*** SHIFT TO SOUTHWEST WINDS TODAY ***

DISCUSSION: The shift to southwest winds continues today with all areas likely to experience southwest winds by afternoon. Winds will be especially gusty over ridges, aligned gaps and saddles, and down close to I-80/505 in Branch XL where the Bay and Delta breezes will enhance winds. Marine air will be in over the valleys at shift change, and as this marine air mixes out late morning, conditions will suddenly worsen.

SATURDAY: *** WINDS BECOMING MORE SOUTHWESTERLY ***

- WEATHER: Mostly sunny. Areas of morning stratus in Napa Valley, Russian River Valley, and near the SF Bay.
- WIND (20 FT): Valleys: Light and variable through 1100 then becoming south 5-10 MPH with gusts to 15 MPH. Gusts to 25 MPH possible in the valleys of divs KK, GG, CC. Ridges and gaps: northwest 4-8 MPH through 1100 then becoming west-southwest 8-13 MPH with gusts to 18 MPH.
- MAX TEMPERATURES: bottom: 92-97, top: 88-93.
- MIN RH: 23-28% bottom, 28-33% top

Branch X: Winds: North-northwest 5-10 MPH with gusts to 15 MPH through 1200, then becoming west-southwest 5-10 MPH with gusts to 15 MPH. Min RH: 45-55%. Highs 75-80.

SATURDAY NIGHT:

- WEATHER: Partly cloudy.
- WIND (20 FT): Valleys: becoming light and variable. Ridges: southwest 4-8 MPH.
- MIN TEMPERATURES: 60-65 bottom, 65-70 top.
- MAX RH: Valleys 60-80%, ridges: 40-60%.

Branch X: Winds: Southwest 5-10 MPH. Max RH: 80-100%. Lows 55-60.

OUTPUTS

FIRE BEHAVIOR

GENERAL: Fuels are at holding at the 90th percentile for ERC and are available to burn, continuing through the next 7 days. Fuels are highly receptive to ignition from embers, or new ignitions. Expect ignitions outside control lines to be highly resistive to control. Larger diameter fuels will continue to consume causing a threat when near control lines. Roll out and tree torching is probable, and will contribute to the spotting potential.

Rates of Spread- up to 1.5 mi/hr, Flame Lengths up to 25 ft

*Greater rates of spread and flame lengths are possible when wind and slope are in alignment.

Probability of Ignition: up to 90% Spotting Distance: Spotting up to ½ mile.

SPECIFIC:

West Zone Meyers – This fire is burning in heavy timber broken up by grassy meadows. Concerns for today will be a change in wind direction. Today's South-southwest wind could affect the North-northeastern lines. An established spot across Meyers grade or Fort Ross roads will challenge control efforts. Control opportunities to the North and East are limited, and Fuels become more continuous.

Walbridge – Expect the fire to be active on the eastern flank again today. Heavy fuels and difficult terrain will challenge control efforts. Today the fire will experience a South-southwest wind. For the last 4 days, the fuels in the south have been shaded out by smoke and little clear air has been available, this will change today. Lines in the Northeast will be challenged by todays wind direction. As the fire comes out of higher terrain it transitions to lighter fuels and will have an increased rate of spread.

East Zone-

Branch XX- With the Southwesterly wind, expect open flanks to burn in the brush and oak woodland fuels to the North-northeast. Northwest movement is possible, where local terrain can funnel the wind. Fire spread South towards Three Peaks and Angwin is possible in the timber and understory fuels on the North slopes.

Branch XXX- Expect the fire to back downslope in the heavier fuels towards Hwy 16. Potential for fire movement to the North along Hwy 16, funneled by terrain winds. Grass and shrub fuels have burned recently, with some dead shrub skeletons available to burn. Good nighttime humidity recovery in the valley bottom will moderate burning after dark.

Branch XL- Fire will continue to back to the south, with minimal spread to the east possible. Roll out into unburned fuels can cause uphill runs with the wind. Interior pockets of fuel will continue to burn out.

AIR OPERATIONS: Areas of stratus in the morning.

SAFETY

Escape routes and safety zones are a must, especially with the extremely dry fuels and observed fire behavior!

Stump holes/ ash pits from the larger fuels will be present over most of the complex area.

Major Hazards and Risks: Extreme fire behavior, Hot dry weather, Limited resources.

Extreme Fire Behavior: Fuels are receptive to fire spread. A small amount of wind on this dry fuel changes fire behavior dramatically!! Be alert to changes in wind direction and expect changes in fire behavior. Watch for spot fires outside the control lines and embers cast into structures during Structure Defense. Stay alert for wind direction changes.

Driving: Slow Down! Drive defensively. Narrow winding roads. Expect the unexpected around every curve. Drive with headlights and seatbelts on. Coordinate your movements on one-lane roads.

