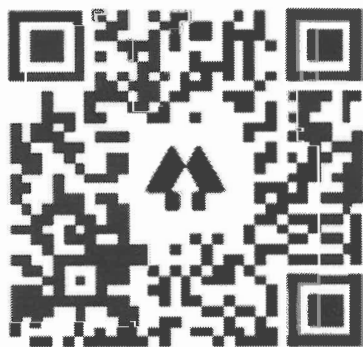

# Dixie West Zone Weather Forecast

**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** Strong northerly winds will continue today with gusts as high as 40 mph, mainly along the ridge tops and across aligned drainages. The threat for a rain/snow mix will continue through at least noon today with accumulations unlikely for elevations at or below 6500 FT. Wind chills or feel like temperatures will be in the teens this morning and slowly increase into the lower 30s by the afternoon hours. Actual air temperatures will likely struggle to get out of the upper 40s for most locations. **Be sure to dress in layers if possible to keep warm when outside!**

**TODAY:** Mostly cloudy and cold. 20% chance for a rain/snow mix. Decreasing clouds in the afternoon.

**High Temperatures:** Valley/Drainages: 48-53° Mid-Slope (4500-5500 FT): 44-49° Ridges (> 5500 FT): 40-45°  
**Minimum Relative Humidity:** Valley/Drainages: 25-30% Mid-Slope (4500-5500 FT): 25-30% Ridges (> 5500 FT): 25-30%

**Interior heat islands (near DP-301):** N to NE winds between 10 and 15 mph with gusts to around 35 mph. Areas downwind of Prospect Peak will be sheltered and sustained winds may be closer to 10 mph with gusts to around 25 mph.

**DIV S/U:** N to NE winds of 15 to 25 mph with gusts of 35 to 40 mph. Regions along HWY 89 may be sheltered from NE winds and sustained speeds near 15 mph with gusts to 30 mph are more likely here

**DIV W/Z:** N to NE winds of 15 to 25 mph with gusts of 35 to 40 mph

**DIV J/K/L:** N to NE winds of 8 to 12 mph with gusts to around 25 mph.

**Stability:** No inversion---deep mixed layer to near 10,000 FT AGL.  
**Chance of Precipitation:** 20% **LAL:** 1 **Transport Winds:** NE at 35 mph.

**TONIGHT:** Mostly clear conditions with residual NE to E breezes. Cold with wind chill values in the teens.

**Low Temperatures:** Valley/Drainages: 22-28° Mid-Slope (4500-5500 FT): 20-30° Ridges (>5500 FT): 18-23°  
**Relative Humidity Recovery:** Susanville ICP: 23-28 ° Hat Creek Spike: 21-26°  
Valley/Drainages:60-70% Mid-Slope (4500-5500 FT): 55-60% Ridges (> 5500 FT): 55-60%

**Interior heat islands (near DP-301):** NE winds around 10 to 15 mph with gusts to around 25 mph through the night.

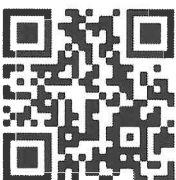
**DIV S/U:** NE to E winds around 8 to 12 mph with gusts to around 20 mph through the night.

**DIV W/Z:** NNE to NE winds around 8 to 12 mph with gusts to around 20 mph through the night.

**DIV J/K/L:** NE to E winds around 6 to 10 mph with gusts to around 20 mph through the night.

**Stability:** Very shallow inversion developing around 2100 PDT.  
**Chance of Precipitation:** 2% **LAL:** 1 **Transport Winds:** NE to E around 15 mph.

**Extended Outlook (Tuesday through Thursday):** Strong NE to E winds are anticipated again on Tuesday with sustained speeds near 20 mph and gusts to around 45 mph. This will result in Tuesday morning wind chills in the teens. Afternoon temperatures will climb a little higher with a few more areas making it into the 50s during the afternoon. Afternoon RH is expected to fall down to near 20%. Tuesday night into Wednesday will feature another cold night with many regions falling down into the mid 20s. A warming trend is expected through the end of the week with a slight increase in N to NE winds on Thursday. Speeds at this juncture appear that they will remain around 15 mph with gusts to 30 mph.

## FIRE BEHAVIOR

**GENERAL:**

\*Northeast California Energy Release Component is about 55\*

- **Expect very little fire activity** with a few isolated areas of smoldering and creeping in unburned interior islands, dozer berms, stumpholes and post-burn needlecast. Strong northeast could cause rapid fire spread outside of containment lines.
- **Fuels are grass, brush and timber** - Scott and Burgan fuel models GS2, SH3/4/9, TU1/5 and TL 6/9. 1000-hour fuel moistures are < 10% and live fuels are 60 – 70%.
- **Topography is varied** and includes mountains, hills, drainages, benches and meadows. The elevation ranges from 4000' to over 8000' in Lassen Park. All aspects are represented and slopes range from 0 to 80%.

**SPECIFIC FIRE BEHAVIOR:**

**Very low fire behavior and potential.** Very few smoldering hotspots remain within the fire perimeter.

**West Zone:** There are a few areas of unburned interior islands of vegetation in Lassen Park and Lassen Forest/Prospect Peak/Cluster Lakes areas that will continue to burn themselves out with low intensity. Light smoke may be visible. Any new starts or fire outside containment lines near DIV's S, P, O, N and L could rapidly spread southwesterly.

**East Zone:** Very little heat evident. There may be a few remaining hot stumpholes and buried heat in dozer berms. Very light smoke visible near Greenville but not a threat to containment lines.

**Maximum Fire Behavior** (new starts or outside of containment lines):

- Surface Flame Lengths 6-9'
- Rate of Spread 15-35 chains/hour grass and 10-20 chains/hour in timber
- Spotting Distance up to ¼-½ mile
- Probability of Ignition 60%

## AIR OPERATIONS

- Strong high level winds will limit aviation operations

## SAFETY

- Size-up work areas for fire weakened trees near containment lines. Watch for hot stumpholes and snipes.
