

WEATHER DISCUSSION: The marine layer depth will be around 2000 feet this morning with high humidity values to start the day as clouds cover the lower slopes. Fire weather conditions will remain mild for today's operational period with seasonable temperatures, higher than normal humidity and generally light winds. The marine layer will slowly mix out by mid-morning with moisture briefly creating humidity rises for the higher elevations as the burn-off occurs. General winds will remain from the West to Southwest, strongest for northern portions of the Calaveras Zone that feel the influence of winds off the Bay. Southwest Divisions of Calaveras Zone in Henry Coe Park such as Div T/O/N will see southwest winds during the afternoon that will become strong and gusty in Div M as they get pushed through Pacheco Pass along Hwy 152. Continue to expect night time lowering of the humidity from around 2am-6am, especially above 2000 feet interior portions of the Calaveras and Canyon Zones which can lead to rapid increases in fire behavior during the pre-dawn hours from fuels burning out or burning operations.

WEATHER FORECAST FOR WEDNESDAY:

WEATHER: Morning clouds below 2000 feet otherwise smoke and hazy sunshine.

TEMPERATURES: Highs 79-85 Calaveras Zone, coolest above 2000 feet.

Highs 86-90 interior sections of the Canyon Zone.

HUMIDITY: 28-38% Calaveras Zone, wettest below 2000 feet. 18-28% Canyon Zone.

20 FT WINDS:

Ridgetop: Southwest 5-10 mph afternoon gusts 15-20 mph strongest Div Q/R and I.

Upslope/Upcanyon 3-8 mph late afternoon gusts 12 mph Canyon Zone drainages.

Hwy 152: Expect strong and gusty west winds in Div M around Pacheco Pass and San Luis

Reservoir. Afternoon and evening westerly gusts 30 mph.

STABILITY/INVERSION: Strong morning inversion breaking by midday Calaveras Zone then Canyon.

WEATHER FORECAST FOR WEDNESDAY NIGHT:

WEATHER: Smoke and haze otherwise mostly clear skies over the fire with clouds on the lower slopes.

TEMPERATURES: Lows 57-65 lower slopes of Calaveras Zone and 66-75 above 2000 feet.

HUMIDITY RECOVERY: 65-75% but locally 22-32% hills of the Canyon Fire above 2000 feet.

20 FT WINDS: Ridgetop: Southwest winds 5-10 mph evening gusts 15 mph.

Slopes: Downcanyon 2-5 mph.

STABILITY/INVERSION: Stable inversion layer setting up overnight.

Extended Forecast: Thursday through Saturday a seasonable weather pattern looks to set up. Highs lower 80s to lower 90s. Humidity 18-28% with good recovery on the lower slopes. WEATHER SUMMARY:

Seasonable weather will enter the area, and will last into next week. Daytime marine layer will begin lifting by noon. Expect low 80's on the western slopes of the Calaveras Zone, and high 80's on the interior and eastern portions of the Canyon Zone. Nighttime humidity will crash into the low teens between 2am and 6am in the areas above 1,500' elevation. Winds over the Canyon zone will be light and terrain driven, while the Calaveras Zone will experience gusty westerly winds.

GENERAL:

Fuels are currently at seasonal levels, and below the 90th percentile. Brush fields have a large amount of dead material in them from the previous years of drought and lack of fire history. Fuels above 1,500' elevation will burn extremely well in the early morning hours due to the humidity dropping each night. When fuels, wind, and topography are all in alignment you can expect dangerous rates of spread. The winds along Hwy 152 and HWY 580 can be very strong from the west and will eddy in the canyons and drainages found there.

Values above are valid for any new starts in the area

SPECIFIC:

- New ignitions will become established quickly in the dry fuels.
- Take the weather often throughout the shift to track the changing trends and conditions.
- Rolling material will continue to drop into the steep drainage creating slope reversal.

