

## ...RED FLAG WARNING FOR LIGHTNING AND STRONG OUTFLOW WINDS TODAY...

WEATHER DISCUSSION: Scattered thunderstorms are expected today and this evening across the fire perimeter. Impacts will be frequent lightning, gusty outflow winds with locally heavy rain possible. Although wind directions maybe chaotic the storm flow direction will be from the Southeast thus outflow winds generally will be from the south and may reach 25 to 35 mph. Still on track for strong west and southwest winds and very dry conditions beginning Wednesday. Both daytime and nighttime RH values will be critically low.

#### TODAY (MONDAY DAYTIME):

WEATHER: Isolated holdover thunderstorm cells this morning...then increasing tstorm coverage early this afternoon lasting through the evening. Storm cells will be more intense with rain and hail.

- SOUTH AND WEST FACING SLOPES AFTER 1400 COMBNIED WITH WIND MAKE FOR INCREASED FIRE ACTIVITY.
- ENERGY RELEASE COMPONENT OF THE NFDRS IS SLIGHTLY ABOVE AVERAGE FOR THIS TIME OF YEAR. BUT THIS IS THE PEAK OF FIRE SEASON IN THIS AREA, SO AVERAGE IS CLOSE TO THE 90<sup>TH</sup> PERCENTILE.

- THE FIRE AREA HAS NO RECORDED SIGNIFICANT FIRE HISTORY.

#### TOPOGRAPHY:

- MOST OF THE FIRE IS BETWEEN 4000-6000' ELEVATION.
- MOSTLY PLATEAUS WITH DEEP DRAINAGES. THE MAIN DRAINAGES ARE THE BUTTE CREEK/FOSTER DRAW, ASH CREEK AND WILLOW CREEK.

SCORCHED AND UNBURNED CANOPY IN DIV D, E AND F HAS THE POTENTIAL TO RESULT IN TORCHING AND CAST SPOT FIRES INTO THE GREEN. IF THE FIRE PROGRESSES SOUTH-EAST, FUELS CONVERT TO GRASS AND BRUSH. OUTFLOW WINDS WILL CAUSE CRITICAL RATE OF SPREAD.

#### BRANCH III

EXTENSIVE SCORCHED CANOPY IN DIV G AND O IS A HAZARD THAT IS A RISK TO THE LINE. WITH RISK OF OUTFLOW WINDS THIS OPERATIONAL PERIOD THIS CONCERN IS AMPLIFIED. FUELS IN DIV O CONVERT TO GRASS IF THE FIRE PROGRESSES FURTHER SOUTH TO SPOONER TROUGH CYN.

#### **BRANCH V**

ACTIVITY IS DECREASING IN THIS BRANCH. ROLL OUT AND UNBURNED ISLANDS INSIDE THE LINE ARE A HAZARD, MEADOWS ALONG THE "GREEN" SIDE OF HWY 139 COULD CARRY A SPOT FIRE AT A RAPID RATE OF SPREAD.

#### AIR OPERATIONS:

INSTABILITY RESULTS IN GOOD VISIBILITY MOST OF THE DAY, BUT DOWNBURSTS ARE A HAZARD

#### SAFETY

REMEMBER THE FROG FIRE, JULY 30, 2015 AND THE CRANK FIRE, AUGUST 30, 1987. THESE FIRES
OCCURRED UNDER REMARKABLY SIMILAR CIRCUMSTANCES TO TODAY WITH DROUGHT AND
THUNDERSTORM DRIVEN FIRE BEHAVIOR. THEY RESULTED IN ONE FATALITY, 3 DESTROYED FIRE
ENGINES AND MULTIPLE SHELTER DEPLOYMENTS. AND BOTH WERE LESS THAN 30 MILES NORTH
OF OUR PERIMETER.

# INCIDENT MANAGEMENT TEAM WATER USAGE PLAN

## California Drought Emergency

The following shall be considered and implemented by all fire resources as a means to provide maximum efficiencies when utilizing water resources, while minimizing the impacts to private and public water supplies. Accountability shall be maintained for all water supplies that are utilized and care should be applied to ensure proper replacement and/or reimbursement to the supplier/ owner.

#### Fireline personnel- (During mop up operations)

- Use of Pencil Hose and Garden Nozzles with Shut-Offs.
- Use of Back pumps.
- Dry Mop-up and consolidation of heavy fuels to areas where they can burn out safely
- Locate/ Relocate Firelines to lighter fuels or natural barriers when safe.
- Set up and use portable tanks in anticipation of longer transport times for Water Tenders.
- Use of foams, gels and other water enhancers.
- Evaluate need to mop up in excess of 200 feet from fireline

#### Road Maintenance and Repair-

- Monitor and water roads only when and where needed.
- Water when most effective (evening and nights).
- Use chemical treatments when available (Magchloride, Omni bind ect).
- Consider use of tertiary or treated water (sp)

#### Aviation Operations-

- Use of Gels, Foams and Retardants. Set up portable plants.
- Consider Blivits and Pencil hose for interior mop up operations as opposed to numerous bucket drops.
- Establish and use pre-use agreements for existing and known water sources.
- Use large watershed dip sites when able. Minimize use of small, static ponds and lakes.
- · Maintein accountability of water used and locations of dip sites.
- Evaluate need for interior bucket drops

#### Private Water Supplies-

- Notify property owner as early as possible.
- Minimize usage and develop alternative water supplies when and where appropriate.
- Track usage (meter, 214 form) and develop a plan to replace water.
- Make arrangements for reimbursement and damage claims if needed.

#### Public/ Municipal Water Supplies-

- Notify Agency as soon as possible and request a representative to the incident.
- Identify fill areas and request metering devices. Place on incident map.
- Use alternative or reclaimed water sources when available. Place on incident map.
- Make arrangements for reimbursement and damage claims if needed.

#### Management and Supervision-

- Use leaders intent and establish Water Conservation as an Management Objective.
- Consider complexity of water use on incidents. Establish a Water Supply Group Supervisor to coordinate additional resources to support the incident needs.
- Complete the Water Usage Report daily and turn in to Finance
- · Review this check list and brief daily.
