



#### \*\*\* Dry Lightning Threat: Red Flag Warning Today \*\*\*

An incoming low pressure system will result in another day of increased potential for thunderstorms today. A few storms may become strong or severe. Strong outflows with erratic and sudden wind shifts are possible with these storms along with localized areas of heavy rainfall, hail, and dry lightning strikes.

# WEATHER SUMMARY: RED FLAG WARNING IN EFFECT UNTIL 2100 PDT WEDNESDAY DUE TO THUNDERSTORM ACTIVITY AND POTENTIAL DRY LIGHTNING OVER THE FIRE AREA.

Low pressure over the area will increase the chances of thunderstorms to 35%. The potential for dry lightning exists with these storms along with strong gusty erratic outflow winds. Temperature will be slightly cooler than yesterday, 82-87° with RH values increasing, minimums at 20-25% in the afternoon. Winds will be light early becoming west at 9-14 MPH in the afternoon, except for outflow winds of 50-60 from thunderstorm activity. The inversion will clear quicker than yesterday, around 1200, increasing fire activity earlier in the day.

#### **OUTPUTS**

#### FIRE BEHAVIOR

**GENERAL:** The fire is burning in heavy timber and slash intermixed with bitterbrush, along with clear cut plots littered with moderate to heavy slash. Fuel moistures in the bitterbrush are nearing record levels, with timber fuel moistures very low due to drought conditions in the area. The fire will continue to burn actively when aligned with the wind and slope, even under the inversion.

- Timber and slash: Rates of spread 9 - 16 feet per minute, 35 - 48 feet/minute with outflow winds Flame lengths 7-10 feet, 11-15 feet with outflow winds

Spotting 1/4 to 1/2 mile, with 1 1/2 mile possible during outflow winds

- Brush: Rates of spread 13-15 feet per minute, 80-90 feet per minute with outflow winds Flame lengths 4-5 feet, 9-11 feet with outflow winds Spotting up to ½ mile, up to 1 mile with outflow winds

- Probability of Ignition 98%

#### SPECIFIC:

Branch I: The fire is primarily burning in the bitterbrush within the timber. Fire activity has been dictated by topography until wind increases and becomes an factor. If active thunderstorms develop, increased fire activity with short to midrange spotting is possible. Expect spotting of up to 1 mile when aligned with the wind.

Branch V: This Branch should have low to moderate fire behavior but may still experience spots from outflow winds. Holdover hot spots within the interior can be potential ember producers with enough wind.

Branch IX: This Branch has the largest variation in topography burning in a mix of bitterbrush and manzanita under the heavy timber. There has been significant fire activity when the winds align with the slope, including single and group tree torching. As the day progresses and thunderstorm activity increases, Spotting will be an issue, especially in Divisions O & Q

AIR OPERATIONS: Thick inversion will inhibit air operations until midday. Outflow winds near thunderstorms may affect flight operations

#### SAFETY

- Be aware of the afternoon thunderstorms that can bring wind shifts
- Fire weakened timber is starting to fall, maintain your situational awareness
- Make sure to identify escape routes and safety zones early in the shift before dark