AIR OPERATIONS: Visibility will clear up by noon when the inversion lifts. Expect gusty conditions over the ridgetops in the afternoon. Transport winds W 10mph. Air resources might not be available for your tactical plans due to visibility, weather, new fires, or being timed out. Have a plan in place for air resources before they arrive to maximize their efforts.

- Fire weakened timber and branches will release due to winds. Roadways will become blocked easily.

- Disinfect "High-touch" surface areas.

REMINDERS TO ALL EMPLOYEES

- Self-Monitor yourself while you are on and off the line. If you experience any flu-like symptoms, COVID-19 symptoms, or any Respiratory illness symptoms contact your Company Officer and or Strike Team Leader.
- Maintain proper hand hygiene. Wash hands with soap and water for 20 seconds. Utilize hand sanitizer often. Do not shake hands, touch, or hug others.

- Employee informs Company Officer and Strike Team Leader of presumed/confirmed COVID-19 symptoms.
- Employee advised to seek evaluation by Medical Unit and CAL MAT or base camp medical unit.
- Crew initiates cleaning measures. Mask, safety glasses, gloves worn. (If needed, LOGS will assist)
- Medical Unit to notified IC, Liaison, Safety and Logistics ASAP. Medical Unit will notify COVID-19 Public Health Officer and determine need for testing and locations.

Incident Action Plan

- Company Officer / Strike Team Leader notified of personnel with COVID-19 positive test or symptom.
- Medical Unit evaluates individual(s) and need for care and evaluation.
- IC, Liaison, Safety and Logistics notification made to determine course of incident evaluation and response.
- Line Chief, Agency Administrator, and Region Office updated upon notification

- Incident Notification

- Shift Tickets (signed by you and your incident supervisor) / CTRs (signed by your incident supervisor)

Administratively Determined (AD) Resources:

We need for you to send us the following information:

- Contact phone number and email
- Resource Order
- Casual Hire Form
- CTRs (signed by your incident supervisor)

Federal Employees:

As of right now, we are not planning to create OF-288s for Federal "regular" employees. Each of you can utilize your CTRs as your backup documentation for submitting your time sheets.

IF, however you require an OF-288, we will do our best to accommodate your needs. If you are claiming Hazard Pay, just like always, you must provide a justification for the claim ("H=Hazard") is NOT enough. Use "action verbs" to explain what/why you are claiming the hazard.

WHEN YOU ARE CLOSE TO DEMOB:

- Give Finance a "Courtesy Email" 1-2 days prior to make sure all your documents have been received.
- Submit all time documentation (including travel home) ahead of demob.
- Send an email the morning of your demob to the Support email so the demob process can be started from the virtual finance group.

Media Law

The <u>California State Penal Code Section 409.5(d)</u> allows the news media to enter scenes of disaster, riot, or civil disturbance. Properly identified members of the news media should not be restricted from entering locations specified within the code. However, this does not include crime scenes, and does not imply that the news media may interfere with incident operations while they are in the areas of concern. If entering such a location that is hazardous, they should be advised; media access cannot be prevented for safety reasons unless their presence would impede CAL FIRE's mitigation of the incident or the disturbing of evidence. When working around the media, remember:

- Media is not permitted on private property without the property owners permission.
- If approached and questioned by the media and or the public, talk about your assignment or task at hand. Remember to wear all the appropriate PPE.
- If needed call for an incident PIO through the chain of command.
- Never speculate, give opinions or speak for others.
- There is no such thing as an "off the record" comment.

CAL FIRE Social Media Policy (Social Media 0691)

Social Media is increasingly being used by public agencies, the media as well as the public. This form of communication continues to grow rapidly in order to supply the instant gratification needs of society. Therefore when on a CAL FIRE incident you will adhere to the CAL FIRE Social Media Policy, 0691. You can get further information about the CAL FIRE Social Media Policy from the incident Public Information Officer. While assigned to the incident, there will be **no** posting of:

- Inappropriate information or materials
- No opinions
- No endorsements
- Inappropriate pictures or videos






SCULIGHTNING COMPLEX INCIDENT FACILITIES MAP




