flanking and rollout, increasing potential for slopovers. Deep seated heat in the duff layer and root systems continues to smolder and may cause control issues. Probability of ignition is 40%

Above 1200 feet: Creeping and smoldering ground fuels can burn through control lines in dirty burn areas loaded with thick duff. Widespread isolated heat signatures are still showing in most areas still with heavier ground fuels consuming near 100%. Fuel orientation is changing with trees and brush falling over stump holes and smoldering duff layers. Poor overnight moisture recovery may allow for heavy fuels to remain active. Probability of ignition is 55%

AIR OPERATIONS: Smoke and marine layer may remain over the lower elevations of the fire for a good portion of the morning, should burn off midmorning.

SAFETY

- Weather is getting hotter and drier. Watch for poor overnight humidity recovery at the upper elevations
- Be aware of ash pits and stump holes across the incident, watch where you step!
- Fire weakened trees and branches continue to release, falling with little warning


Strike Team Leaders only submit one 214 for your resource and not multiple Unit Logs for each engine.

CZU LIGHTNING Fireline Suppression Repair Guide

Supression Repair Guidelines:

- 1. Follow the CZU Lightning Incident Suppression Repair Plan.
- 2. Identify issues of damage made by fire suppression activities.
- 3. Repair damaged areas as instructed by the North and South Group Leaders.
- 4. Attempt to make contact with the landowners prior to repairs.
- 5. Identify issues to be brought to Comp Claims when it is outside the scope of suppression repair.

General Cleanup and Repair:

1. Collect all trash such as plastic water bottles, cardboard, plastic flagging, foodstuffs, wrappers, blown hose and plastic bags and pack it out.

Access Roads:

- 1. Install waterbreaks where a waterbreak previously existed.
- 2. Install or maintain rolling dips where they previously existed.
- 3. Breach berms to facilitate drainage.
- 4. Clean out inlet and outlet of culverts plugged with soil and vegetation pushed by the dozer.
- 5. Water roads as necessary that were used for fire control operations to reduce dust and stabilize soil. Grading will be determined by the Group leader.
- 6. Where suppression activities have damaged/destroyed road drainage facilities (culverts, over-side drains) repair or replace as determined by the Group Leader.

Constructed Fireline Adjacent to Homes:

- 1. Spread piles of soil where Dozers ran adjacent to homes.
- 2. Lop, chip, and/or make safe piled or knocked over trees and vegetation that was pushed over for dozer line construction.
- 3. Repair any broken or damaged fences and/or gates <u>as the result of fire suppression activities</u>. Document the extent and condition of damage prior to repairs.

Helispots, Drop Points, Staging Areas, Safety Zones:

- 1. Avoid leaving heavy piles of slash and/or debris; scatter so it appears natural.
- 2. Pull any berms back onto the site. Install cross-drainage.
- 3. Spread slash or brush over the area if available.

Dozer Lines:

1. Install waterbars on constructed dozer lines. Waterbar spacing will not exceed 150 feet.


Road Gradient	Waterbreak spacing
0-10%	150 feet
11-25%	100 feet
26-50%	75 feet
>50%	50 feet

- 2. Waterbars should be constructed at an angle of approximately 45 degrees to the fire line, and deep enough to significantly reduce the chance of being destroyed by off-road vehicle use.
- 3. For dozer lines that are located along ridgelines, alternate the direction of the waterbars (in a herring bone configuration) to eliminate water accumulation on one side of the ridge.
- 4. Waterbars should be located to discharge into natural vegetation where possible.
- 5. Scatter organic debris over dozer line surface near areas where dozer lines intersect roads to prevent trespass.