Personnel: Manage yourself and those around you for fatigue. Drink fluids frequently and eat nutritious food regularly. As fatigue increases, injuries tend to increase also. Keep an eye on your crew and partner. Stay engaged and make smart decisions.

Fatigue: Limited resources and hot, dry, windy weather for the next several days. Be alert for signs of fatigue and take breaks as necessary. Be alert for signs of fatigue in yourself and others.

Hazard trees: Survey your work areas for hazard trees, flag and restrict access, use only qualified personnel for tree felling. Dead trees from bug kill. Review and follow Hazard Tree Safety in your IRPG.

Steep slopes/rolling material: Watch your footing while hiking in steep terrain. Be careful of loose rolling debris. Maintain Situational Awareness.

Downed powerlines: Follow Powerline Safety guidelines in the IRPG, watch out for burned out power poles.

Review your ICS 206 and know what to do in the event of an (IWI).

Maintain Situational Awareness

New Incidents:

- Remain flexible and mobile.
- Identify available resources ahead of time
- Utilize PACE planning. Have a primary, alternative, contingent, and emergency plans.
- Establish LCES in the beginning of a new start.

Covid-19 Precautions:

- Keep your distance. Wear a mask when less than 6' from other people.
- Wash your hands
- No group gatherings without masks
- Don't show up to work sick
- Do daily health evaluations on your personnel.



Archaeological and Historic Properties: General Fire-line Guidance.

Do not compromise safety for the protection and preservation of archaeological and historic properties. When possible and prudent:

- 1. Be on the lookout for prehistoric and historic archaeological sites. These sites typically occur adjacent to streams and springs, confluences are often especially sensitive. However, sites can occur in other areas too. The most common indicators of prehistoric sites in this area (North Coast Ranges) are scatters of shiny black obsidian flakes from tool making activities and dark midden soils. Historic-era sites include homesteads that contain foundations, rock chimneys, and stone / brick-lined wells. Historic-era mining sites are possible as well.
- 2. Note, that not much of the area has ever been surveyed for archaeological resources and many sites out there have yet to be discovered.
- 3. If you observe archaeological resources, flagged or unflagged, attempt to avoid with ground disturbing activities altogether.
- 4. If avoidance is not possible, minimize ground disturbance. Use a hand crew rather than a dozer to remove fuels from control lines that must cross site areas if possible.
- 5. Leave all artifacts in place as some may have been intentionally placed for religious or ceremonial reasons.
- 6. Note locations of discovered resources on a map, better yet, take site coordinates with a GPS. Leave information for the archaeologist so that the sites can be relocated and protected during Fire Suppression Repair. Flag the site in red if possible.
- 7. If you encounter a burial or other human remains, cease work in that area and contact the archaeologist immediately.

Your help preserving California's non-renewable cultural resources is appreciated. It is our responsibility as federal and state employees to help in the protection of our heritage – preserving these places, and artifacts for scientific, cultural, educational, spiritual, and religious uses.

MEDIA

<u>California State Penal Code Section 409.5(d)</u> allows the news media to enter scenes of disaster, riot, or civil disturbance. Properly identified members of the news media should not be restricted from entering the locations specified within the code, even if the area presents a danger to them. Media members should be advised of the nature of possible danger. Members of the media do not have the right to access crime scenes or any area where their presence may interfere with incident operations, mitigation or evidence collection.

- The media may only access private property with the property owner's permission. Fire
 personnel cannot provide members of the media with authorization to enter private
 property.
- If approached and questioned by the media and/or the public, talk about your assignment or task at hand. If need be, direct the questioning party to the incident PIO.
- Do not speculate or give opinions
- There is no such thing as an "off the record" comment.

CAL FIRE SOCIAL MEDIA POLICY (Social Media 0691)

Social Media is increasingly being used by public agencies and the media as well as the public. This form of communication continues to grow rapidly in order to supply the public's desire for instant information gratification. All personnel assigned to a CAL FIRE incident will adhere to the CAL FIRE Social Media Policy. Further information about the CAL FIRE Social Media Policy can be obtained from the Information Officer. If you are uncertain, please ask. **Do not post**:

- Inappropriate information, pictures or videos
- Opinions regarding the incident or policy
- Endorsements of any kind

Media no longer means the news/broadcast industry but now refers to anyone that has the capability to shoot video and or photographs and post them onto social media in a matter of minutes. Unfortunately we have seen some instances of video or photographs that have depicted unsafe, unprofessional or embarrassing circumstances which are a serious breach of ethics. When this happens it reflects poorly on all that are attached to this incident. Posting an inappropriate video, photo or blog comment could have unwanted effects. It may be unsafe to shoot photos or video and a firefighter who is concentrating on a camera can't be looking up, down and all around.






