...Red Flag Warning for Dry Lightning and Gusty Outflow Winds until 5 pm Monday...

WEATHER DISCUSSION: The Red Flag Warning remains in effect for a slight chance of dry thunderstorms along with gusty outflow winds. Otherwise expect more moderated fire weather conditions as higher humidity and slightly cooler temperatures develop. Smoke may be less prevalent due to better mixing that could allow for an earlier break of the inversion. Prevailing wind direction will be Westerly over the Calaveras Zone and along the ridges. Across the Canyon Zone mainly light upslope winds will prevail with westerly winds on the ridges. The biggest life safety threat will be from gusty outflow boundaries where gusts to 45 mph will be possible. These winds will be gusty and erratic pushing fire in unpredictable ways towards untested or open containment lines. If you see virga that is a Watch Out for strong and gusty winds!

WEATHER FORECAST FOR MONDAY:

WEATHER: Slight chance of a thunderstorm otherwise smoke and haze under partly cloudy skies.

TEMPERATURES: Highs 85-92 (2-5 degrees cooler than yesterday)

HUMIDITY: 21-29% (5-10% wetter)

20 FT WINDS:

Ridgetop: Southwest 5-10 mph afternoon gusts 15 mph (gusty and erratic near any t-storms)

Slopes: Upslope/Upcanyon 3-8 mph

STABILITY/INVERSION: Moderate morning inversion should break by midday Calaveras Zone.

WEATHER FORECAST FOR MONDAY NIGHT:

WEATHER: Smoke and haze otherwise partly cloudy skies.

TEMPERATURES: Lows 62-72, warmest above 1000 feet.

HUMIDITY RECOVERY: 45-55% but locally 25% hills of the Canyon Fire above 1500 feet.

20 FT WINDS: Ridgetop: Southwest winds 5-10 mph evening gusts 15 mph.

Slopes: Downcanyon 2-5 mph.

STABILITY/INVERSION: Stable inversion layer setting up overnight.

SAFETY INFORMATION: Continue to be ready for isolated thunderstorms. Review page 21 of your IRPG.

Extended Forecast: Tuesday through Friday a seasonable weather pattern looks to set up as the pattern dries out with no more threat of thunderstorms. Look for daytime highs mid 80s to mid 90s Canyon Zone. Humidity will lower 15-25% with good recovery on the lower slopes. Night time drying trends will likely continue across the Canyon Zone as the marine layer makes its way into the Santa Člara Valley. Prevailing wind direction will be Westerly 5-10 mph gusts 15-20 mph afternoon hours.

Outflow winds from isolated thunderstorms could produce gusts to 45mph on all areas of the complex. Temperatures will be in the low 90's with West winds 5-10mph gusting to 15mph across the ridge tops. Daytime humidity will be in the mid 20's across the complex. The Canyon Zone will experience upslope/upcanyon winds 8mph during the day. Moderate humidity recovery will occur overnight with the return of the onshore flow. Take the weather every hour to track the trends through the shift.

GENERAL:

Winds will continue to test all control lines in the complex area, as well as cause fire weakened timber and branches to release without warming. Gusty outflow winds will be possible if thunderstorms surface in the area. Expect critical rates of spread when fuels, wind, and topography are all in alignment. Winds along Hwy 152 will be very strong from the west and will eddy in the canyons and drainages found there. Lightning strikes, new starts, and spot fires will become established quickly in the dry fuels.

Values above are valid for any new starts in the area

SPECIFIC:

- New ignitions will become established quickly in the dry fuels.
- Isolated thunderstorms could still form over the complex. Be alert for weather changes.
- STRONG GUSTY outflow winds will cause erratic fire behavior and spread in all direction.

AIR OPERATIONS: Visibility will clear up early in the shift. Expect gusty conditions over the ridgetops in the afternoon. Transport winds SW 10mph. Air resources might not be available for your tactical plans due to visibility, weather, new fires, or being timed out. Have a plan in place for air resources before they arrive to maximize their efforts.

SCU LIGHTNING COMPLEX LIGHTNING SAFETY

Thunderstorms cause significant hazards to our personnel, including downbursts that can cause a change in winds and produce extreme fire behavior and lightning. When thunderstorm development is likely, lookouts should be posted and aware of signs of a developing storm. For example, a sudden reversal in wind direction, a noticeable rise in wind speed, and a sharp drop in temperature may note the mature stage of a storm. Heavy rain, hail and lightning occur only in the mature stage of a thunderstorm. During a storm, use the following guidelines:

- Do not lie down.
- The best position is sitting on your pack /web gear or crouching with feet close together.
- Avoid sitting directly on the ground, if possible; but, if necessary, keep feet and butt close together.
- Avoid grouping together. Keep a minimum of 15 feet between people when possible.
- "Stay out of dry creek beds" is correct for flash floods, but has nothing to do with lightning.
- Handheld radios (with short rubber antennas) or cell phones are safe to use. Communication is vital to crew safety. Do not use land line radios or radios with elevated antennas.
- Wide, open spaces are better than trees or clumps of trees in the vicinity. Ridge tops, etc., should be avoided.
- If you feel the hair on your arms or head "stand up," there is a high probability of a strike in the vicinity. Crouch or sit on a pack.
- Put down all tools.
- Take shelter in vehicles if possible.

