




A very dry air mass will settle across the region through the weekend with typical afternoon southwest breezes expected. Daily afternoon minimum humidity will lower to near single digits along with weak humidity recoveries overnight. The driest and breeziest days are expected on Thursday and Friday with poor humidity recovery expected Friday night into early Saturday morning as a dry slot moves across the incident.

### **GENERAL:**

- The local area has an abundance of heavy timber with ground litter, intermixed with grass, bitterbrush, and Manzanita, along with clear cut plots littered with moderate to heavy slash.
- Fuel moistures in the bitterbrush are nearing record levels, and timber fuel moistures are very low due to drought conditions in the area. Fuel moistures in Manzanita are much higher, slowing fire spread.
- Expect new ignitions to become wind driven quickly, with dangerous rates of spread and short-range spotting, when in alignment with slope.

Timber and slash: Rate of spread 6-10 ft/min // Flame length 3-7 feet // Spotting 1000 feet // PIG 85%

Bitterbrush: Rate of spread 9-12 ft/min // Flame lengths 10-13 feet // Spotting 1/4 mile // PIG 70%

Manzanita: Rate of spread 5-9 ft/min // Flame lengths 2-4 ft // Spotting 500 feet // PIG 60%

\*\*\*Values above are valid for any new starts in the area\*\*\*

### SPECIFIC:

- Fire behavior will be minimal. Smoldering will be possible from stump holes with deep seated heat, and thick surface fuels.
- Increased winds will cause smoldering material to become active, as well as releasing fire weakened timber.
- Fuel and weather conditions are very similar to those from the day of ignition.
- Cut blocks contain a very receptive fuel bed for embers to become established in, and release from forming new spot fires easily.
- ERC values have reached the 90th percentile.

AIR OPERATIONS: Clear skies. Gusty conditions will continue over the ridge tops. Transport winds will be out of the South Southwest 20-25 mph.

#### SAFETY

- Ash pits will remain hot and could be deep. Watch your footing.
- Fire weakened timber will continue to release. Be alert for fire and mechanically damaged trees.
- New starts will have the ability to grow rapidly with the increase in wind and decrease in humidity.





# Incident Base Map- Lassen County Fairgrounds