- Wash Hands, Don Mask and Isolate from other employ-ees. Maintain a distance of > 6 feet.
- Notify the Company Officer and/or Strike Team Leader.
- Notify Medical Unit Leader
- Refer employee to appropriate healthcare provider for evaluation and treatment.
- Disinfect "High-touch" surface areas.

REMINDERS TO ALL EMPLOYEES

- Self-Monitor yourself while you are on and off the line. If you experience any flu-like symptoms, COVID-19 symptoms, or any Respiratory illness symptoms contact your Company Officer and or Strike Team Leader.
- Maintain proper hand hygiene. Wash hands with soap and water for 20 seconds. Utilize hand sanitizer often. Do not shake hands, touch, or hug others.
- Over coughs or sneezes (if not masked). Cloth Masks should be exchanged and or washed daily.
- ♦ Masks are required when out in the public on non-emergency business.
- Disinfect high-touch surfaces daily.
- Practice social distancing (> 6 feet) at meal times, dormitories, in-person meeting, or while in public.

Employee Response Action Plan

COVID-19 Positive Test or COVID-19 Positive Clinical Symptoms Presentation

- COVID 19 Symptoms: Cough, SOB, Fever or afebrile, Chills, Muscle Pain, Sore throat, Loss of taste/smell
- Employee informs Company Officer and Strike Team Leader of presumed/confirmed COVID-19 symptoms.
- Employee advised to seek evaluation by Medical Unit and CAL MAT or base camp medical unit.
- Crew initiates cleaning measures. Mask, safety glasses, gloves worn. (If needed, LOGS will assist)
- Medical Unit to notified IC, Liaison, Safety and Logistics ASAP. Medical Unit will notify COVID-19 Public Health Officer and determine need for testing and locations.

Incident Action Plan

- Company Officer / Strike Team Leader notified of personnel with COVID-19 positive test or symptom.
- Medical Unit evaluates individual(s) and need for care and evaluation.
- IC, Liaison, Safety and Logistics notification made to determine course of incident evaluation and response.
- Line Chief, Agency Administrator, and Region Office updated upon notification

Facilities Response

- Medical and Safety notified
- Incident Notification
- Disinfection plan initiated.
- Resource Status Evaluated

Medical Evaluation & Contact Tracing

- Personnel interviewed by Medical Unit. List of Positive contacts made in the last 5 days acquired. All Exposed are required to wear surgical mask, self monitor for Fever/Resp symptoms for up to 14 days (exposed personnel are subject to COVID-19 testing)
- Home Unit / Department utilized and retrospective tracking of Positive COVID-19 personnel inter-actions are identified within the last 5 days.
- Home Unit / Department updated by Company Officer / Strike Team Leader.
- Public Health Department is contacted and updated by IC or Designated Representative.
- Positive COVID-19 Employees w/symptoms will need to be evaluated by Health Department conducting testing, prior to returning to assignment.
- Positive COVID-19 Employees w/o symptoms may be required to be evaluated and resource status will be reviewed prior to returning to assignment.

Media Law

The <u>California State Penal Code Section 409.5(d)</u> allows the news media to enter scenes of disaster, riot, or civil disturbance. Properly identified members of the news media should not be restricted from entering locations specified within the code. However, this does not include crime scenes, and does not imply that the news media may interfere with incident operations while they are in the areas of concern. If entering such a location that is hazardous, they should be advised; media access cannot be prevented for safety reasons unless their presence would impede CAL FIRE's mitigation of the incident or the disturbing of evidence. When working around the media, remember:

- Media is not permitted on private property without the property owners permission.
- If approached and questioned by the media and or the public, talk about your assignment or task at hand. Remember to wear all the appropriate PPE.
- If needed call for an incident PIO through the chain of command.
- Never speculate, give opinions or speak for others.
- There is no such thing as an "off the record" comment.

CAL FIRE Social Media Policy (Social Media 0691)

Social Media is increasingly being used by public agencies, the media as well as the public. This form of communication continues to grow rapidly in order to supply the instant gratification needs of society. Therefore when on a CAL FIRE incident you will adhere to the CAL FIRE Social Media Policy, 0691. You can get further information about the CAL FIRE Social Media Policy from the incident Public Information Officer. While assigned to the incident, there will be **no** posting of:

- Inappropriate information or materials
- No opinions
- No endorsements
- Inappropriate pictures or videos




